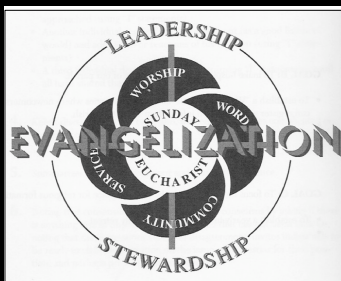

### THE HOLY FAMILY

Exert from *Scripture Soundings: Year C Commentary*

Today's Gospel is taken from the "infancy narrative" section of Luke. It is helpful to note the very carefully crafted nature of the stories he recounts here. Under the guise of narrating historical events, Luke is actually engaged in a profound theological reflection on the nature and person of Jesus Christ. From the perspective of his vantage point many years after the life and death of Jesus, and certainly inspired by the Christian community's faith in Jesus as the risen Son of God, Luke is able to weave a narrative of his early years in a way that reveals to the astute reader all that will unfold more clearly later on in the course of the Gospel story of his public ministry, death, and resurrection.

The heart of this story is Jesus' pronouncement that he "had to be" in his Father's house. The phrase "had to be" is a favorite expression of Luke's to signal the inevitability of a destiny tied irrevocably to God's saving plan for the world. Jesus reveals his special relationship to God as his Father, a relationship that surpasses any human ties to Mary or Joseph. His is a transcendent identity from the beginning. The fact that he was drawn to the

temple, to his "Father's house," carried with it a pregnant meaning that will be more fully realized in the Gospel proper, where Luke tells the story of Jesus' great journey to Jerusalem, the place where the events of his paschal mystery are to be played out. His identity and his mission are both foreshadowed in this scene as he "preaches" in the temple, only to have his message (and person) meet with amazement and astonishment.

### Reflection

On this day, we pay special honor to the **Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph**. We all belong to families, whether born, married, or adopted into them. We all belong to the family of faith through the waters of baptism and, finally, as part of God's creation, we belong to the larger human family.

In an exert from *What Is the New Evangelization* by Michelle K. Borrás, she writes, "Pope Benedict, while visiting Germany in 2011 asked, 'Do we, as human families, need God, or can we live quite well without him?' He then said, 'The more families and the human race withdraw from God, the clearer it becomes that man in his hubris of power, in his emptiness of heart, and in his longing for satisfaction and happiness, increasingly loses his life. A thirst for the infinite is indelibly present in human beings. Man was created to have a relationships with each other, *and to have a relationship with God; we need him.*' Our families need him. We cannot stop thirsting for what surpasses us, for the infinite, and this infinite is a Person who gives himself to us. He loves us and desires our love so intensely that we could say that he, too, thirsts for *our love.*"

### THE PEACE IN FINDING JESUS

Exert from *Living Faith - Daily Devotions*

In the Words of Mother Teresa, "God so loved the world that he gave us his only begotten son, Jesus Christ. When Jesus came into the world, he loved it so much that he gave his life for it. He wanted to satisfy our hunger for God. And what did he do? He made himself the *Bread of Life*. He became small, fragile and defenseless for us. Bits of bread can be so small that even a baby can chew it, even a dying person can eat it. He became the *Bread of Life* to satisfy our hunger for love."

Mother Teresa continues, "I don't think we could have ever loved God if Jesus had not become one of us. So that we might be able to love God, he became one of us in all things, *except sin*. If we have been created in the image of God, **then we have been created to love**, because **God is love**. In his passion Jesus taught us how to forgive out of love, how to forget out of humility. Find Jesus, and you will find peace...and love."

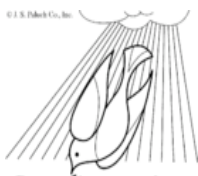
