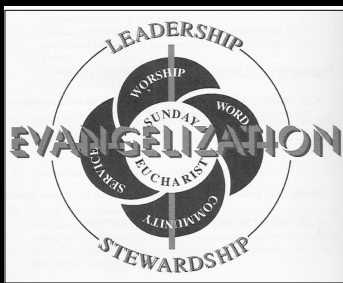

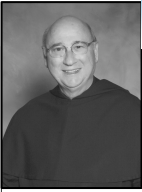

~ FROM THE PASTOR ~

Talented, talented, talented! That's our school children, teachers, staff and of course Mrs. Erin Thielke who entertained St Juliana parish/school community during the annual school *Spring Sing* recently in the Parish Center. What a marvelous performance from our children and the creative skits dramatized by our vibrant Eighth grade class. Applause, applause, applause to everyone!

Every day I witness a kind of harmony in the daily activities of our parish and school communities. I am always humbled by the amount of energy, enthusiasm and charity exhibited by parishioners and staff who partner with me and with each other for the betterment of our faith community. I hear so often about how parishes in the Diocese of Orange and in particular our deanery excel. Well, we excel too! I have moments when I sense great pride in what we are accomplishing and witnessing in living the Christ-life.

A quote from Paula Gunn Allen stands out in my mind. She writes: "*Snowflakes, leaves, humans, plants, raindrops, stars, molecules, microscopic entities all come in communities. The singular cannot in reality exist.*" Working together to grow and accomplish our pastoral goals as outlined by our Parish Pastoral Council will take more than wishful thinking...it will take hard work, commitment, partnership, and intentionality. We have to want to be better, do better, live better, love better, forgive better, and stick-to-it better.

Our Parish Pastoral Council, under the leadership of Bob Dietterle, invited the heads of all the various *Seven Elements of Parish Life* ministries - outlined on page two of the parish bulletin (the inside cover) - to meet together in the Parish Center last Sunday afternoon. Most of the ministries were represented. The task of each ministry is to identify particular objectives or action plans to implement the goals outlined by the Council for a period of 1 year and 5 years. A time line was created and the Council will then review what is submitted. I am confident that we will do well if we trust the process.

I had the honor of participating in the graduation retreat of our Eighth grade students at Marywood last Tuesday conducted by Scott Kambak. It is a long day for the students and Scott's program engages the students in ways that keep them interested and open to God's grace. The theme of the retreat day was: "*One in the Spirit.*" Throughout the day Scott emphasized that each student is special with his or her own gifts. The journey in the Spirit moves each student from birth through death, coming closer and closer to God. The class of 2012 will always be linked in this journey even after they graduate and go separate ways. Thank you, Scott! Your loyalty to the parish and our Junior High Youth Ministry for over 30 years has greatly influenced the lives of our children and now young adults.

Last Monday our school parents and friends of St. Juliana School celebrated the 18th Annual Golf Tournament and Dinner at Alta Vista Country Club in Placentia. The shotgun-scamble began at 12 noon and dinner at 6:30pm. I had the opportunity to golf with three others: school parents, Karl and Ryan, and Josh, Ryan's brother. We have made progress in this area and will continue to be responsible stewards. A reminder from our Finance Committee that our *Legacy Courtyard* in the plaza area of the Parish Center still has many openings for memorial *Pavers*. The cost to have a paver placed in the Courtyard is \$500. Each paver has up to three rows of letters with sixteen letters per row. There are forms in the back of church and in the Parish Office. You can become part of the effort to "*Honor Our Past, Building Our Future.*"

My special thanks to all who come faithfully to our Thursday evening *Catholicism Series* at 7pm in the Parish Center meeting room 1-2. We still have two more sessions: May 31st: *Prayer and the Life of the Spirit* and June 7th: *World Without End: The Last Things*.

We were blessed to have had Pastor Sara McCurdy from Morningside Presbyterian Church as our guest speaker last Tuesday evening. Pastor McCurdy shared with us the basic teachings of the Presbyterian Church as outlined by John Calvin, the Swiss Reformer. Our next speaker will be Father Al Baca who is the representative of the Catholic Diocese in Ecumenical affairs. He will speak on the efforts the Diocese is making with regard to ecumenical dialogue. The date will be announced later.

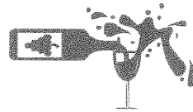
