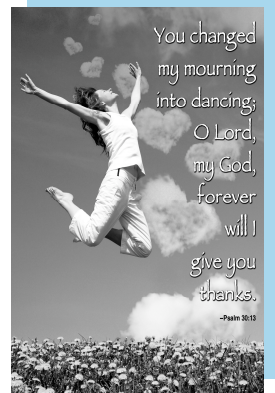

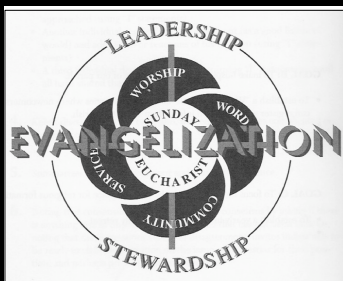

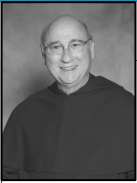

~ FROM THE PASTOR ~



Wonderful! Wonderful! Wonderful! That's how I would describe last Sunday's celebration of the Feast of St. Juliana, our parish patroness. At all the Masses, the celebrant presented a bouquet of roses to the image of St. Juliana, recited a prayer in her honor, and Claudia sang an original song she composed highlighting some of the virtues of St. Juliana.

Following the 11am Mass parishioners young and old mingled together on the church lawn to enjoy the chili cook-off (twelve chili slower cookers each numbered). All the chili entries were delicious. There were three winners and each received a gift certificate. Besides the chili there were hot dogs, chips, snacks, water, and frozen yogurt. The children played games and had a surprise visit by the Fullerton Fire Department. The firemen gave each child a badge making them honorary firemen. The children had a chance to hold a fire hose with the help of a fireman and experienced firsthand how to manage a fire hose shooting water half way across the field. I want to thank Julianna Tapia, Julianna's team, our Secular Servite community, and all the participants who came and brought their "easy-ups," coolers, chairs, blankets, and food items for making this *Third Annual St. Juliana Feast Day* such a festive success. Next year we hope to have more games, lots of balloons, some music, and a much larger participation. Every parish should have a feast day. It is a Catholic tradition to want to showcase and boast of the virtues of the parish patron. In 2013 St. Juliana's feast day will be the weekend of June 22-23.

The St. Juliana celebration encourages me in my belief in the power of community. As members of St. Juliana parish we have a common origin, value system, faith, and destiny. We are bound to each other and our collective witness is a source of grace for those who are seekers in the world around us. The more we can celebrate each other and our community life intermingled with our personal commitment to Christ and the Church and our Servite way of life, the more will others want to be a part of us. As a parish family we are not in competition with other parishes or with any political structure. We are simply who we profess to be: the *Body of Christ*.

Father Anthony de Mello, S.J. tells a story that illustrates the primacy of giving good example. *It intrigued the congregation to see their rabbi disappear each week on the eve of the Sabbath. They suspected he was secretly meeting the Almighty, so they deputed one of their number to follow him. This is what the man saw: the rabbi disguised himself in peasant clothes and served a paralyzed Gentile woman in her cottage, cleaning out the room and preparing a Sabbath meal for her. When the spy got back, the congregation asked, "Where did the rabbi go? Did he ascend to heaven?" "No," the man replied, "he went even higher."*

During Sunday morning coffee and donuts recently, I had

occasion to talk with a parish family who related a story that illustrates the power of prayer. Miracles happen because prayer happens. I heard about their daughter who fifteen years ago was diagnosed with a very aggressive cancer and not expected to live. She received a prayer leaflet in honor of St. Peregrine. She faithfully prayed. The prognosis looked somewhat more hopeful...a few months. Fifteen years later, despite some residual health issues, she is a cancer survivor and attributes her miracle to the intercession of St. Peregrine.

This is just one of thousands of miracles that go unsung or unnoticed in the lives of survivors who have discovered a *friend, confidant, healer, intercessor, and survivor* in St. Peregrine. As Catholics we recite in the Creed at Mass that "*we believe in the Communion of Saints...*" St. Peregrine has a very special love for those who share his experience of suffering the pains of cancer. Never doubting that God accompanies us in our struggle, St. Peregrine prays for all who today live the daily distress of this disease.

This Saturday, July 7th following the 8am Mass we will pray our devotion in honor of St. Peregrine. I hope you will come for yourself or to represent someone who is unable to attend. You may mention the person(s) name(s) when you come forth to receive a blessing with the relic of St. Peregrine.

The author Gail Devers writes: "*Keep your dreams alive. Understand to achieve anything requires faith and belief in yourself, vision, hard work, determination, and dedication. Remember all things are possible for those who believe.*"

The Office of Pastoral Care Ministry of the Diocese of Orange has reactivated the diocesan ministry to those who have been hurt by the act of abortion. For the past two years a new program---*Hope and Healing After Abortion: A Ministry to those Hurt by Abortion*---has been developed to meet this need. It has been operating as a pilot program, serving Deanery II, from the Pastoral Center Office at Holy Family Cathedral. For those in need of help, the hotline number is 1-800-722-4356.

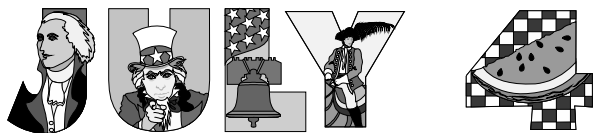

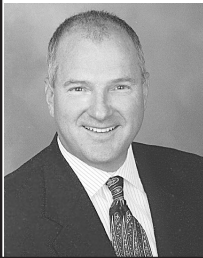
