

~ FROM THE PASTOR ~

The word "enthusiasm" literally means to be "In God" from the Greek "en-theos." The readings for last Sunday's feastday Mass when read aloud burst with enthusiasm. Moses is bursting with enthusiasm for what the Lord has done for the once en-

slaved community. Hear the "feeling" in his words: "Did anything so great ever happen before?" "Was it ever heard of?" "Did a people ever hear the voice of God?" Then he pulls them further into his enthusiasm: "That is why you must now know and fix in your heart, that the Lord is God....you must keep his statutes."

In the second reading we hear the enthusiasm in St. Paul's words about the Holy Spirit: "Those led by the Spirit are children of God....we are heirs with Christ."

Catch the enthusiasm as Jesus addresses his disciples who in turn are filled with enthusiasm: "Go and make disciples baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Teach them all that I commanded you and know that I am with you always until the end of the Age."

To be "In God" is to be "enthusiastic" and to be "enthusiastic" is to be "In God." Enthusiasm is life giving. Enthusiasm is dynamic. Enthusiasm is contagious. Enthusiasm is the antidote to boredom, sameness, and predictability.

All you need to do is to be around children. They are naturally curious and enthusiastic. However, biblical enthusiasm, to be "In God," is not based on curiosity or even excitement alone. A childlike enthusiasm is easily squelched. Just say "no" to a child and it ends. Biblical enthusiasm is founded upon an inner commitment to be "alive" in God. It is the animator that moves us to be better, to do better, to live better, and to love better not selfishly but for God and others.

No one has ever completely explained the mystery of the Holy Trinity. However, understanding the meaning of being "In God", "En Theos," "Enthusiastic" comes very close. If we model our lives on the love of Father, Son and Holy Spirit enthusiasm will flow naturally and become the source of happiness and joy in our life together as a parish family, a domestic family, and as a world-wide Church family.

The 15th century English mystic, Julian of Norwich through intense spiritual experiences was able to probe the mystery of a God who loves in triplicate, as Father, as Son and Brother, and as Spirit. She writes: "God showed me a little thing, the size of a hazelnut, lying in the palm of my hand. It was as round as any ball....I thought, 'What can this be?' My question was answered in general terms.... 'It is everything that is made.' I marveled at how this could be, for it seemed that it might suddenly fall into nothingness, it was so small. An answer for this was given to my understanding. 'It lasts and ever shall last because God loves it. And in this fashion, all things have their being by the grace of God.' In this little thing, I saw three properties. The first is that God made it. The second is that God loves it. The third thing is that God keeps it. And what did I see in this? Truly, the Maker, the Lover and the Keeper."

Our St. Peregrine monthly devotion on the first Saturday of the month following the 8am Mass is becoming better attended. I really want to encourage parishioners who have active cancers and in treatment as well as those who have family members (continued)

with cancer to come to Mass and receive a blessing in honor of St. Peregrine. Throughout the centuries countless numbers of devotees have been cured of cancer through the prayers of St. Peregrine. If you come to Mass you may come for a blessing and name the person(s) you are representing and the blessing will be theirs. I would love to hear of your experiences, healings and miracles attributed to your prayers and devotion to St. Peregrine.

Mike McHenry and Dolores Gilbert have been busy recruiting children for Vacation Bible School (VBS) and SRE registration after the 9am and 11am Sunday Masses. Our children will really benefit from both programs as they grow in their Catholic Faith. I hope parents will be enthusiastic and support these educational opportunities.

This weekend we say goodbye to Father Paul as he leaves on Wednesday for his "u-haul trip" to Affton, Missouri and our Servite parish, Seven Holy Founders to begin a new phase of his life as pastor. Father Paul has endeared himself to St. Juliana parishioners and he will be missed. He will now have an opportunity to use his pastoring skills in a parish similar in size as St. Juliana's.

At the same time, we welcome Fr. Luke back to St. Juliana after a three year absence in his capacity as parochial vicar. Father Luke is well loved by St. Juliana parishioners and is happy to be returning. I am sure he will be overjoyed to hear from you. I look forward to working with Father Luke as he brings his gifts...talents to the parish.

Congratulations to our Eighth grade graduation class as they break for summer vacation and prepare for High School. They will always be "bravados" and "bravadas" in my book.

As our young students climb the academic ladder, the words of the author Jack Canfield seem appropriate. He writes: "One of the things that may get in the way of people being lifelong learners is that they're not in touch with their passion. If you're passionate about what it is you do, then you're going to be looking for everything you can to get better at it."

On this feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ, the church highlights the centrality of the Eucharist in our lives as Catholics. We believe in and witness to the miracle of bread and wine, the elements Jesus chose to identify with at the Last Supper as His Body and Blood. These are not representations or facsimiles or symbols but the Real Presence of our Lord under the appearances of bread and wine. As often as we celebrate Mass and receive our Lord in the Eucharist, we commemorate the Sacrifice of our Redemption. That Christ is present both in the Word and Sacrament is integral to the worthy celebration of Mass. To be present at the beginning of Mass and until the final blessing and dismissal is to respect and honor this most precious and life giving Sacrifice of Christ.

A closing thought from Sarah Ban Breathnach: "Today, expect something good to happen to you no matter what occurred yesterday. Realize the past no longer holds you captive. It can only continue to hurt you if you hold on to it. Let the past go. A simple, abundant world awaits."
