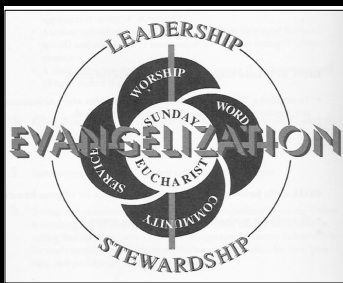

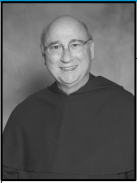

## ~ FROM THE PASTOR ~

A few weeks ago all the priests of the Diocese of Orange were invited by Bishop Brown to visit the Crystal Cathedral campus for a tour, presentation, and lunch. Our Provincial, John Fontana, O.S.M., and members of the Provincial Council were meeting here at St. Juliana so we all travelled together to Garden Grove for this get-together.

As you well know, the Diocese has purchased the Crystal Cathedral and its surrounding campus of almost 40 acres and renamed it *Christ Cathedral*. The Diocese will not take possession of the Cathedral and surrounding buildings until June of 2013. At that time, the Cathedral ministries founded by Dr. Robert Schuller will vacate the campus and relocate at the former St. Callistus church. The St. Callistus parishioners will then move to the Arboretum chapel on the campus and will conduct Sunday services there until the Crystal Cathedral is renovated into a suitable space for Catholic worship.

The highlight of the day occurred during the late morning presentation by the new rector of the Cathedral, Fr. Christopher Smith. Father Smith introduced a number of men and women who represent the team who will direct the various steps involved in converting the Cathedral and campus to reflect our Catholic worship and tradition. Investigating a legion of architects and then choosing one or more to draw plans will be a formidable task. It will not be easy to convert the Cathedral into a Catholic worship space. It wasn't designed with Catholic liturgy in mind. The look is more like that of a concert hall with the magnificent organ (fifth largest in the U.S. and eighth in the world) in the center line of vision where normally the altar would stand out. Following Father Smith's presentation, Bishop Brown said a few words and then, in a surprise move, introduced Dr. Schuller. The curtain on the stage opened to reveal a smiling Dr. Schuller seated on a chair in the middle of the stage.

A tall and humble man, Dr Schuller showing his age but standing proud walked to the podium and in a calm and almost inaudible voice welcomed everyone and talked a little about himself and how the Cathedral came to be and then in a strong, vibrant, almost thundering voice said, "*You are the Mother Church and now the Cathedral will be a real Cathedral.*" In an instant everyone arose and with an earsplitting applause gave their approval to his words.

That moment with Dr. Schuller was for me: "A never to be forgotten moment." I am sure others felt that way too. While the press and other observers have presented Dr. Schuller, his family, and the staff of the Cathedral ministries in a negative light and brought into the public forum the wasteful and extravagant stewardship of the Cathedral ministries, I believe that deep down whatever part Dr. Schuller played in the tragic turn of events that caused him to lose his life long dream and work was inadvertent. He expressed to us how much he loves the Church and his desire to bring Christ into the everyday life of Christians. He encouraged the new

owners to keep his dream alive and to preach "Christ." A prayer service followed and then lunch.

Parishes and groups are strongly encouraged to arrange a scheduled tour. Tuesday and Saturday mornings have been set aside for this purpose. The Crystal Cathedral has volunteer docents who are knowledgeable about the buildings and are usually available for individual visits to the Campus. Tours are scheduled for 9 AM till 2:30 PM Monday through Saturday. No prior registrations are needed. You can check the Cathedral Ministries webpage [www.crystalcathedral.org/events](http://www.crystalcathedral.org/events) news/index.php. We will organize a bus tour from the parish in the very near future.

You may have received a mailing recently entitled: "*Next to the Church---The Parish School: The Legacy and the Future of Catholic Education.*" The intent of the brochure and companion letter is to encourage all who have the financial means and the desire to insure the future of Catholic education to support our school here at St. Juliana. Our history has made it clear that we have done a marvelous job not only in the area of academic excellence but also in moral and spiritual development of our children. I hope parishioners and friends alike will join in this effort to keep our school excellent and well funded.

Vacation Bible School begins this week. My special thanks to our director of Faith Formation, Mike McHenry and to his able bodied co-worker, Delores Gilbert for the weeks of preparation they devoted to this exciting program. VBS will be an awesome experience for our children.

Thank you, St. Juliana parishioners, for your faith-filled stewardship. We are better than half way to fulfilling our goal of 600 families supporting our 2012-2013 PSA. With your help and the success of our parish festival in September by this time next year we hope to reduce our debt from the present amount of 1,200,000.00 to under one million. What sacrifices you have made. With such generous hearts, you have never complained or resisted a plea for help.

I hope you will support our Knights of Columbus blood drive next Sunday. Our Knights have organized blood drives for many years and countless persons in need of life-giving blood have benefitted. This is one of many ways the Knights of Columbus support the Corporal and Spiritual works of Mercy.

Francine Ward once said: *Remember, reaching goals is not so much about doing big things when the feeling hits you; it's more about doing little things every day that move you toward your dream. It's about staying steady and on course.*"

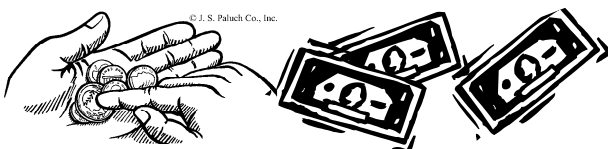

## PASTORAL SERVICES APPEAL



Thank you to the 318 families who have generously pledged \$163,468 through their financial contribution to our 2012 Pastoral Services Appeal to support the mission of the church to teach, preach, minister, and serve in the name of Jesus. All monies pledged and paid over and above our goal of \$109,000 will be returned to our parish as a form of a rebate to help pay down the balance of the Parish Center loan with the diocese. Our 2012 goal is 600 families and \$250,000 and we are over halfway there.

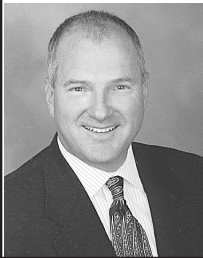
