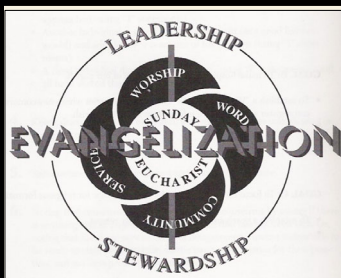

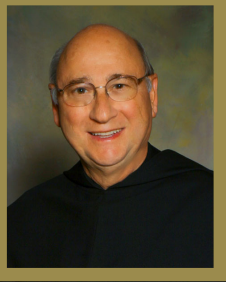

Pope Francis recently commented on the crisis facing Nations with regard to human rights and the protection of those most vulnerable in society. The following quote from a talk at Lampedusa is often used. He said then: *"In this world of globalization we have fallen into a globalization of indifference..."*

In our own situation here in the United States, the issue of Comprehensive Immigration Reform is a concern not only for our Government but also for our Catholic Church. We have always been a church of immigrants. Bishop Kevin Vann is inviting Catholics and other people of faith in the Diocese of Orange and beyond to join him and come together in prayer, solidarity and action with and for our immigrant sisters and brothers.

In St. Matthew's Gospel Jesus tells us, *"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me a drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me."* These words call us to enlarge our vision of a just and compassionate world. It is the task of the Church and thus every parish community in every Diocese to participate in some fashion in this quest for justice.

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul here at St. Juliana is responding to Bishop Vann's invitation to our Parish to participate in the first major social action event at Christ Cathedral entitled, ***"Prayer-Solidarity-Action for Comprehensive Immigration Reform"*** on Saturday, November 16, 2013 at 12:30pm. A parish Vincentian family is sponsoring bus transportation from St. Juliana's parking lot leaving at 11:30am and returning at 3:00pm.

I plan on attending and would like representatives of all the parish ministries to support this effort. If the bus is filled, car-pooling is an option. To reserve a place on the bus please call (714)-879-8721 and leave your name, number in your party and phone number. Let us join thousands of fellow Catholics in response to Pope Francis, our U.S. Bishops and Bishop Vann's call for social justice and charity in our own communities.

During the month of October throughout all the dioceses in the United States, parishes participated in the *"October Count."* The objective of this yearly count is to measure trends in church attendance. The data gathered from reports sent into the chancery offices shows that on average about 25% of Catholics attend Sunday Mass. That percentage hasn't changed much in the last 15 years. Sad to say, Sunday Mass is not a priority for a large group of those who identify themselves as Catholic. The trend here at St. Juliana has remained fairly stable the last three years. Even with a large influx of new parishioners registering, our average weekly count has not changed much.

The average Sunday attendance in 2012 was **1,572**. In 2013 the

average attendance was **1,445**. That amounts to a decrease in attendance of **127** parishioners. **Statistically** that is insignificant and with a margin of error plus or minus we are reasonably stable. Of course, the potential for greater attendance is much higher. We all need to work harder at welcoming and encouraging family members and inactive Catholic parishioners to be more faithful.

Some of our neighboring parishes have reported the following statistics: St. Anthony Claret: **3,899**; San Antonio: **2,731**; St. Joseph: **2,850**; St. Philip Benizi: **2,421**; Our Lady of Guadalupe: **3,543**; St. Bonaventure: **3,612**; St. Martin de Porres: **2,518**; St. Mary's: **3,080**. In comparing these statistics it is important to note that these parishes are larger than St. Juliana.

Our Junior High Youth Ministry (JHYM) has an interesting program planned for this coming Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup> in the Seven Holy Founders' room in the Parish Center from 7:30 to 9:00 pm. The presentation promises to bring greater awareness to our youth of world and neighborhood poverty and hunger. As Scott Kambak reminds our youth, this offering will be a great introduction to the five mile walk planned for later in the month. I encourage our parents to endorse these activities for our youth.

I believe that one of the basic truths of the Christian life is the call to *"Forgiveness."* It is a fact of life that we frequently find ourselves in situations that challenge us to exercise the virtue of forgiveness. An article appearing in the *Priest* journal written by Thomas M. Pastorius, *"What is forgiveness? Ten Truths for the Spiritual Journey"* outlines some useful ways to practice forgiveness on a daily basis. He writes: 1) *Forgiveness does not mean acquitting. True forgiveness is about owning the fact that we have been hurt and making a choice to respond to that hurt with love and peace*; 2) *Forgiveness is not the same as forgetting*; 3) *Forgiveness is a virtue*; 4) *Forgiveness takes time and does not happen all at once*; 5) *Forgiveness is not about restitution. Forgiveness---to be true forgiveness---has to be unconditional*; 6) *Forgiveness means no longer being a victim*; 7) *Forgiveness is not a feeling. We can mistakenly think we are not making progress because we do not feel like forgiving*; 8) *Forgiveness is not mutual. The gift of forgiveness does not have to be accepted in order for it to be given*; 9) *Forgiveness does not require perfection*; 10) *Forgiveness does require prayer*.

This weekend women from the parish are participating in a *Women's Silent Retreat* located in the beautiful and serene grounds of the Sacred Heart Retreat house in Alhambra. The theme of this retreat is: *Year of Faith*. Besides the opportunity to listen to conferences by the retreat master, Rev. Francis Benedict, OSB, the women will have a well-deserved opportunity to rest and to have quiet time which is a luxury in their busy lives.

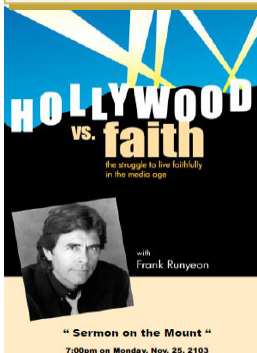
