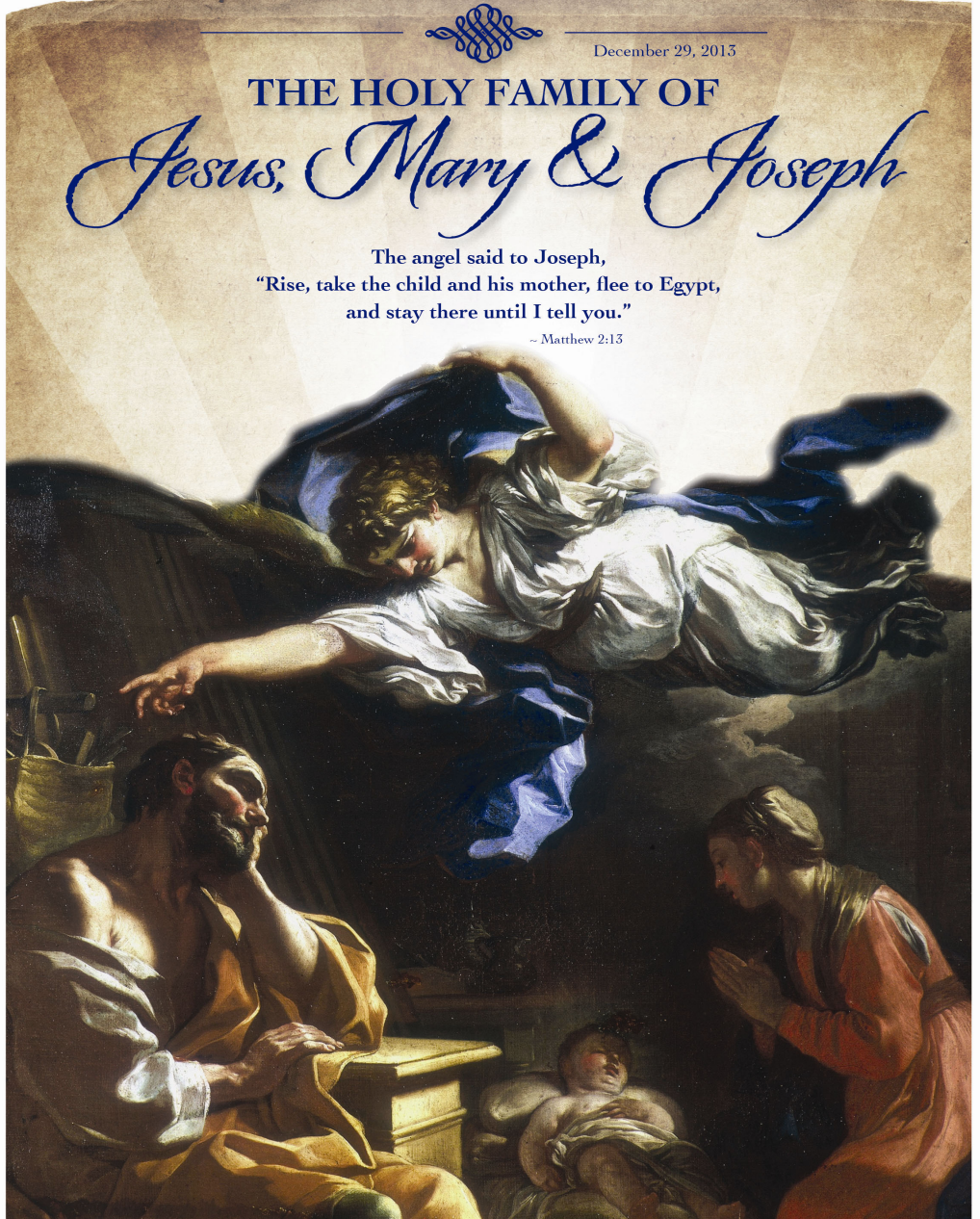

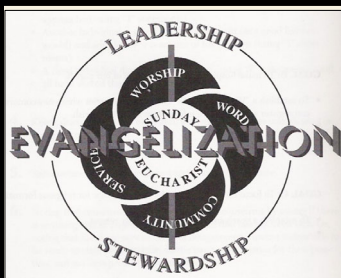

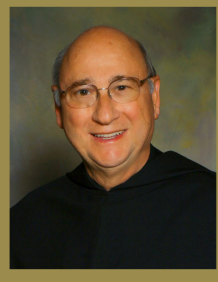

Let us celebrate in our homes and certainly at church the entire Christmas story that concludes with the Baptism of Our Lord and the beginning of his public ministry on January 12th. Although I will be away from the parish for that length of time, I promise to remember you in prayer and to light a candle in any church or shrine I visit. Please continue to remember me in your prayers as well as we begin the New Year together.

Father Luke and I are touched by your generosity this Christmas. Our gratitude goes beyond adequate words. Your cards, gifts, baskets of fruit and other goodies, libations, hugs and kind words gave us both support and comfort. Thank You!

I know that the parish staff feels that same kind of support and appreciation. Your cards and gifts to them helped make the pre-Christmas gatherings more joyful.

It goes without saying that our parish choir under Todd Helm and accompanied by Claudia Kellogg achieved a level of excellence that would be admired by anyone trained in good liturgy and music. My kudos to our ancillary musicians as well!

All of our celebrants, deacons, liturgical ministers, ushers, along with our environment volunteers under the direction of Catherine Haydon, Mark Augustine, John Garcia and the behind the scenes recruits did a marvelous undertaking to make our Christmas celebration "full of wonder."

Please keep an eye on the bulletin for many of the exciting programs planned by Mike McHenry, our Director of Faith Formation for the parish. The Adult Confirmation course begins in January along with a lecture on Christ Cathedral of the Diocese, *Crystal to Catholic* by Dr. John Madden. The entire month of January will also feature a replay of *Catholicism: The New Evangelization* by Father Robert Barron and a guided study of the book the parish distributed to all families at Christmas, Matthew Kelly's *Rediscovering Catholicism*. A reminder and further information will appear in the body of the bulletin as the dates approach. Thank you Mike for planning these programs!

I hope you are all enjoying Matthew Kelly's book *Rediscovering Catholicism*. One of the many reasons our parish sought underwriters for this book as a Christmas gift to each family, (along with Matthew Kelly's *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic*, gifted to the parish earlier this year) is because Mr. Kelly is one of the most passionate Catholic speakers and authors of our time, whose message has caught the attention of many leaders of our Church. Matthew Kelly was raised Catholic, and discovered, what he calls the "genius of Catholicism" in his teens, and has spent the past two decades inspiring millions of men, women, and children to explore our faith in a fresh way. He founded the nationally recognized the *Dynamic Catholic Institute* to research the specific question, "Why do Catholics engage or disengage in the faith?" This institute also works to

try to determine what it will take to establish vibrant Catholic communities in the 21st Century. Because Matthew Kelly's message has had such impact in many parish communities, it became a mission this past year for St. Juliana Church to find a way to **give all families of this parish these books**. Contact the Parish Office if you did not receive the *Rediscovering Catholicism* book at Christmas. Our intention is to have *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic* and *Rediscovering Catholicism* books gifted to all families in our parish and for them to serve as a 'jumping point' for personal growth in faith and engagement in our community. Matthew Kelly's core message resonates with people of all ages and from all walks of life. Whether he is speaking in a business forum, at a high school, or in a church, he invites his audience to become *the-best-version-of-themselves*. Challenge yourself to read his books! They are a gift from the parish to each of your families, through the generosity of underwriters who believe these books are an extremely valuable parish tool in evangelization. My hope and prayer is that you are inspired to, as Matthew Kelly invites you to be *the-best-version-of-yourself*, and with God's grace, share that joy and enthusiasm with the community of St. Juliana Falconieri and wherever you are called to serve.

Some thoughts on Christmas from a variety of authors quoted in *Bits and Pieces* published by Lawrence Ragan Communications: "Christmas is the time for looking ahead courageously through the gates of the swiftly approaching New Year...of resolving that the coming months will reflect a kinder, more forgiving, and less heedless person that was mirrored in the past" (Ellen V. Morgan). "At Christmas, all roads lead home" (Marjorie Holmes). "Christmas is a bridge. We need bridges as the river of time flows past. Today's Christmas should mean creating happy hours for tomorrow and reliving those of yesterday" (Gladys Taber).

In the book, *Catholic Customs and Traditions* the author Greg Dues writes the following account of *Christmastime*: "Not many religious traditions---or secular ones---continue after December 25 in the typical family in the United States. Christmas holidays with school vacation, visiting and partying with family and friends are popular for a week. Christmas decorations stay up for a while, but much of life quickly settles into an ordinary routine. The church, however, is not finished with Christmas yet. Christmas songs during liturgies remain popular until the feast of Epiphany...The feast of the Holy family is celebrated on the Sunday between Christmas and January 1. December 26 commemorates the first martyr, St. Stephan; December 27, the evangelist St. John; and December 28, the feast of the Holy Innocents....The feasts of Epiphany and the Baptism of the Lord, close out Christmastime....Afterwards, the figurines in the Nativity scene are packed away along with other decorations that gave the previous weeks such an exciting atmosphere."

God bless you this Christmas season! I will have my article space filled with seasonal meditations until I return mid-January from the Holy Land. My prayers and blessings are with you all.

DIOCESE OF ORANGE FOR CHRIST FOREVER CAMPAIGN

Pledge Totals Surpass \$820,294 at St. Juliana Falconieri!

Our For Christ Forever Campaign Committee would like to thank all the families and individuals who have contributed so far and have made the diocesan campaign a great success. We have received **\$820,294** in pledges from 251 parish individuals and families. At this time, we are awaiting a response from over 1,200 of our parish families. Currently, we are at **60% of goal** from only 16% of our parish. Please keep in mind that since we have surpassed our 2013 PSA goal in cash, we will now receive 25% of all monies collected up to our campaign target of \$1,287,473. Our rebate will be used to pay down the Parish Center loan that currently stands at **\$816,744.68** and make some roof repairs to the Church and rectory.

As of December 12th, we are happy to report receipt of \$77,132,441.94 in pledges from over 21,225 donors. Let's continue being BOLD by being Catholic. Thank you! TOGETHER we are doing GREAT things!

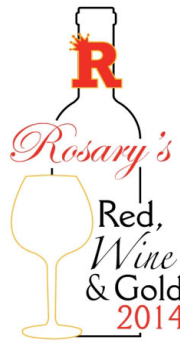
