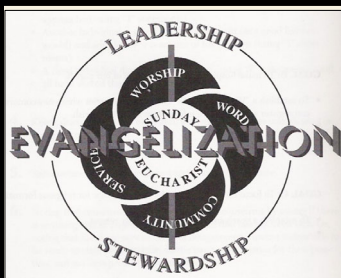

The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as "Corpus Christi," we celebrate this weekend was quite a spectacle in years past. I have vivid memories as a child and then later as an altar server of processions with the Blessed Sacrament carried in the Monstrance around the exterior of the church and then

inside with the choir in full voice singing Eucharistic hymns. A canopy carried by specially selected men from the parish shielded the priest-celebrant carrying the Blessed Sacrament. Everyone genuflected or knelt as the procession passed by. Incense was in abundance and no one coughed. Candles burned brightly on the altar and in the hands of senior altar servers selected as an honor guard. There was no question circulating in the minds of the faithful of the importance and centrality of the Eucharist. This blessed moment was the "Real Presence" of the Risen Lord. Christ, our Risen Lord, was present body and blood, soul and divinity. No doubts! No questions; just the reality of the moment!

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, article 1374 of the chapter entitled: "The Celebration of the Christian Mystery" we read: "The mode of Christ's presence under the Eucharistic species is unique. It raises the Eucharist above all the sacraments as 'the perfection of the spiritual life and the end to which all the sacraments tend' (St. Thomas Aquinas). In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really and substantially contained' (Council of Trent)."

In his letter to all the Bishops of the church written in 1980 on "The Mystery and Worship of the Eucharist," Blessed Pope John Paul II wrote these words: "The Church and the world have a great need for Eucharistic worship. Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love. Let us not refuse the time to go to meet him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offenses and crimes of the world. Let our adoration never cease."

The monthly day/night of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the family chapel in church is always announced at Mass and published ahead of time in the bulletin. The date changes from time to time so please listen for the next Day of Adoration. The Knights of Columbus have been the faithful champions of this devotion.

During the week the east door of the church nearest the family chapel is open from early in the morning until 3pm. Please feel free to stop and spend a few moments in church before the Blessed Sacrament.

I wish to extend my special thanks to all who attended the educational workshop in the Seven Holy Founders room in the Parish Center last Tuesday evening. The workshop was presented by the Alzheimer's Association of Orange County on "Know the 10 Signs of Alzheimer's Disease." This workshop, as well as future presentations is a part of our on-going adult formation sponsored by our Faith Formation ministry under the direction of Mike McHenry.

The upcoming book reflection (see page 7 for details) entitled: "Please, God, Let them be Amazing" written by parishioner Kyle Derek Ervin promises to be an inspiring evening. I hope you will attend this presentation on Tuesday, June 11th at 7pm in the Seven Holy Founders meeting room.

On December 1, 2009 Kyle Erwin's son was born via emergency C-section and weighed in at only 2 pounds, 12 ounces. He was supposed to die. A day later, on December 2, 2009, Kyle's wife and little Anthony's mother developed a blood clot, a major complication after labor, and was declared clinically dead for over 1 1/2 hours. Kyle, there at the hospital when the blood clot stopped his wife's heart, did the only thing he could---he prayed. Knowing his wife's only chance for survival were the men and women in scrubs he said the lone prayer that made sense to him at the time: "Please, God, Let them be Amazing." Kyle and his wife Brynn, who miraculously lived through this life-threatening event, will be present and lead the book reflection and discussion.

As you read in a previous bulletin, our parish debt has been reduced to \$966,661.96. I offer my deepest gratitude to all who have so faithfully fulfilled their pledges and to those who have given over and above their initial commitment. In the Book of Sirach we read: "Give to the Most High as he has given to you, generously, according to your means. For the Lord is one who always repays, and will give back to you sevenfold... With each contribution show a cheerful countenance and pay your tithes in a spirit of joy."

It emphasizes the joy of the institution of the Eucharist, which was observed on Holy

Thursday in the somber atmosphere of the nearness of Good Friday.

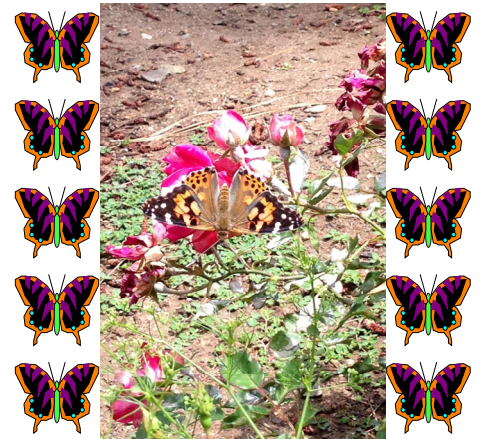
