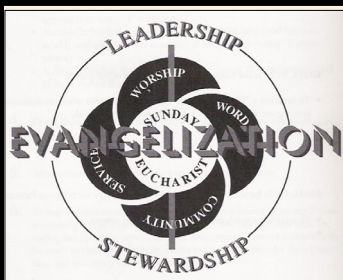

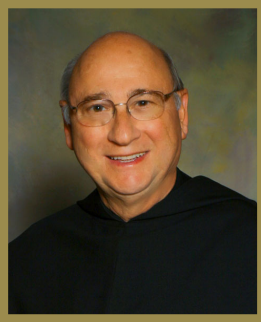

Last Saturday morning I was having a cup of “first light” coffee on the rectory patio. It was a cool morning and the smell of the garden and freshly cut grass was delightful. I felt peaceful. Gratitude flooded my heart; not about anything in particular, just a free floating kind.

As the morning progressed I began to hear the sounds of musicians tuning their instruments and orators checking the microphones and practicing a few key phrases. Rosary High School students and guests were preparing for their main moment in the academic year: graduation!

Soon, I thought, these seniors will be walking across the stage. Teachers, parents, family members, guests will eye them closely and experience a sense of pride. With diplomas in hand each student, I am sure, looked to the future with a sense of hope and perhaps some fear. Can it really be happening?

This ceremony with its high hopes and dreams is reenacted every year throughout our neighborhoods in both private and public schools. St. Juliana took its turn last Friday as our Kindergarten little ones graduated in the morning and our eighth-graders in the evening. I was privileged to be present at both to hand out diplomas and congratulate each student.

In *Bits and Pieces*, a small publication by Lawrence Regan Communications, Inc. writer Laini Taylor captures similar sentiments in these words: “*Hope can be a powerful force. Maybe there’s no actual magic in it, but when you know what you hope for most and hold it like a light within you, you can make things happen, almost like magic.*”

Father’s Day next Sunday, June 16<sup>th</sup> is an opportunity to honor both our blood fathers and those who have been like fathers to us. Wikipedia has information on the history of *Father’s Day* which I will share with you in more detail next weekend. For our purposes here it is interesting to note that *Father’s Day* was inaugurated in the United States in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century to complement *Mother’s Day* in celebrating fatherhood and male parenting. After the success obtained by Anna Jarvis with the promotion of *Mother’s Day* in the U.S., some wanted to create similar holidays for other family members, and *Father’s Day* was the choice most likely to succeed. There were other persons in the U.S. who independently thought of *Father’s Day*, but the credit for the modern holiday is often given to Sonora Dodd who was the driving force behind its establishment. More to come!

The second collection this weekend for our *Servite Missions* in KwaZulu, South Africa may come as a surprise. Sorry for the last minute reminder! If you came unprepared to support this donation, you may still do so next weekend, since we will cancel the collection for the Building Fund and transfer the School Collection from next Sunday to June 23rd.

The first American Servites arrived in Zululand, Natal, South Africa in 1948. The area was remote with no towns or villages, no industry or job opportunities, lack of roads, no electricity, no

running water, no schools, general poverty and the political system of apartheid.

Today, five Servite Friars, including three Zulu Friars (one newly ordained a priest this past May), minister in the Missions. There are also Servite Zulu seminarians in various stages of formation. They constitute the hope for the future.

Five parish communities have been established with a network of 70 other larger and smaller communities where Mass is celebrated every two weeks. Two communities of African sisters serve alongside the Servite Friars.

Catholic groups in the community are beginning to provide for themselves and the Catholic population is now approaching 25,000 compared to about 4,000 in the early 1960’s. At the Servite *Star of the Sea* High School, the pass rate over the past number of years has been 100%. This compares very favorably with the national average of about 52%.

Our Servite Friars are thankful to God for the wonderful work that members of the community, the sisters and lay people have done in Zululand over the past 65 years. This has been made possible by the generous offerings of the people of the United States and other countries. St. Juliana parishioners have always been exceptionally generous. In the past three years St. Juliana sent to the Missions \$7,988 in 2019, \$7,490 in 2011, and \$8,734 in 2012 for a total of \$24,212.

For the past few weeks the committee planning the celebration of the *Feast of Saint Juliana* on Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup> has been hard at work. Julianna Tapia and members of various parish and school commissions have activities planned that I know will be enjoyable for all of our families. The Knights of Columbus will be barbecuing. There will be games looked after by our Scouts, treats for the children, a surprise visit by the Fullerton police and fire departments, lots of balloons, a chili cook-off, and other surprises.

I have always believed that every parish should have a parish feast day. St. Juliana’s feast day (June 19th) which we will celebrate on Sunday, June 23rd is placed at a good time of year with the end of the school year and the kick-off of summer festivities. For our celebration to be successful we will need to mark our calendars and plan on participating. The celebration opens at the end of the 11am Sunday Mass. You may come early to bring your coolers and set up your “easy-ups” and chairs. Everyone is encouraged to “come as you are.” It will be okay to be in shorts, jeans, tee-shirts, sneakers or flip-flops for Mass this one time and of course within good taste. You may still go home to change if you feel more comfortable doing that. It’s a picnic!

Deb Caletti, the author of *Honey, Baby, Sweetheart* wrote these words: “*Summer, after all, is a time when wonderful things can happen to quiet people. For those few months, you’re not required to be who everyone thinks you are, and that cut-grass smell in the air and chance to dive into the deep end of a pool give you a courage you don’t have the rest of the year. You can be grateful and easy, with no eyes on you, and no past. Summer just opens the door and lets you out.*”

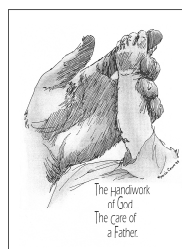

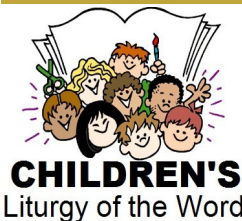

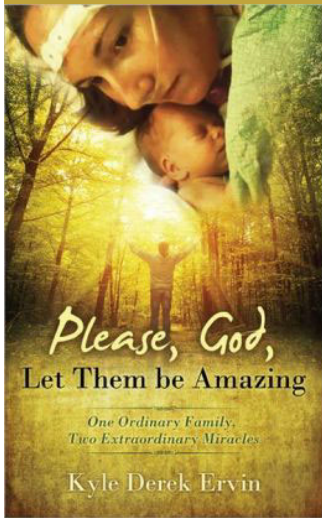

Kyle, there at the hospital when the blood clot stopped his wife's heart did the only thing he could.

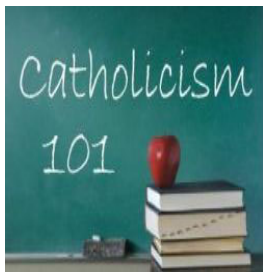

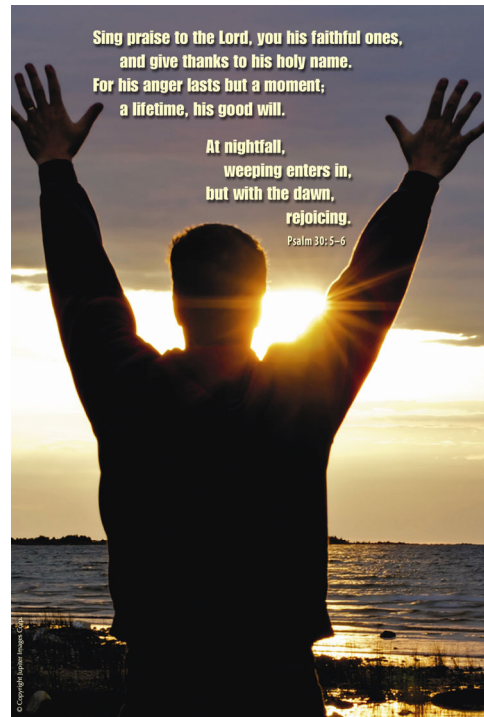
