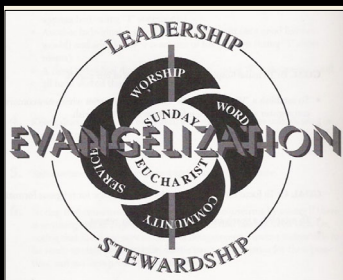

Did you attend the Brew Fest? It was a gala event that brought young and old, school parents and parishioners, visitors and friends from near and far to celebrate an evening of fun and fellowship. Proceeds from this occasion are earmarked to assist school parents and teachers as they provide the best possible Catholic education for our children.

Brew Fest is the brain child of a group of school dads who have a strong interest in the school and loyalty to the parish. The moniker they chose to designate their group, C.L.I.F., stands for *Catholic Lithuanian Irish Federation*. Without any thought of recompense or public recognition, these men have proved invaluable to the financial stability of the parish school. Who are these key men? They are Steve Farrell, Pete Gray, Roy Hollister, Jon Hawkins, Joe Leveck, Rick Price, and Vitas Rugienius. In the name of our school community, thank you!

Our Servite Secular Order (OSSM) community, *St. Juliana of the Eucharist*, provided the blessed bread and water in honor of St. Philip Benizi, O.S.M. last Sunday. Our Servite traditions have an important place in the life of our parish. What is so heartening to me is even when the Order has found it necessary to return a parish to the Bishop, many of the Servite traditions continue. It is even a greater blessing when a Secular Order community is present in the parish or some other ministry long after the Servite friars left. At present we have six Secular Order members. Dave Lazaro is the prior and he would be happy to talk to you about the Order and how to join. Your willingness to be a part of the international Servite family will help ensure the Servite presence in St. Juliana parish.

From the earliest days of the Order, there have been married couples and individuals who desired to share in the spirituality of the friars. The majority of these people remained in their own homes, fulfilling their family responsibilities and carrying out their tasks in the work force and society of their time. The Secular Order was officially recognized by Pope Martin V in 1424.

The essential elements of the spirituality of the Servite family are threefold: *Works of Mercy*: Extending loving concern for all; helping others affected by contemporary situations such as poverty, illness, war alienation. *Marian Inspiration*: Deepening knowledge of Mary and her place in the history of salvation; celebrating particular acts of devotion to Mary; extending the tender and merciful presence of Mary to the whole world. *Community Life*: Accepting our brothers and sisters with their gifts and their limitations; appreciating the talents of others; living in harmony with each other and all creation in a world divided by hatred.

Our parish School is in session. Soon our SRE program will begin. With our new and expanded parish weekly bulletin, information about school happenings and faith formation nights will be copious. Included in the educational ministry of the parish will be future adult education programs along with the yearly parish mission which Mike McHenry is planning at this time. I am encouraged by the good spirit and attitude of the parish and school community as we strive to become united in mutual support. "*We are One Parish, One Community, One Ministry*" must be our motto. Let us help each other in this effort.

One series of adult education presentations I am excited about will be given in late October or early November by Rabbi Art

Levine entitled: *The Real Israel*. These presentations by Rabbi Levine are intended to familiarize us with the underlying dynamics of a dynamic country. The four presentations are: 1) *The land and its people*; 2) *The economy*; 3) *History, government, and politics*; 4) *Lifestyles and social issues*. More information will follow.

The book you received a few weeks ago, *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic* by Matthew Kelly is very readable. I hope you are reading it. In Chapter One entitled, *Incredible Possibilities*, he states the theme of the book and ends with a question. He says: "*Transforming people one at a time is at the heart of God's plan for the world. It is also essential to developing dynamic marriages, loving families, vibrant parish communities, thriving economics, and extraordinary nations. If you get the man right (or the woman, of course), you get the world right. Every time you become a-better-version-of-yourself, the consequences of your transformation echo through your marriage, family, parish, nation, and beyond to people and places in the future. It is God who does the transforming, but only to the extent that we cooperate. God's grace is constant, never lacking. So our cooperation with God's desire to transform us is essential; it is the variable. Are you willing to let God transform you?*"

In light of our Capital Campaign I found the opening words of Chapter Four on the third sign of a dynamic Catholic really helpful. The title, "*The Happiest People I know*" sets the stage for the connection between generosity and personal fulfillment. Matthew Kelly writes: "*The happiest people I know are also the most generous people I know. Is that a coincidence? I don't think so. The world proposes selfishness as the path to happiness. God proposes generosity as the path to happiness. I know many selfish people, but I don't know any who have a deep and lasting happiness. Selfish people always seem restless and discontented. The happiness we experience through selfishness is fleeting because it is dependent on external circumstances. But I also know some very generous people, and their happiness is not dependent on things going their way or on getting what they want; their happiness is rooted in the life of God. This happiness, this joy springs up from something that is taking place within them. We are all invited to that life and that happiness, and generosity is the path that leads there.*"

Our Holy Father Pope Francis addressed these words to a group of pilgrims in Rome a few months ago: "*God thinks like the Samaritan who did not pass by the unfortunate man, pitying him or looking at him from the other side of the road, but helped him without asking for anything in return; without asking whether he was a Jew, a pagan or a Samaritan, whether he was rich or poor. He asked for nothing. He went to help him. God is like this.*"

I hope you will attend the first *Interfaith Religious Fair* next Sunday from 1pm to 3pm in the Parish Center sponsored by FI-MA (Fullerton Interfaith Ministerial Association). This will be an opportunity to learn about the different faith communities representing both Christian and non-Christian. I am very proud that our parish site was chosen to host this momentous occasion. There is no doubt in my mind that Almighty God will bless this event which hopefully will attract those who are unchurched or do not identify with a particular faith. The highlight of the day will be a short address by Dr. Paul Levesque from CalState at 2pm.

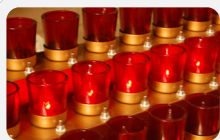

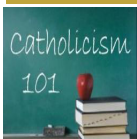
