## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE



The regular occurring events in our parish life define us. Such events are the culture of St. Juliana Parish. Many of our distinctive customs and productions are of course centered on the liturgy. The events we celebrate as a worshiping Church tell us and others who we are; Advent and its candles, Christmas and its lights and joy, Lent and penance, Easter and resurrection, and Pentecost with its urge to go out and be the presence of Jesus. Then there are those days of "Ordinary Time" when we just are – when we just are Church, building

the Kingdom of God, and celebrating our building.

We first learn this mission to build the Kingdom that God desires by our life in various communities; these are the community called family, the parish, and its parish school. These three communities are really one cultural community, called St. Juliana Parish Community.

We all showed that culture at the Fall Festival! Families and friends came together, the parish community current and moved away came together, the school was here, and the Fall Festival was successful. It was successful because it was faithful to who we are and what we are about.

The Kingdom of God is the Body of Christ. This Body is best when it gathers to celebrate possibilities and current realities. Like a liturgy, stories are told: "Well, this is what has happened since I saw you last..." As at a liturgy food and drink are taken with other people: "Hard to make a decision. I like burgers and dogs. Look Filipino food! Over there the ever popular and great Italian kitchen! Me, I want funnel cakes. What, no pop-corn? (There's one in every crowd.)"

Yes, the Fall Festival is a celebration of Church! It is the celebration of our faith community. It's good fun and it defines us. Together we are joyful, encouraging, compassionate, and welcoming of all who come to us. Seems like something Christ-like to me.

The liturgy of the Eucharist gathers people to give thanks to God for what he does. It encourages us to extend thanks to family and friends (enemies too) because they are part of our lives. To all of you who came, thanks. To all who bought tickets, thanks. To all who rode the rides, ate the food, played the games, stayed and told stories, and spent money - thanks. To everyone who worked the event- from the greatest of the organizers to the least of the volunteers- THANK YOU VERY MUCH! God granted prayers for good weather, THANK YOU GOD FOR THE GOOD WEATHER! May our Good God bless you and us, the St. Juliana Parish Community in every way and do so every day!

Shall we "do" the "Fall Festival" again next year? Well, of course! It breaks up those common Sundays of "Ordinary Time." It's who we are. And we are better when we are gathered

together. Right?

The Church celebrated the feast day of St. Francis on Saturday, October 4th. Together let us pray for Pope Francis as he leads our Catholic Church with joy and hope; let us not forget Fr. 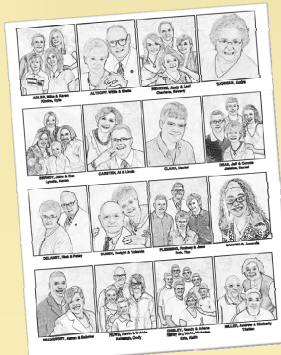

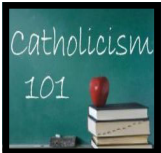

**CATHOLICISM 101**



**Catholic Social Teaching**  
*In October the Church celebrates Respect Life Month. In the Catholic Church and indeed in many faiths, the issues that the world wrestles with are brought to the forefront.*

There are Seven Themes Of Catholic Social Teaching. You can find these in greater detail at [www.usccb.org](http://www.usccb.org).

**Life and Dignity of the Human Person.** The Catholic Church proclaims that human life is sacred and that the dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision for society.

**Call to Family, Community, and Participation.** We believe people have a right and a duty to **participate in society**, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable.

**Rights and Responsibilities.** Every person has a fundamental **right to life** and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities--to one another, to our families, and to the larger society.

**Option for the Poor and Vulnerable.** In a society marred by deepening divisions between rich and poor, our tradition recalls the story of the Last Judgment (Mt 25:31-46) and instructs us to put the **needs of the poor and vulnerable first**.

**The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers.** The **economy must serve people**, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in Gods creation.

**Solidarity.** We are **one human family** whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences.

**Care for God's Creation.** Care for the earth is not just an Earth Day slogan, it is a requirement of our faith. We are called to protect people and the planet, living our faith in relationship with all of Gods creation. This environmental challenge has fundamental moral and ethical dimensions that cannot be ignored.

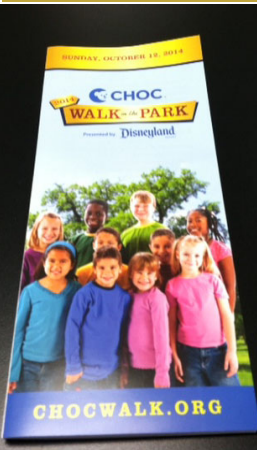
