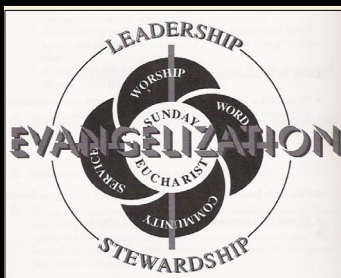

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE



A village really is needed for the Feast of the Holy Eucharist, the Mass, to come alive. Just look at the many ministers and ministries who assist at the celebration. Some of the duties of the Mass are not obvious, perhaps even unknown, while others are more front-and-center folk.

One of the most necessary and very much needed of the not-so-obvious ministries is that of **sacristan**. A sacristan prepares the sacristy, that place in the church where the sacred vessels, books, and church needs are kept. The sacristan also prepares the church itself for worship by simply making sure the lights are turned on, the doors are opened, and the climate is acceptable. This wonderful ministry is a saving grace to Father Luke and me and priests who visit our community. It requires being at church about one-half hour before the Mass is to begin. Duties include setting out the chalice, communion dishes (ciborium), the cruets (wine and water), and making sure the Roman Missal (prayer book) is close at hand. Following Mass the sacristan puts away what was used at the Mass he/she served, sort of over-see the altar servers to be sure the candles are extinguished, and closes the church unless another Mass follows. It might be a ministry you would want to do if your children are assigned as servers – your spouse a minister of communion or a reader. Hint – I would really appreciate having two reliable sacristans (one and a back-up) at each weekday and Sunday Mass. Hint - we have real need for reliable sacristans. I am very happy to teach the tricks of the trade which isn't real hard. You might want to talk to some of our sacristans who serve now. If you are able, interested, willing, generous, please contact me, Fr Mike, at the parish office, 714.853.1190. Men, women, college men/women, all good folks can be sacristans. Listen, God is calling you... Yep, that's God's voice won't you please respond? I am counting on you. So is the Lord!

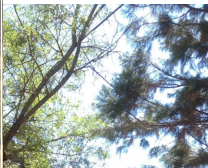
Two teams have been formed from the St. Juliana Community to honor and celebrate two students currently receiving treatment at CHOC Hospital.

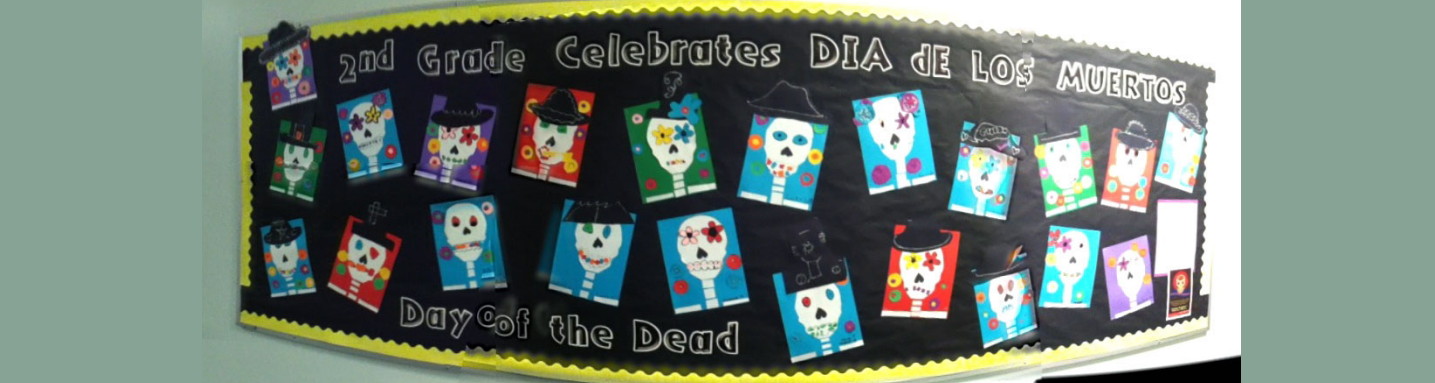
