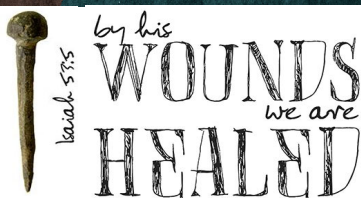

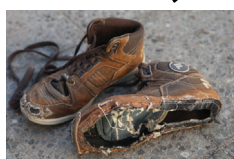

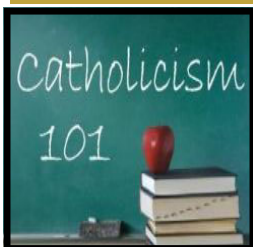

## CATHOLICISM 101



### What is the Synod of Bishops?

Over the past few months we have been hearing a lot about the Synod on the Family. Depending on which news agency you get your news from, you may have received only the political view of the event. This is important but there is so much more!

The Synod of Bishops is a permanent institution of the Catholic Church. It was established by Pope Paul VI in 1965, shortly after the close of the Second Vatican Council.

The Synod's main task is to continue the spirit of collegiality and communion that was present at the Second Vatican Council. Synods are comprised of bishops from around the world who assist the Holy Father by providing counsel on important questions facing the Church

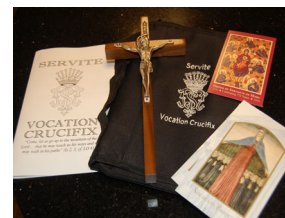

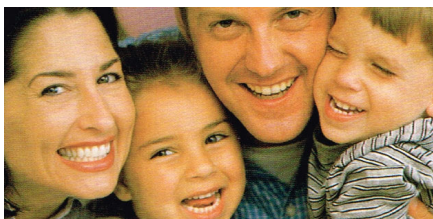

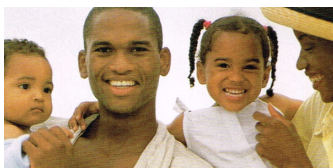
