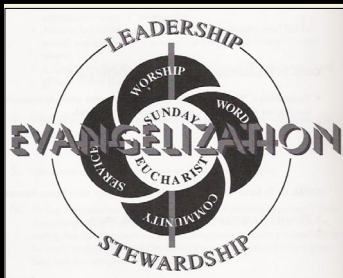

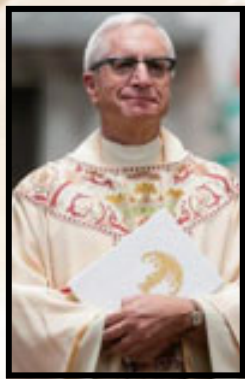

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Currently, the cathedral for the Diocese of Orange is Holy Family Cathedral in the city of Orange. The Holy Family is our patronal feast! How often do you put or do you see “holy” used as an adjective to describe “family”? Yet, in our faith, holy and family go together as naturally as Jiff extra-crunchy peanut butter and fig jelly!

As we read the Scriptures and believe what we read, we must live what we read and believe. That belief is that we are God’s chosen people. God created us in the beginning and continually chooses us to be in a special relationship with Him. Jesus tells us in the Holy Gospel of St. John 15:16-17 “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide: so that whatever you ask the father in my name, he may give it to you. This I command you, to love one another.”

On this Feast of the Holy Family we realize that we must become more than human, we must be holy seekers of perfection which is holiness. In baptism, being Christian has been added to being human. From our baptism we are not only the Cummins, Melodia, McClelland, Miramontes, Nguyen, or Gonzales family, we are also part of the Trinity Family. St. Juliana is also our faith family home and our address.

To become the family you are intended to become, look at the list of virtues St. Paul lists in Col 3:12-21. In your family cultivate: “heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if one has a grievance against another; forgive as the Lord has forgiven you. And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection.” Outside our church the world does not care much for these virtues. St. Paul’s task is that of conversion and it is indeed difficult! Thankfully, St. Paul gives us further instruction, the how-to-do-it kit. This is how we might accomplish the good deeds, the virtues, he listed: “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.” Psst, the world outside our doors doesn’t care much for choices made after prayer either!

As you return some of what Santa chose for you: clothes that didn’t fit, stuff that didn’t work, and find another family for the fruitcake, realize the importance of these virtues and they are what God has chosen for you.

Your family is our church community on a smaller scale. During the coming year, realize more deeply what it means to be chosen by Christ and become a Holy Family. It will be a great moment when the neighbors come to your door and you welcome them in. They tell you: “We’ve noticed something you have in your family that is missing in ours. We want to join your faith community. Where is it?” And you tell them your faith address is “St. Juliana at Acacia and Melody Lane in Fullerton. Come, join us!”

REFLECTION

~ WE ARE GOD’S HOLY FAMILY ~

The scriptures of Israel are filled with many stories of barren couples who were miraculously granted the gift of children by God. Surely the best known among these is the first reading from today, from which Luke took inspiration when he recounted the miraculous birth of John the Baptist to Zechariah and Elizabeth, and the more miraculous birth of Jesus to Mary and Joseph. In each instance, we are given examples or role models of those who trusted in God. More than examples of those who trust, they are models of self-surrender. They abandoned their own presuppositions and prejudices about the workings of the world and turned their lives over to belief in a God who can make life grow where none ought to; a God who can turn death around into a new and unimagined life; a God who can, today, take a tiny child of humble parents in an insignificant town and make him into a light for all the world. This is what we, as God’s holy family, are called to do each day: to trust not in ourselves and the way we think things should be, but to open ourselves and surrender ourselves in faith to a God of endless promise.

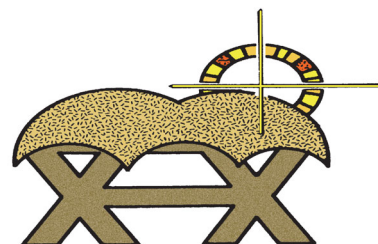
ADORATION

Adoration is now in the Church, not the Children’s Chapel.

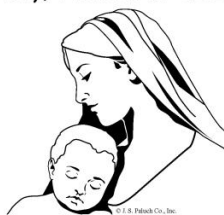

The feast of the Holy Family was instituted by Pope Leo XIII in 1893. A common practice among Catholics is to write "J.M.J" at the top of letters and personal notes as a reference to Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as the Holy Family.

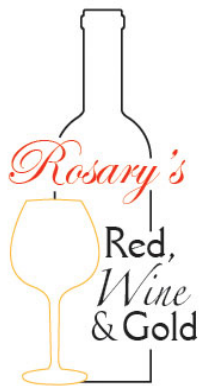
