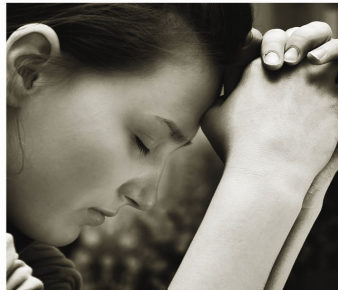
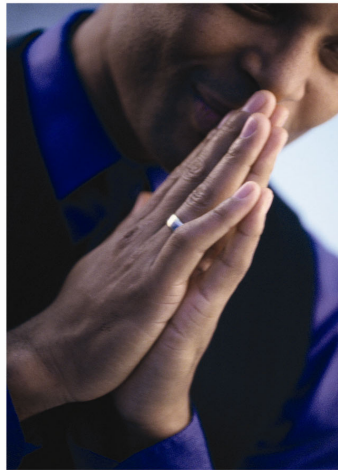

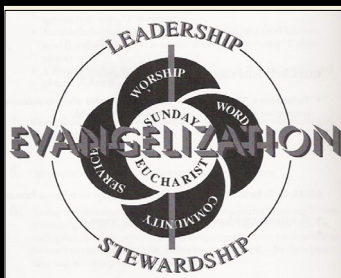

Of course, let us remember our dear Father Luke, O.S.M. as he celebrates his birthday this Thursday, February 27th. If you attend the 6:30 Mass that day, I am sure he would appreciate your prayers and heartfelt birthday wishes.

As we pray for vocations and honor our Servite priests, I would like to share some very encouraging news. In December of this past year, four youthful Servite Indonesian seminarians arrived in Chicago to begin their study of the English language and to continue their theological studies at Catholic Theological Union. They are presently living at our Servite Monastery and Basilica of Our Lady of Sor-

rows in Chicago. They will receive further formation in Servite life and after priestly ordination will serve in the United States for a period of time before returning to Indonesia.

The Servite Seminary in Indonesia is thriving. It is our hope that by supporting these young men they will persevere in their chosen vocation and one day minister in various parts of our Servite world where there is a need for Priests and Brothers. Certainly, we would welcome one of these young men to continue our Servite presence here at St. Juliana.

The names of these young seminarians are: **Hendrickus (Erik) Tanjung, Yolanda (Bonfilus) Hojasing, Leonardus (Leo) Hambur, and Sebastianus (Sebastian) Soy Mulu**. They are all in temporary vows leading to solemn vows as professed Servites and finally ordination to priesthood. They have finished two years of philosophy and theology in Malang, Indonesia.

Our Knights of Columbus have been very proactive in supporting seminarians and I am sure that St. Juliana parishioners would be happy to sponsor one or more of these young men to help pay for their education and daily needs. Silence can be challenging in a society that thrives on noise, distraction, social media, and work. Men need quiet time. In an article in the magazine, **Tidings**, the author Randy Hain sets down six obstacles to being authentically Catholic. He writes: **1) Fear of people not liking the real us. Fear of not fitting in. Fear of being judged. Fear of persecution for our religious beliefs; 2) Lack of confidence in our opinions. Lack of courage to defend the truth. Lack of knowledge about our faith; 3) Attachment to an income level and lifestyle that requires unhealthy compromises; 4) Conforming to society's tolerance and acceptance of things which are in direct conflict with our faith, values, and principles; 5) Relaxing our standards because it is easier to go along with the crowd than take a stand; 6) A lack of self-awareness. Do we even know there is a problem?**

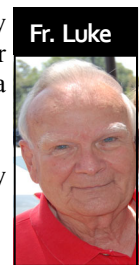

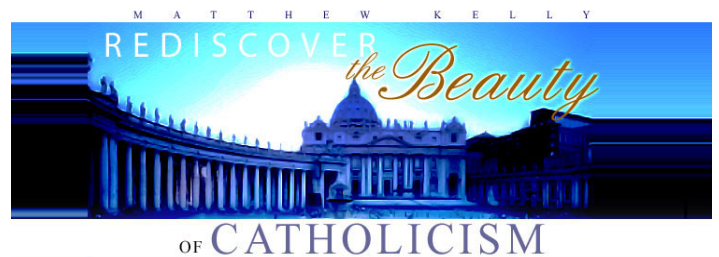

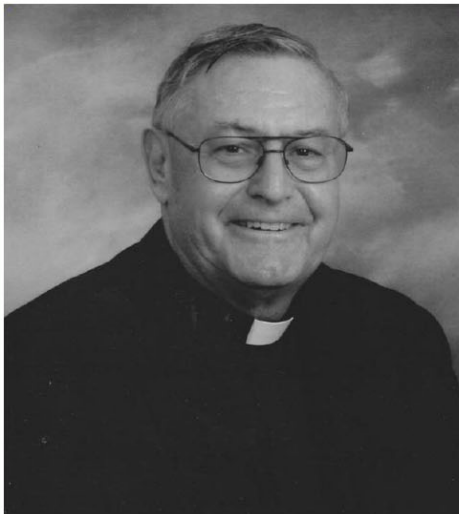
