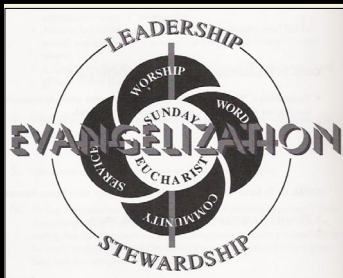

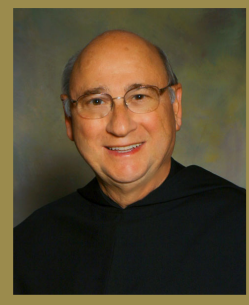

In the five years I have had the privilege of serving as parish priest and pastor here I have learned a great many things about you and about myself. One of the many God-given traits of St. Juliana parishioners is your in-born, almost intuitive sense of responsibility and commitment. This is most obvious in my experience with your consistent **generosity**.

During the past fifteen years you have literally raised millions of dollars to expand the parish facilities, support Diocesan pastoral services, finance mission and charitable causes, aid the poor, and subsidize the parish school and the Religious Education program. This on-going beneficence also covers many lesser enterprises not to mention your kindness to the Servite community here at St. Juliana. If I were to single out one amazing feature of parochial life during my time it would be your **generosity**.

In the book of the prophet Isaiah in the Jewish Scriptures we read words of comfort addressed to the Israelites returning from captivity in Babylon. Isaiah tells these returning exiles in chapter 55: 1-3, **All you who are thirsty come to the water....come, receive grain and eat; come without paying and without cost... come to me heedfully, listen, that you may have life...**

What Isaiah is saying is that God is a **generous** God. There is no limit, no boundaries and no restrictions on his **generosity**. And we don't have to earn it or try to prove we are worthy of God's blessings. We do our best. We live good lives. But even in our messiness and sin, our mistakes and failings, God never deprives us of his love and **generosity**.

The dictionary defines **generosity**: "Free in giving or sharing; high minded; noble, abundant, ample, copious." That is our God and much more!

We then ask ourselves these questions: "Where and when have I experienced God's **generosity** in my life? What are the signs of his **generosity** right here and now?"

I remember an occurrence in the early years of my priesthood. I was assigned to a parish as the new associate. This was a promising assignment since the three older priests also assigned were nearing retirement. It turned out to be a very difficult first year, since I was young, newly ordained, and a product more or less of Vatican II. The rub came when it was time to use the one car we shared. Guess who was the last in line to use the car? Well, anyway, I did my best to adjust. Then one day, after having spilled my soul to a parishioner about how I wanted to take a few days off but could never get the car, the doorbell rang. Standing with his hands outstretched, car keys dangling and a plastic credit card, was Jim, the parishioner. "Here, Father, take the car, get away, and charge the gas." I'll never forget his **generosity** to me at a time when I was sad and vulnerable.

Another time I remember **generosity** was during a trip from St. Louis to Chicago. I was traveling with my own car during the Christmas season to visit my family. As I was cruising down Interstate 55, I began to notice that I was the only one on the

expressway. Then suddenly the car began to turn sideways and slide down the open lanes for at least a quarter of a mile before I skidded into a ditch. The Interstate was a sheet of ice. Now I knew why no one was traveling. As I sat stunned with little hope of rescue, along came a pickup truck with two young men. They turned the truck sideways, hitched a chain, pulled me out, and left me to continue my journey wiser and more cautious. They never asked for anything. They did it "freely, high minded; noble, abundant, ample and copious."

The greatest sign of God's **generosity**, I believe, is experienced in **generous** people who reach out to others without thought of their own comfort or need. Sometimes the poorest people are the ones who give the most because they possess a "**generous spirit**." Others live what the Bible refers to as a higher righteousness. They are **generous** not because of flattery or pride but because **generosity** is an attribute of God. Their sentiment is, if God has blessed me so much, how much more I want to bless others.

Every year more than 9 million Americans give one or more pints of blood to benefit people they never met. Nearly half of all American adults do some kind of volunteer work on a regular basis.

Possessing a **generous spirit** means I am willing to put aside some of my own comfort for another. It means I am aware of how God has blessed me and therefore I desire to bless others. A **generous spirit** helps me not only to reach out to others, but it helps to make me a happier and more loving person. **Generosity** makes it possible for me to be kinder, gentler, and less judgmental. Lastly, to possess a **generous spirit** is also to possess a **healing spirit**. **Generosity** promotes healing for those who suffer low self-esteem, or feel hopeless, alone, or afraid.

In the end, people of faith realize that **generosity** is an attribute of God whose mercy and love are both free and limitless. We are instruments of God's beneficence and in whatever manner we share according to the gifts we possess and nurture, to that extent will we help create peace and prosperity for all God's children.

The late Father Anthony de Mello, S.J was a great story teller. Many of his anecdotes stem from his study of Eastern religions. He tells the story of a rather prosperous business man disturbed by a tramp who stood in the doorway of his office asking for alms. He rang for his secretary and said, "Do you see this poor unfortunate man here? Observe how his toes stick out of his shoes, how frayed his trousers are, how tattered his coat. I am sure the man hasn't had a shave, a shower or a decent meal in days. It breaks my heart to see people in this wretched condition--so get him out of my sight at once!"

Father de Mello then followed with another story. A great religious persecution broke out in the land and the three Pillars of religion---Scripture, Worship, and Charity---appeared before God to express their fear that if religion was stamped out, they would cease to exist. "Not to worry," said the Lord, "I plan to send One to earth who is greater than all of you." "By what name is this **Great One** called?" "Self-Knowledge," said God. "He will do greater things than any of you have done."

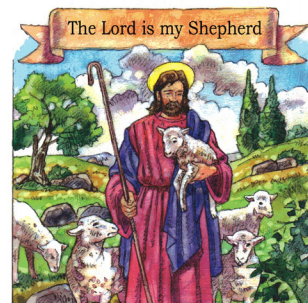

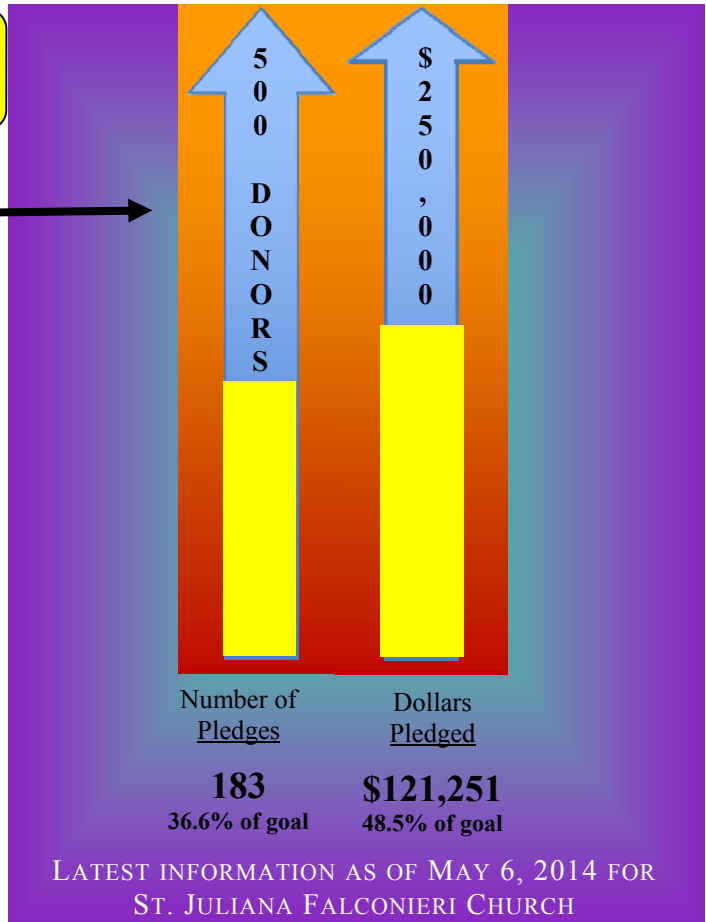


Our PSA 2014 campaign began in late March and to date we have received 183 responses totaling \$121,251. Our pledges range from \$5 - \$12,000.

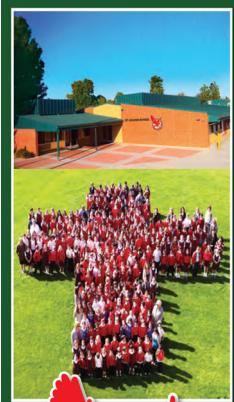
Our diocesan assessment is \$108,000. We have officially met our goal—now, every pledge paid and received over \$108,000 will be returned to St. Juliana.
