PSA UPDATE 2014



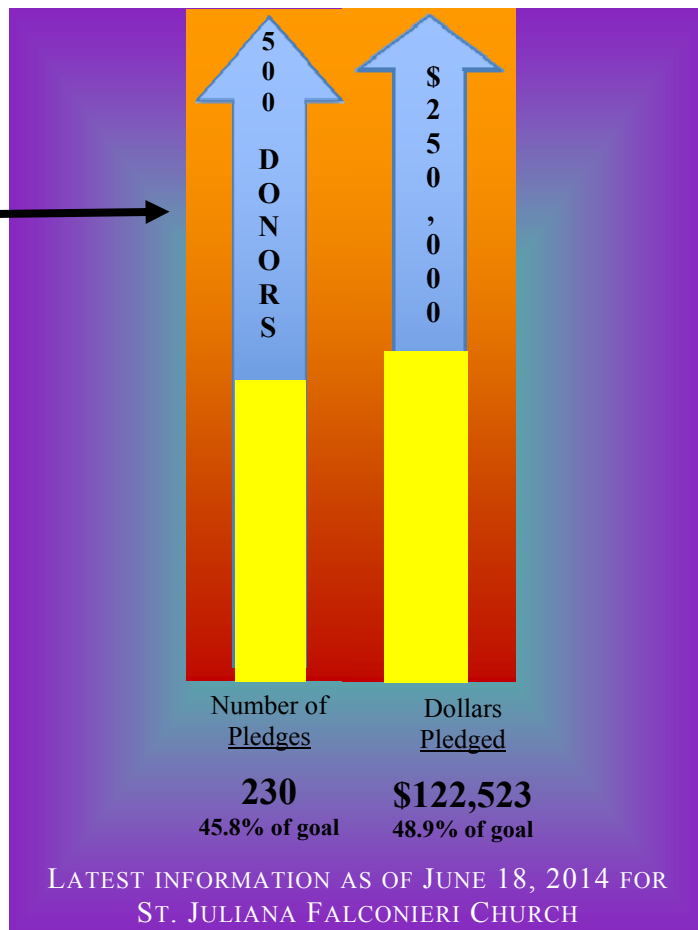
Our PSA 2014 campaign began in late March and to date we have received 230 responses totaling \$122,523. Our pledges range from \$5 - \$12,000.

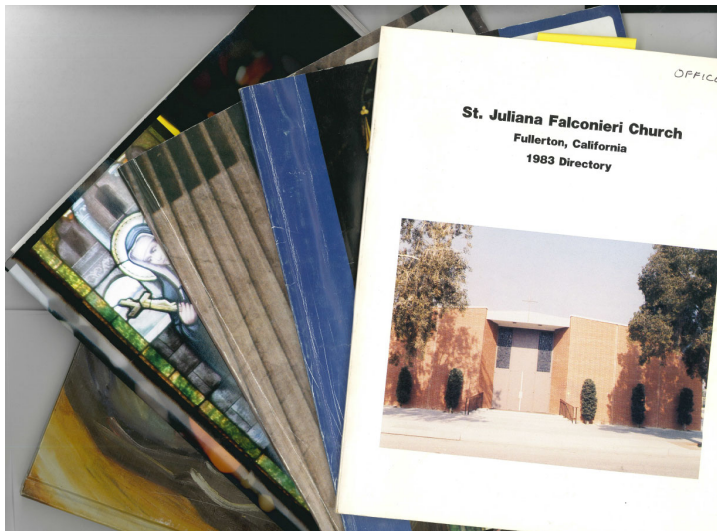
