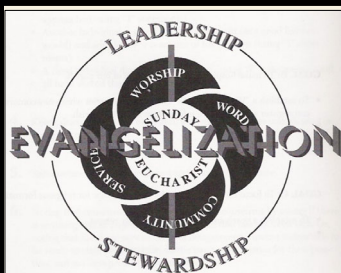

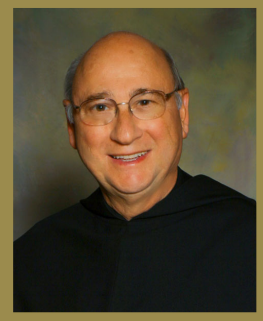

For the past five years I have enjoyed writing to you. While it is not possible to interact with every parishioner in a personal way, penning this weekly missive helps to bring us closer and to establish a written history of the parish from at least the pastor's point of view. Obviously, not everything that happens can be written about, but I believe I have made an attempt to share with you many of the important moments of the past five years.

**Now is the time to say goodbye and share with you my last column.** This Sunday evening I leave by train for a week's vacation and then the following week I will be in Chicago for our annual Servite Provincial Chapter. Father Luke will be attending the Chapter as well (June 16 - 20) and the daily liturgies will alternate between Mass and a Holy Communion service the week of June 16th. Deacons Gerhard and Chuck will cover the Communion Services that week and Fr. Aaron Riomales will be here for some of the morning Masses.

I'll return to the parish for my final week on Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup> in time to welcome Bishop Vann for his first weekend pastoral visit and the *Feast of St. Juliana Falconieri, O.S.M.* I am really excited about the Bishop's visit and the festivities surrounding St. Juliana's special day.

Bishop Vann will have dinner and stay at the rectory on Saturday evening. He will hear confessions in Church on Saturday at the regular time: 3:30 p.m. On Saturday afternoon he will meet with the parish staff, pastoral council, finance council, and all parish leaders; about 30 plus parishioners. He plans to call on one or two homebound parishioners who might enjoy a visit from him. During his visit he will also examine the sacramental books to see that they are in order and as is customary, sign the books attesting to their accuracy.

On Sunday, Bishop Vann will preach at the Sunday morning Masses and preside at the 9 a.m. Mass. While it will be the liturgical calendar *Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)*, we will include prayers from the feast of St. Juliana which is actually on June 19<sup>th</sup>. Because Corpus Christi is a major feast day in the Church calendar, we cannot replace it with the Mass of St. Juliana. Nevertheless, the outdoor festivities will be joyous and St. Juliana will know that she is not forgotten.

If you would like to volunteer to help with the feast day, please contact the office. We will need e-z ups to help supplement the ones owned by the parish to shade the food distribution and *Chili Cook Off!* There will be games and prizes for the children along with train rides, a visit from the Fullerton Fire and Police Departments, and other surprises. I hope you will attend.

Don't forget that Father's Day is just around the corner. I was happy to see that the Father's day Mass cards in the back of church have all been taken and hopefully used.

This weekend we celebrate the feast of *Pentecost*...fifty days after Easter. Originally a Jewish feast day, *Shavu'ot* celebrates fifty days after *Passover*. *Shavu'ot* is also known as Pentecost (Greek word for fifty) however it has no particular similarity to the Christian holiday of *Pentecost*. *Shavu'ot* is known as the

*Festival of Weeks* and is the second of three major festivals with both historical and agricultural significance (the other two are Passover and Sukkot). Agriculturally, it commemorates the time when the first fruits were harvested and brought to the Temple, and is known as the *Festival of the First Fruits*. Historically, it celebrates the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai, and is known as the *Festival of the Giving of Our Torah*.

The counting of fifty days reminds Jews of the important connection between Passover and Shavu'ot: Passover freed them physically from bondage, but the giving of the Torah (the Law) on Shavu'ot redeemed them spiritually from bondage to idolatry and immorality.

In the Christian tradition *Pentecost* celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus as described in the Acts of the Apostles and often called the "Birthday of the Church."

*Pentecost* is the final manifestation of the Holy Spirit in the New Testament accounts. We read: "**Suddenly, there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.**"

The role of the Holy Spirit is to help all people speak a common language that reaches out in service to others. St. Paul has it right when he reminds the Galatians that they will know the language of the Holy Spirit when you, "love, have joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, generosity, faithfulness, self-control..." How many times have we met people who speak a different mother tongue but we feel love in their presence? How many times have we travelled to a foreign country and despite the language hardship have experienced kindness and generosity? How often have we met people who cannot speak or are mentally disabled but are gentle and explode with joy?

The Holy Spirit is at work not only in these exceptional moments but also among those who are different in race, religion, or national origin. When we see the world through the eyes of the Holy Spirit we see one family living in harmony and peace with each other.

Father's Day celebration is 104 years old and it was first celebrated in Washington by Sonora Dodd on June 19, 1910 and was proclaimed the third Sunday in June as Father's Day in 1966 by President Johnson. In 1972 President Nixon signed a public law stating annual official Father's Day.

As we bless our fathers, we are reminded of things you will never hear a father say: "**Your mother and I are going away for the weekend. Why don't you invite a dozen friends around for a party?**" The vocabulary of a father: **Feedback: The inevitable result when the baby doesn't appreciate the strained carrots. Independent: How we want our children to be for as long as they do everything we say. Whodunit: None of the children who live in your house. Bottle-feeding: An opportunity for Daddy to get up at 2 am.**

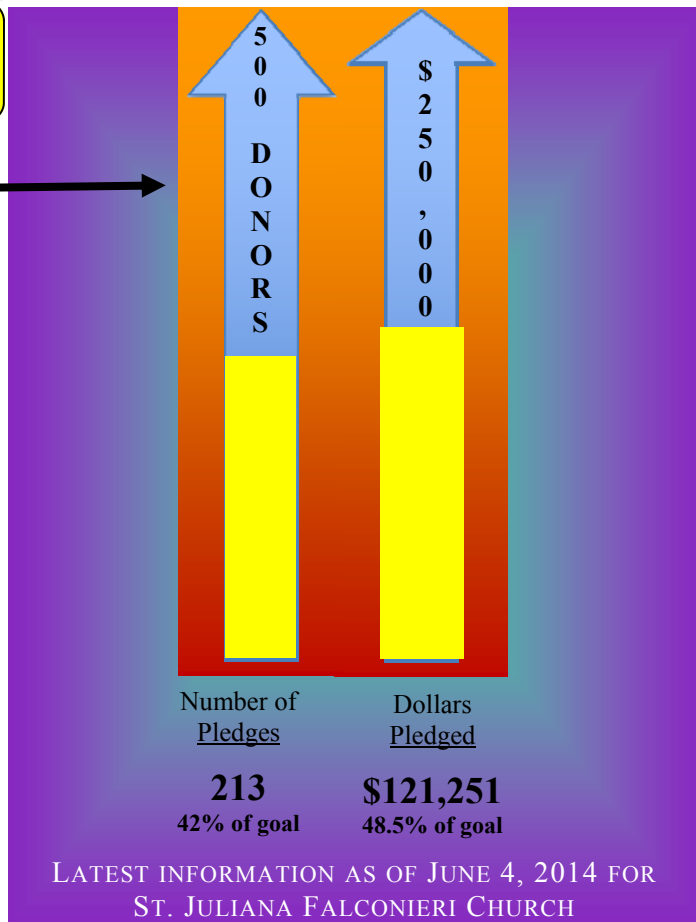
Our PSA 2014 campaign began in late March and to date we have received 213 responses totaling \$121,251. Our pledges range from \$5 - \$12,000.
