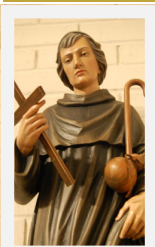

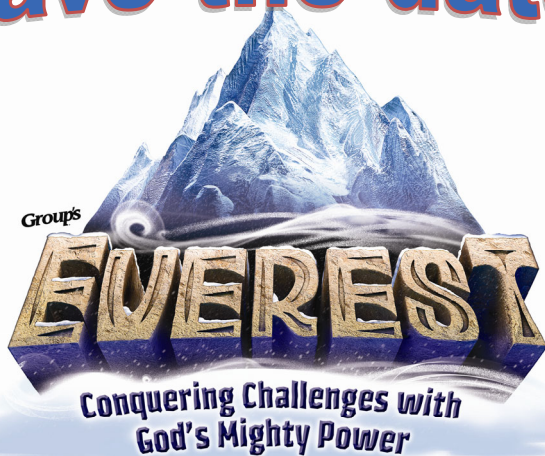

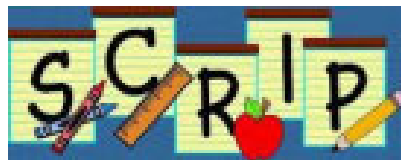
### SUMMER ARTS-N-CRAFTS

**PSA UPDATE 2014**



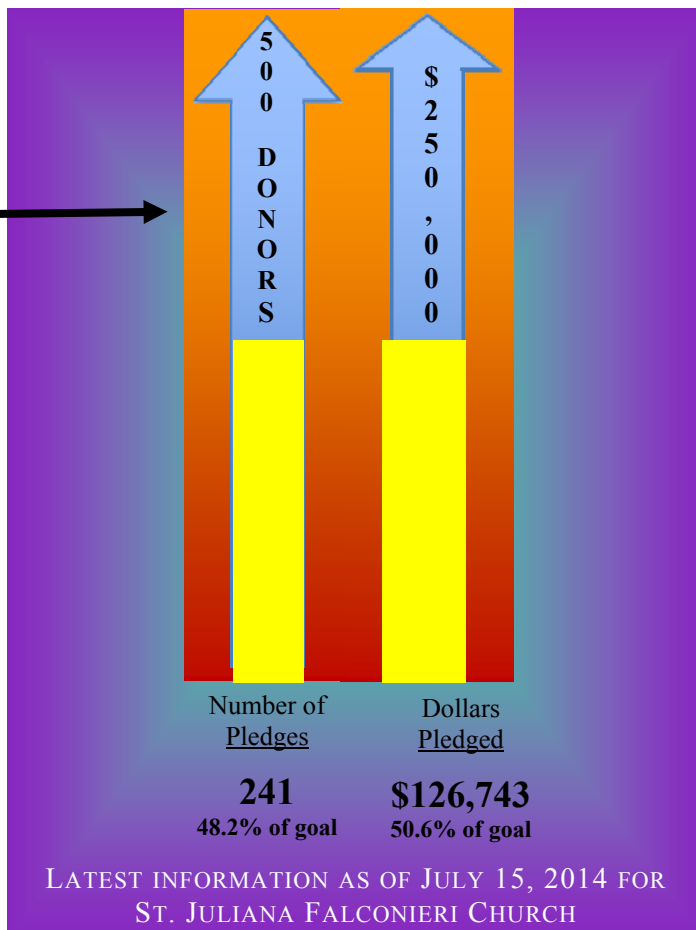
Our PSA 2014 campaign began in late March and to date we have received 241 responses totaling \$126,743. Our pledges range from \$5 - \$12,000.

From my platoon to you, thank you again and God Bless!”

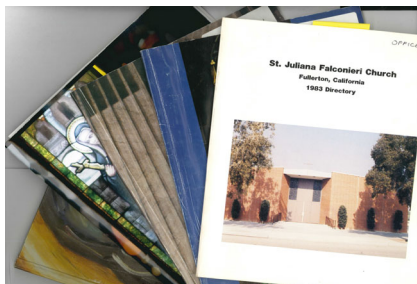
