CATHOLICISM 101

Ordinary Time. Or is it?



Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" simply because the weeks are numbered not because it's mundane or "unimportant. The Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Thus, Ordinary Time is in fact the ordered life of the Church. It's appropriate, therefore, that the Gospel for the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time (which is actually the first Sunday celebrated in Ordinary Time) always features either John the Baptist's acknowledgment of Christ as the Lamb of God or Christ's first miracle—the transformation of water into wine at the wedding at Cana.

Thus for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. That's why there's nothing "ordinary" about Ordinary Time!

PSA UPDATE 2014



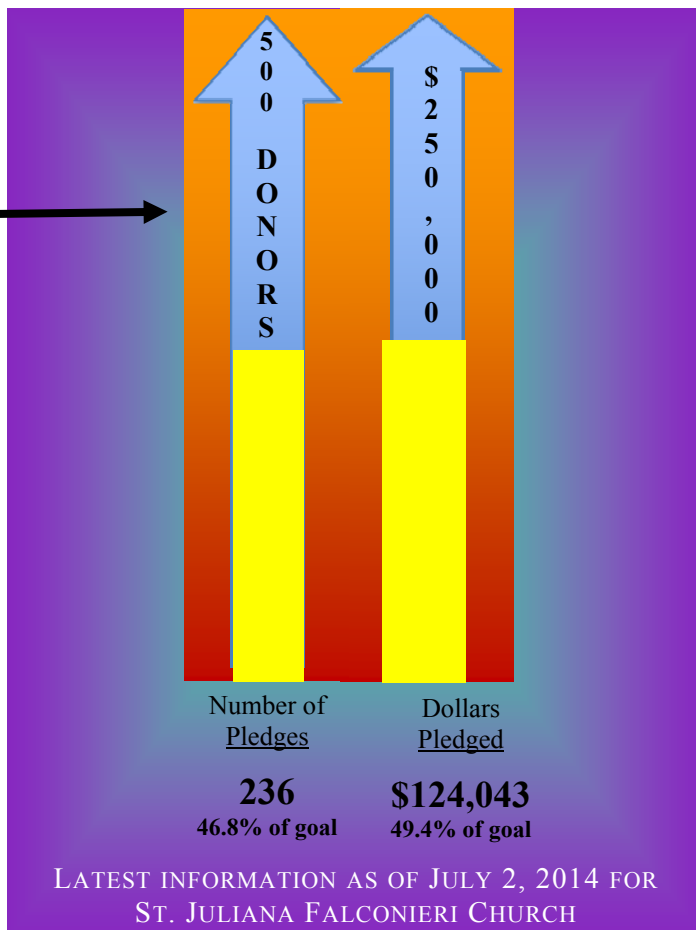
Our PSA 2014 campaign began in late March and to date we have received 236 responses totaling \$124,043. Our pledges range from \$5 - \$12,000.

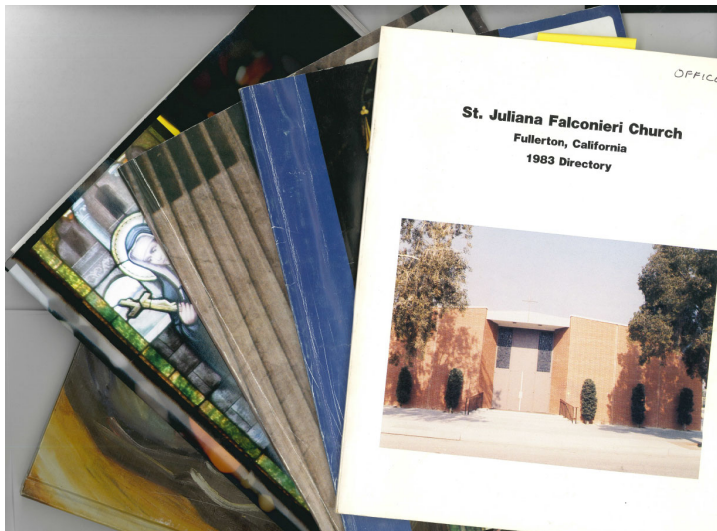
