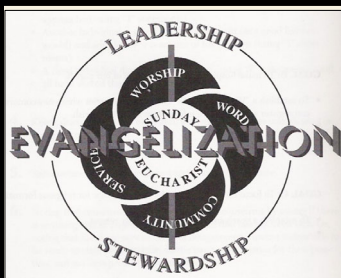

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE, O.S.M.



I've sometimes wanted to storm to "their" office – those guys, they've got to be guys, they are in the Vatican- and ask them how often they preach. Those guys who chop up the Bible into the readings for each day, including Sundays. They really get under my skin from time-to-time. I'm convinced they don't preach daily homilies and not always on Sundays. Today's gospel lesson is but one example. I read the readings, all three, and my fillings fused. How and why were these readings chosen?

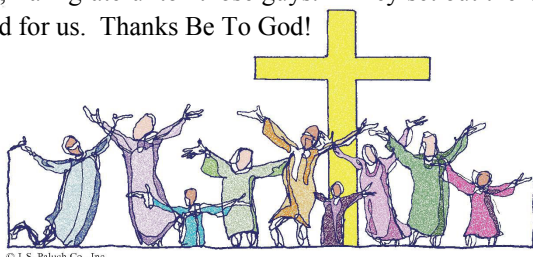
In charity to "those guys", just how did they choose to chop up the whole Bible into bite-sized pieces to be used in the first part of the Mass we call "the Liturgy of the Word"? Which Biblical verses from the whole Bible both parts Old and New Testament, should be read aloud and which should not be chosen? No easy task!

The book of readings is called the "Lectionary." Generally the first reading is from the Old Testament, although during Easter it comes from the Acts of the Apostles. The second reading is from the New Testament. The Gospel, of course is from one of the four Gospels. But that ain't the whole answer! There are the seasons of the year; Christmas, Easter, Advent, Lent, and Ordinary time. Added to these special feasts are the Ascension, Corpus Christi, other feasts of the Lord, feasts of Mary, etc. Add special saints and martyrs, as well as dedications of basilicas, which makes it more difficult. Yikes!

On Sundays, the first reading is related to the Gospel lesson, the Psalm is chosen to respond to the first reading. The second reading is a semi-continuous reading of New Testament writings. The Gospel reading is a more-or-less read through of the Gospels which are similar, the Synoptic Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke. John's Gospel is read during the Easter season and at other times in the various cycles. The cycle for Sundays is three years, years A, B, and C. For weekdays there is a two-year cycle of readings.

It's all rather complicated. I guess I should lay-off of "those guys." They have given us a good look at the Bible as a way we can meet the Lord, know the Lord, and live in His ways. If at the end of the cycles I can say: "Yes, I am a friend of the Lord and I begin to understand His un-common ways", the Liturgy of the Word has accomplished its purpose. That purpose is our conversion. Listen carefully. Believe what you hear. Live what you believe.

In the end, I am grateful to "those guys." They set out the Word of the Lord for us. Thanks Be To God!

ST. PHILIP BENIZI BLESSING NEXT SUNDAY

Next Sunday we celebrate the feast of St. Philip Benizi, O.S.M. with the blessing of water and bread. This blessing recalls the time Philip and a companion visited the Servite friars in Arezzo during a famine. The food ran out and Philip prayed with the friars for relief. Mysteriously baskets of bread and jugs of water appeared at the door. From that time this miracle has been associated with his feastday. St. Philip was born in Florence in 1233. He was ordained a priest and in 1267 elected Prior General of the Order. He is most noted for his wisdom and courage as he enacted laws governing the growth of the Order. Because of his strong influence, he has been considered a "father of the Order." He died in 1285 at Todi and canonized by Pope Clement X in 1671.

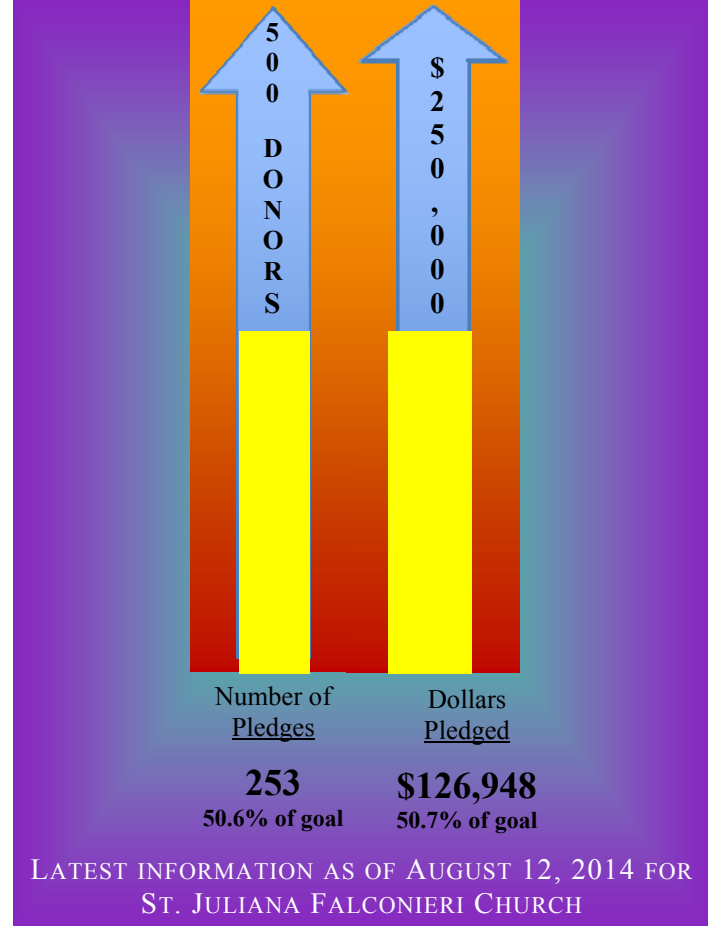

MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE OF ORANGE PRAYER FOR PEACE IN IRAQ
