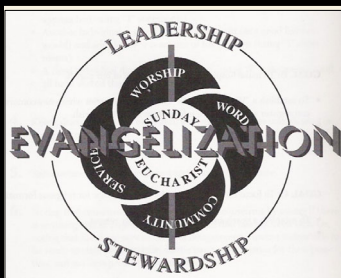

**PENNIES FROM HEAVEN UPDATE**

As of Sept. 7, the total of the donations for the Pennies From Heaven Collection is at \$5,170.97. There are still 130 bottles that have not been returned. Some people have indicated that they are holding on to them to fill for next years collection. We just want to make sure we have enough bottles to hand out next year without having to purchase a lot more. Next weekend, Sept. 21 will be the last weekend that the Pennies From Heaven basket will be in the vestibule. Please turn them in by then so the bottles can be put in the bins and taken out of the vestibule and stored before Festival weekend. When we were feeding the coins into the coin machine at the Schools First Bank the last weekend of August, the total # of pennies was 31,652. We should have the final amount of the collection by the beginning of October. The final figure from the Diocese for last years collection from all the participating parishes was \$235,661.85. That figure is twice the amount of what the collection brought in before the baby bottle hand-out started. Now there are 15 facilities in the Orange Diocese that depend on this collection for their yearly operating costs. And they are so grateful for this assistance so they can continue their life giving work. A big THANK YOU to all who contributed so generously. God Bless You!

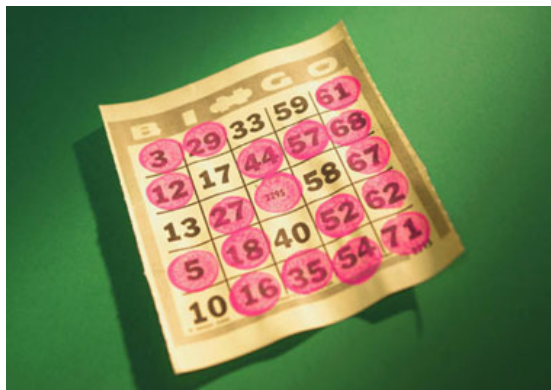
