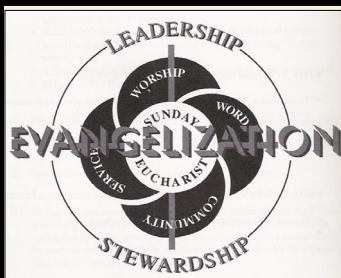

CATHOLICISM 101

The Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary was celebrated at least by the sixth century and first appears in written form about A.D. 150.



It is from that, we learn the names of Mary's parents, Joachim and Anna, as well as the tradition that the couple was childless until an angel appeared to Anna and told her that she would conceive.

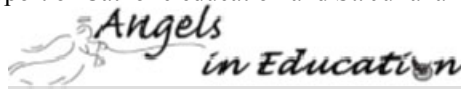
The traditional date of the feast, September 8, falls exactly nine months after the feast of the **Immaculate Conception of Mary**, perhaps because of its close proximity to the feast of the Assumption of Mary. The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary is not celebrated today with the same solemnity as the Immaculate Conception. It is, nonetheless, a very important feast, because it prepares the way for the birth of Christ. *Theotokos* is the Greek title of *Mary, the mother of Jesus*. Cardinal Wojtyla's motto was **TOTUS TUUS** meaning "All Yours" in reference to Mary. Cardinal Wojtyla eventually became Pope John Paul II.

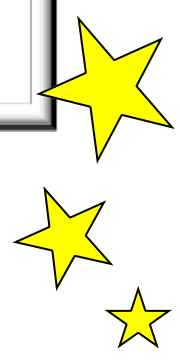
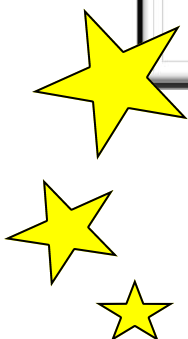
