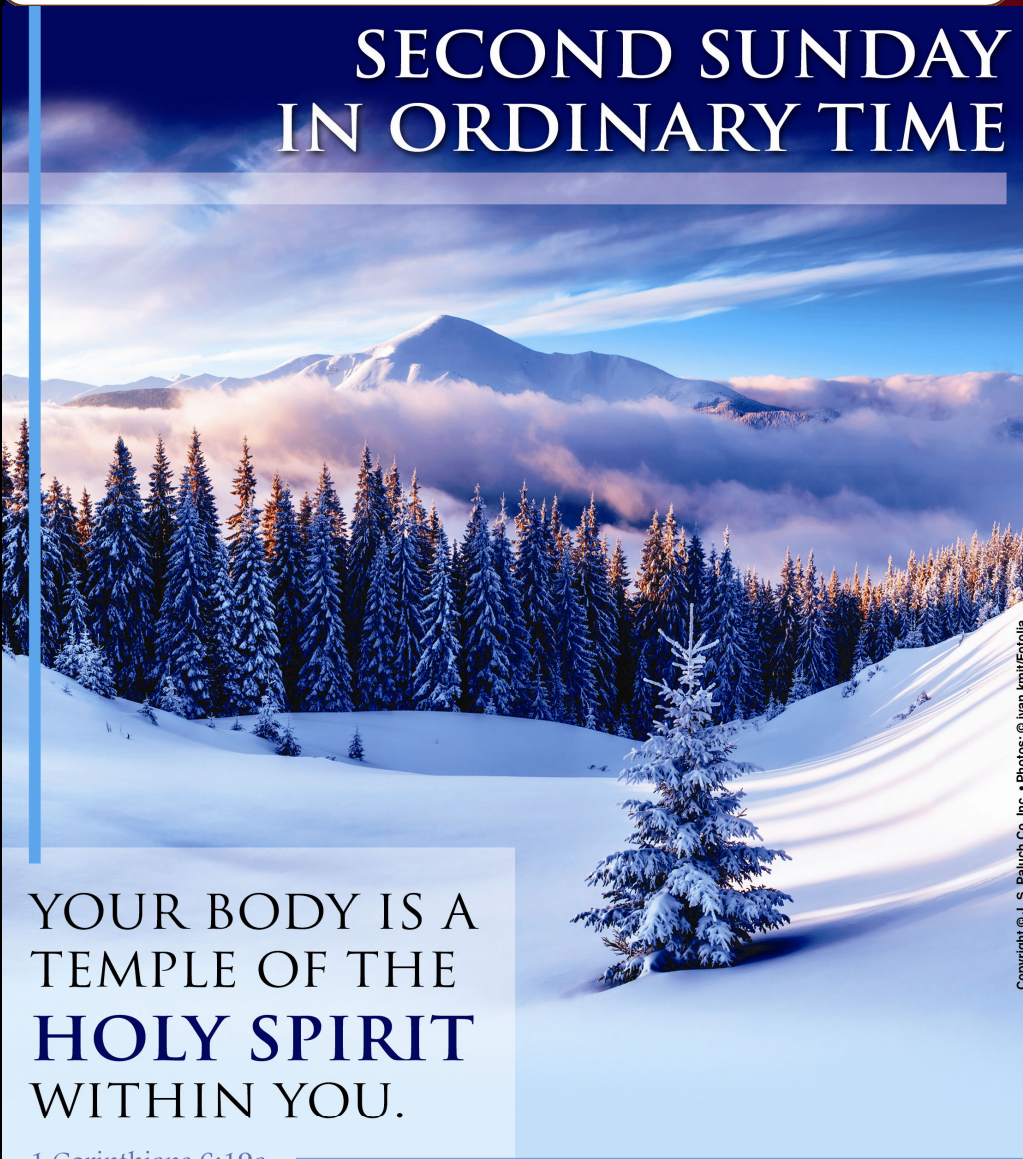

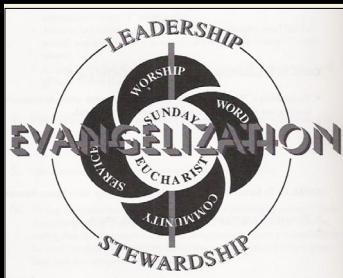

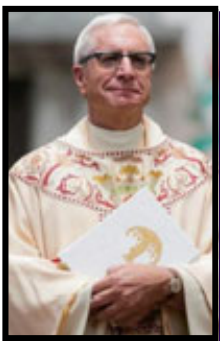

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



The Christmas season has become Ordinary Time. Yes, ordinary – the decorations are gone, the Christmas songs are gone, the guests are gone, and the children are gone. The weight gain, well that's another story!

Ordinary time is that time when we live our Catholic Christian lives in our school, work, family, and shopping malls. How will your companions know you are a Catholic? How do you evangelize?

Today is the Second Sunday in Ordinary time. The Sunday cycle of readings is "Year B." I guess it's our time to B or not to B! Corny, but it works!

I assume that the potential disciples whom Jesus approached were already good men. There is no evidence of any violence or records of criminal behavior among them. Neither is there evidence of academic learning or Fortune 500 life-styles among them. I also assume they are quite ordinary people. Their lives are good but not great. Like all of us they are looking for what might make them great. Even the great search for more. We do this until we discover a secret. Don't we?

Most of the time when asked: "What makes this grammar or high school good?" the answer is "I can get into a good college!" "What makes that college good?" "Well, I can get a good job!" "What makes that job good?" "In this life, one thing counts, in the bank large amounts...money!" And then a thundering realization happens, my phone rings and an appointment is made. The one with a good education and good job sits and asks me: "Father, is this all there is?" "Well, Peggy Lee...no, there is more!"

What are you really looking for? What is it that will really make you not just happy but also joy-filled? What will be the reason-to-keep you going, that will last, no matter what? Jesus does not book-teach the answer many of us learned under fear of punishment from the good old *Baltimore Catechism*, specifically question four with the star before it: "What must I do to gain the happiness of heaven? To gain the happiness of heaven I must know, love, and serve God in this world." Nope, Jesus says: "Come and see. I'll **show** you!" Let me show you the way to love – if you want to live your life, love one another. Let me show you. That will only happen if you are in a real relationship with the Lord!

During Ordinary Time, let Jesus show you how to live your life. He demonstrated love for one another with his life. Let your life be used in love for one another. Recall what is attributed to St. Francis: "Preach the gospel at all time. If necessary, use words." Show your classmates, office staff, neighbor the joy of following Jesus. Do it one day at a time.

This is our time to be Catholic Christians. It's something that you do ordinarily. Right? Just show one another!

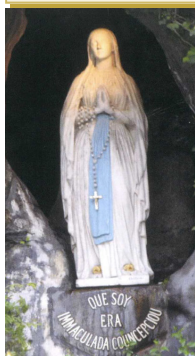

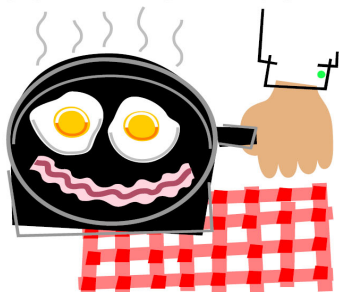

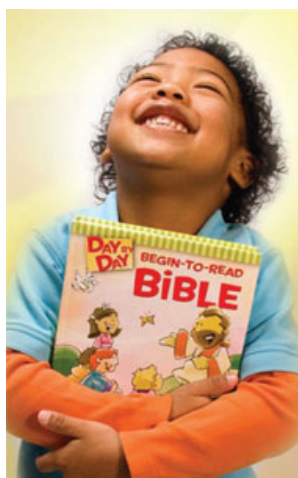

Liturgy of the Word Adapted for Children
9:00am and 11:00am Sunday Masses

The Liturgy of the Word Adapted for Children at St. Juliana is a special part of the 9:00am and 11:00am Sunday Liturgy. The children are invited to hear the Word of God in a version of the Sunday scripture specially prepared by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and approved for children. The children are taught about the story of Jesus' life, death and resurrection and the continuing mission of the church as witness in the world.

At the beginning of Mass, the children are called forth by the celebrant, blessed, and then led to a prepared room by an adult leader. Through the "Liturgy of the Word", we seek to involve the children in the liturgy--the joy of song, the holiness of silence and the richness of ritual.

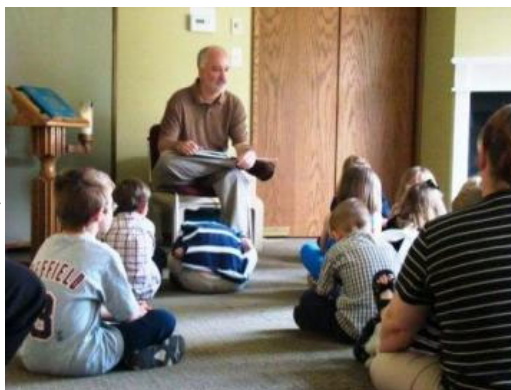


We want to show each child that they are important participants in the liturgy of God's Word and we seek to show them the Wonder of God's Word. The children return to their families at Offertory to participate in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The program is not only open to members of our parish, but visitors as well. There is no cost to attend the program, just a simple information sheet. A child may participate in as many Sundays as he/she wishes. The program runs year round during 9:00am and 11:00am Masses. **The Liturgy of the Word for Children is intended for children grades 1-5.** Parents of children younger than 1st grade should inquire about our Sunday School program.

Adult volunteers are always needed to lead and assist in this great and rewarding ministry.

There is no teaching experience required. Training and all materials are provided.

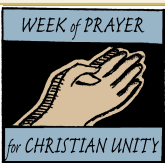
CATHOLICISM 101

The term "Ordinary Time" may be misleading. In the context of the liturgical year the term "ordinary" does not mean "usual or average." Ordinary here means "not seasonal." Ordinary Time is that part of the Liturgical Year that lies outside the seasons of Lent-Easter and Advent-Christmas. In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its aspects. The readings during the liturgies of Ordinary Time help to instruct us on how to live out our Christian faith in our daily lives. The Liturgical color turns from the Christmas Time white to green. In this liturgical season the Church eagerly follows Our Lord as he gathers his apostles and announces his mission. At Cana's wedding feast (The Second Luminous Mystery) he performs his first public miracle at the request of his Mother, and his disciples saw his glory and believed in him. We, his present-day disciples, pray for a like faith as we contemplate the eternal wedding feast of the Lamb and the unique role of the Blessed Mother in the plan of salvation. May we wholeheartedly obey her words of counsel: "Do whatever he tells you."

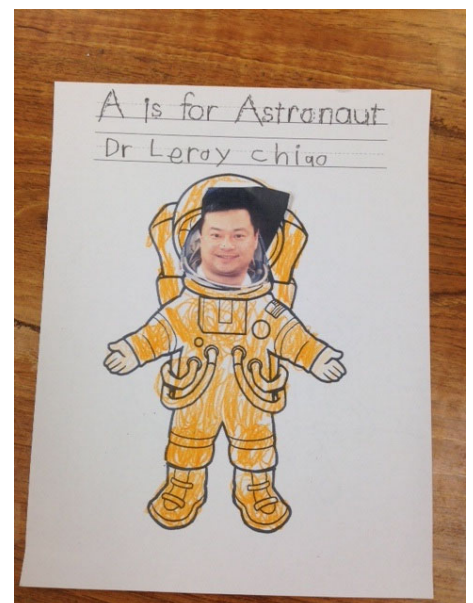

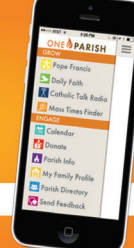
