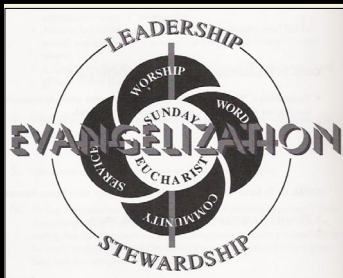

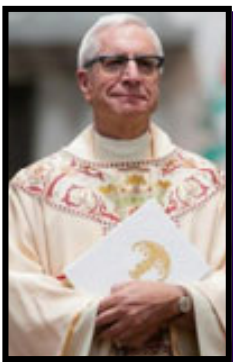

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Quite often I didn't know what a good time was until it had passed far into the rear-view mirror. Ask this question: "How was grammar school?" I will answer you today: "Much better than I realized at the time!" I am a veteran of "Anaheim's Little Army." I am a graduate of Saint Catherine's Academy. I am a product of Roman Catholic education ~ many years of it. Tuition was paid by my working mother; dad died (was killed really) in an accident during the summer between my third and fourth grade. No tuition assistance for grammar or high school was offered or available ~ just sacrifice. Yet, today I wouldn't have had it any other way. I don't regret one dime Mom spent for my Catholic education.

Today I recall the school lessons and my teachers with great fondness. Each morning an army of Dominican Sisters came from their convent to the classrooms. They were young then. A few dedicated men who told battle stories of WWII and military decorations to support their war claims also taught. They were my great mentors. There was a certain *gravitas* in the classroom. Certainly, we did our best to get the teachers off the topic and we were class clowns. Teachers did stray and told us how highly they valued their religious community and the way they defended our country. Their actions were consistent with their words. I heard endless lessons of the saints and all the men and women who are on the mural at St Catherine's Chapel. (If you have never been there, visit its spiritual beauty.) With pride we were also taught about our national and local leaders. Graduates returned with regularity to tell us how the school prepared them for life.

That school gave me identity. It gave me a foundation for life's lessons. It gave my mom community and friends. It gave us both a place to practice our faith. The student body was a mixed breed. Boys from varied socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and national backgrounds were my classmates. Ella Fitzgerald, The Mills Brothers, Marlin Brando, Dennis Day, William Tallman, and other Hollywood types enrolled their children in my school. Can you imagine, these parents hung out on campus!

Today, Catholic grammar school education is doing the same for our school students as it did for me. Its mission, to teach the Gospel and make disciples, has not changed. St. Juliana School's administration, faculty, and staff are dedicated in their vocation to form the next generation of Church in the practice of our faith and the glory of our nation. Our own students are lively; ready to learn, eager to compete in athletics, and excited to grow in the arts. Not to mention they like it here!

I really want each of us to know St. Juliana as a religious woman who was dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament and to learning our faith, a trait she saw in St. Alexis Falconieri, one of the Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order.

Our school and parish community will continue its mission of liturgy and learning because our school students learn it. They have what the Catholic school has always had, one direction and enlightened mentors leading the way.

As we begin Catholic Schools week, please visit St. Juliana School. Please notice the students and their school work. Please thank the administrators, faculty, and staff. Pray that the good work begun in the school, fifty years ago, continues with faith, pride, and courage.

Fifty Years! A Golden Jubilee. Remember our past. Celebrate your accomplishments. Believe there is a bright future.
