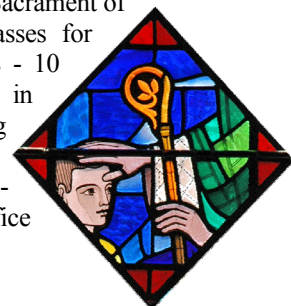
**Christ's Baptism
Foreshadows Our Own**

Many of the Fathers of the Church, as well as the medieval scholastics, saw Christ's Baptism as the institution of the sacrament. His Flesh blessed the water, and the descent of the Holy Spirit (in the form of a dove) and the voice of God the Father announcing that this was His Son, in whom He was well pleased, marked the beginning of Christ's public ministry. We recall our own Baptism each time we enter the church by blessing ourselves with holy water from the font at the doors.
