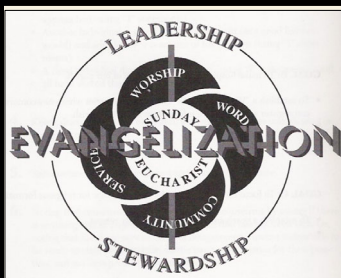

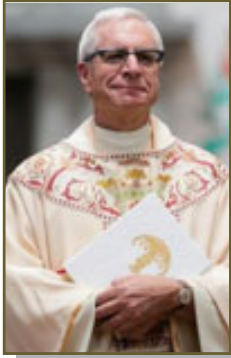

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



"For all the saints, for from their labors rest, all who by faith before the world confessed, your name O Jesus, be forever blest. Alleluia! Alleluia!" The Feast of All Saints is always a "Big Deal" in my faith life. I hope it is in yours too. As a youngster, I remember Mass at St. Catherine's chapel. The long mural wall with women at the sisters' side and men saints on the cadets' side recall the heroes of our faith and assure us that we are never alone in a Roman Catholic worship space!

For the longest time, I suppose we all thought that saints lived long ago and most likely in Italy! Not so anymore. Then Pope St. John Paul II came along and canonized 110 saints during his twenty-six yearlong papacy. Further, he was canonized by Pope Francis! Saints surround us!

To say that Catholics have favorite saints is to belabor the obvious. I am happy our school students adopt and draw pictures of saints as the artist John DeRosen did for me as a St. Catherine's cadet. A bit more important than recognizing a saint by picture is knowing the life of a saint. A bit more important than knowing the life the saint is becoming that saint by the way you live your life. Who is your saint? How did that person live his/her belief so that his/her life is remembered today?

Don't forget that we remember all the saints at every Mass – in fact we pray for all who have died at every Mass. Right there in each Eucharistic prayer is the petition (in these words from Eucharistic Prayer II or similar words): "Remember our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection, welcome them into the light of your face. Have mercy on us all, we pray, that with Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, blessed Joseph her spouse with the blessed Apostles and all the Saints ..." So all the dead and all the saints are remembered at each Mass, there are no souls who are without prayer.

It's that large "Communion of Saints" that interests me. That heavenly home of the resurrected where my parents are more alive now than they were on earth, same with Frs. Jude, George, Pat, Bro Philip, Msgr. O'Brien, and the countless other good clergy, Sisters of St. Joseph, teachers, staff, and parishioners who served this community of faith in so many ways imitating so many saints.

Rather than looking up to heaven and imagining a saint, look out to those who lead you to a deeper relationship with God. Faith is an experience of God which causes an awakening and a conversion. The saints responded to Jesus' call; "Come, follow me." Jesus opened their eyes, showed them what they were missing by their blindness and turned them loose to serve God, as He is revealed in the world of His creation. Jesus was clear: "Put yourself aside and come, follow me. Love one another as I have loved you. " Jesus' command opens such a new reality that one is filled with wonder, awe, gratitude, and joy. Life is experienced as a blessing. The friend of God is holy and lives life in abundance.

Faith's response is belief – what you do, the decisions you make, the way you are known. "That person must have experienced God, look at his decisions and actions." "That person believes God is present in others; look at the sacrifices she makes." That person is "the poor widow who put in more than all the rest" of Luke's Gospel. Mother Theresa of Calcutta gave a lot, so did Thomas More, Thomas Merton, Dorothy Day, Francis Xavier, Catherine of Siena, Peregrine Laziosi, Francis of Assisi, and the whole communion of our ancestors whose memory we celebrate. Which saint's biography have you read lately? What stops you short of being a saint?

What has transformed your life in such a way you can be called holy, a saint, or a person on the way? Does your neighbor consider you a saint? What might your non-churched neighbor see in you that might prompt the comment and question: "What a really holy person you are, beyond just kind and human! Where do you worship? Where is your faith community?"

A bunch of nifty questions!
