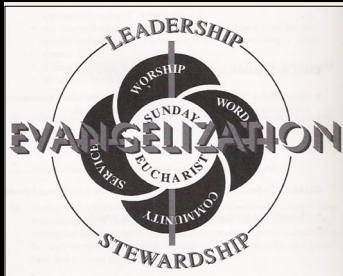

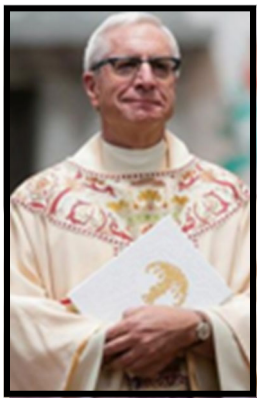

Bad people don't come to confession. Only the good do.

John the Baptist preached repentance. We might think he meant tabulating sins, making temporary amends. No. He meant *metanoia*: conversion, **total** turnabout. Let's be humble enough, John asks, to acknowledge that for some time now our lives have been moving along a very pleasurable--but self-deceptive--road. The only long-run solution is to admit that basic mistake, and turn 180 degrees around--back to the first wrong turn.

Maybe with a small case "p" become a prophet. Teach others how to "know, love, and serve God in this world so that we will be happy with Him in the next." Encounter the Lord in Word and Sacrament, develop a relationship with Jesus, spend time with him during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament the first Tuesday of each month in our parish church, and carve out time in any regular day for prayer. Finally, energized by your relationship with Jesus bring new hope to those whom you encounter. Teach others by your belief to "prepare the way of the Lord...and see the salvation of God."

As a converted Christian, you could be a prophet. Who was John the Baptist? Just one man. Who was Mother Teresa? Just one woman. Oh, granted they were a man and woman of extraordinary heart. But God can do wonders with men and women of ordinary hearts--as long as they're not afraid, as long as they keep their eyes on the steadfastness of the One calling and not on the fragility of the one called. I think the confidence of Christianity responds to a call, like Isaiah's call: "Whom shall I send? Who will be our messenger?" And Isaiah answers very simply: "Here I am. Send me."

Advent is a time for reflecting on our lives and going to confession. Following confession, conversion, and becoming a better witness to the Gospel; "This is the time of salvation, reform your life and believe." This year, our deanery of parishes will share communal penance times. Saturday confession time from 3:30 to 4:30PM will continue in our parish church. Communal penance times will begin at 7:00PM in the following churches of Deanery III.

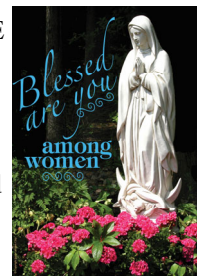

## SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

The Sacrament of Penance offers a new possibility to convert oneself to the Gospel and recover grace that was lost by sin.

Who must go to confession? Each of the faithful is bound by an obligation to confess mortal, serious sins, at least once a year. Confession of everyday faults (venial sins) is strongly recommended by the Church.

Mortal sin: a sin whose object is grave matter and is committed with full knowledge and deliberate consent.

Venial sin: a less serious wrong doing, disobeys the moral law.

Begin with an examination of your conscience. Before you enter the confessional, prayerfully reflect on your words and deeds since the last time you received the sacrament. Knowing the Ten Commandments and the Gospel of Jesus, when have you "missed the mark?" When have you done a do not do – or when you could have practiced a virtue or performed an act of mercy but did not? When did you misuse God's creation? What have you done that gives you guilt?

Tell these faults to the priest. Listen to any advice, counsel, or guidance that the priest might give you.

Receive your penance, the act that you must do to repair any harm your sin has caused and to re-establish yourself as a disciple of Christ.

Receive the absolution of your sins, be reconciled with God, the Father of mercies, and the Church as the priest prays the prayer of absolution for you.

Be prepared to pray an Act of Contrition: these or similar words: My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

As you receive the grace of absolution and pray to "avoid whatever leads to sin" recover a new relationship with the Lord and reform your life.
