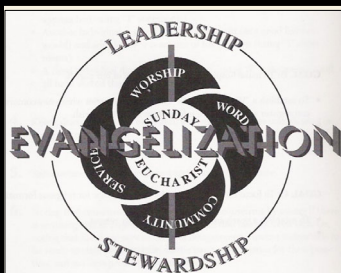

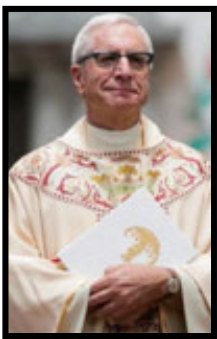

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



My birthday was just splendid! Thank you for simply being with me – together we are not alone. Thanks for planning the reception, for being there, and for the cards and gifts. WOW, never before have I been treated so well. Thanks, thanks, thanks and more thanks. Now, onto Lent.

If you do not attend the Friday Fish Fry, bring yourself and your friends - no disappointment here on a Friday night. Attend the Stations of the Cross as well.

I often search the web just to find that it is a kin to an “antique road-show” - it’s a gold-mine and it’s a junk yard. Like many of you, I too am interested in a quick and good reflection or a “Catholic answer.” About these resources I want to know the details of the author or sources; who are they, what is their back-ground both academically and professionally? One is the Pope, others arch-bishops and bishops, some priests, other lay theologians. Some writers are not so qualified. Among those who are quite good and who post with regularity on Facebook might I suggest:

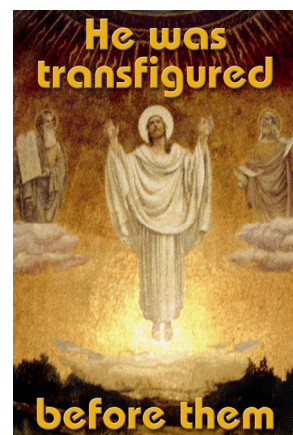
Pope Francis, Archbishop Jose H. Gomez, Fr. Robert Barron, Fr. James Martin, S.J., and Fr. Rocky. Among organizations, I suggest: Word on Fire Catholic Ministries, My Catholic Faith Ministries, Magnificat, and Word Among Us.

I have found the posts from these individuals and organizations to be of good quality and offer faith-filled direction to the reader.

Today’s gospel reading is the Transfiguration of Jesus. Its lesson teaches: how often we are ambushed by the really real presence of Jesus. We don’t use that word, transfigure, very often. When we do it’s powerful. Call to your mind *The Battle Hymn of the Republic* – to me one of the most precious pieces of our National Poetry:



“In the beauty of the lilies
Christ was born across the sea,
With a glory in his bosom
that transfigures you and me,
As He died to make men holy
let us live to make men free,
His truth is marching on.”



Onward, good Christians, allow Jesus to be really real, a transforming presence in your life this week.
