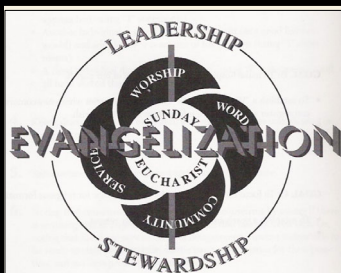

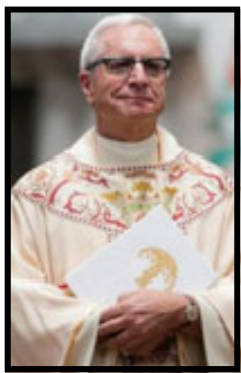

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Tucked into the musical *Camelot* the song “What do the Simple Folk Do?” is a dialogue. Guinevere asks Arthur: “What do the simple folk do (when the doldrums begin)? Do you know?” Arthur replies: “Once, upon the road, I came upon a lad singing in a voice three times his size. When clarified ... singing always made his spirits rise. They sing...” Singing enables the Body of Christ assembled in worship to raise their spirits to God. While we sing, our bodies are engaged in the rhythm of the song – we necessarily take breaths before we can continue our commitment to the song. The assembly joins together in such a way as to become one voice, one Body of Christ. Interestingly, when we lose our self-awareness, even self-centeredness, we are united in one common purpose, the sung worship of God in community.

Our worship songs are defined in many ways. Some are liturgical and others are devotional. Hymnals are filled with both types of songs. The cycles of the liturgical seasons pretty much define liturgical prayer and its appropriate music. Liturgical prayer calls us beyond ourselves to the life of Christ and the Church; it does not change with our many needs. Devotional prayer on the other hand is shaped and defined by us and our needs.

Liturgical prayer and its music is highly structured, it is spelled out in ritual books with red writing called rubrics. The language of this style is creedal and sacramental. A lot of liturgical music uses the texts of the liturgy or of Scripture. These songs draw us into the liturgy as a community called church. Think of “Come Holy Ghost” or “Transfigure Us, O Lord” or “Gift of Finest Wheat.” And for the ritual itself, “Sanctus” or “Holy Holy Holy.”



Devotional prayer and song is very much about individual salvation and healing. Consider here: “For the Beauty of the Earth” a wonderful song which self-identifies as “as hymn of grateful praise.” Continuing the category we would include: “How Great Thou Art” and “How Can I Keep From Singing?”

The role of liturgical music is to guide the parish into a relationship with God and one another. Shouldn't that make your spirits rise and encourage you to "sing three times your size?"

I remind you of the talk on transforming the Crystal Cathedral into Christ Cathedral by Msgr. Arthur Holquin at St. Angela's on March 19 at 6:00PM. Bishop Vann and the priests and deacons of the Diocese of Orange will celebrate the Chrism Mass where the Holy Oils for use during the year are blessed. The Chrism Mass is at St. Columban Church, 10801 Stanford Ave. Garden Grove, 92840. It is celebrated on Monday of Holy Week, March 30 at 5:30PM. This is a spectacular Mass that the Diocese of Orange celebrates with our bishop. Please participate in the celebrations of Holy Thursday at 7:00PM, Good Friday Living Stations of the Cross at 12:00noon and Our Lord's Passion/Veneration of the Cross at 7:00PM, and the Great Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday) at 8:00PM – or one of the Easter Sunday Masses. Morning prayer is prayed each of these three mornings at 8:00AM. These are the “High Holy Days of our faith.” It is good to celebrate all three parts of the One Great Feast.

Lastly, one or two or even a team of Eucharistic Ministers are needed to bring the Holy Eucharist to two care centers in Fullerton on Chapman Avenue near Acacia Avenue. If you are able to bring Holy Communion to patients at one or two care centers on Monday or Tuesday, please contact me at the parish office. Thank you so much.

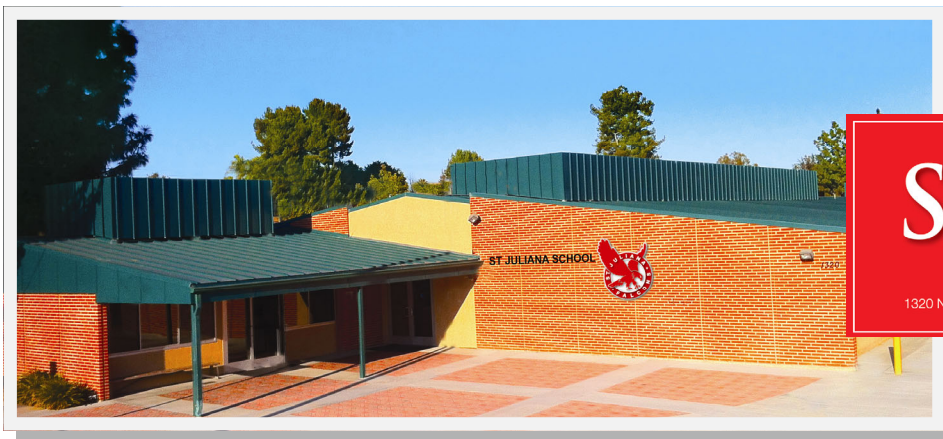

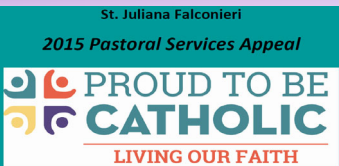
