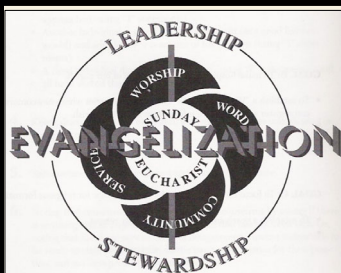

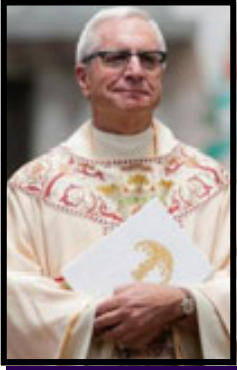

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



The arts capture the glory of God. Poetically, the soul can be directed to God through Gerard Manley Hopkins' *God's Grandeur*: "The world is charged with the grandeur of God." Other times the art form might be the wondrous paintings and sculptures of Michelangelo on the Sistine Chapel, his *Pieta* in St. Peter's or consider many of the great artists of old or the present day. They need not be Italian, although there is a reasonably good argument that a lot of the best art is Italian! Another art form moving the heart to God might be the music of the past and present; a Mozart *Requiem*, the current work of John Rutter, *For the Beauty of the Earth*, or the St. Louis Jesuits whom I knew in the seminary (priest-school) *All the Ends of the Earth*, and do not to forget *Amazing Grace*.

Why can't we just sing our favorite hymns in Mass? Music is appropriately chosen when it fits the liturgical season and selected Scripture readings. However funny or chaotic, it would be out of place to sing "Away in a Manger" during Lent or "O Sacred Head, Surrounded" during Christmas!

As the homily ought to give the congregation a deeper insight into the readings, so the music ought to suggest a deeper understanding of the Word of God.

We are entering into the Easter Triduum, the three high holy days of our faith; Holy Thursday Mass of the Last Supper, Good Friday, and the Great Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening, and Easter. During Lent the use of instruments was discouraged so we chanted the Mass parts; *Sanctus and Agnus Dei*. Generally, the Lenten hymns were intro-spective. Soon we will hear trumpets blast as Jesus breaks through death to life.

Most of the Church year is called Ordinary Time. The bulk of the Sundays of Ordinary Time are celebrated during the summer. While many church choirs dismiss themselves during the Sundays of summer, our choir and music ministry keeps itself together all year. As there is no "downtime" for the congregation, you are not excused from Mass during the summer; our choir continues the ministry of leading us to glorify God in one voice of praise.

Liturgy is the work of the people to praise God. Let us sing joyfully to the Lord, together worship Him in songs of praise. *Lift up your hearts to the Lord. Sing out your joy to the Lord.*

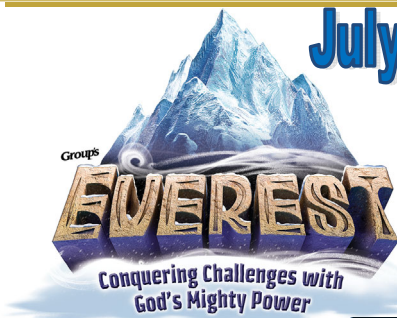

CATHOLICISM 101

RCIA: Third Scrutiny of the Elect (5th Sunday of Lent)

 This Sunday, we continue the celebration of the Scrutinies. On the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent we pray in a particular way for those who are to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. We pray that any attachment to evil might be removed, and that they be truly converted to Christ. The Elect "wait in joyful hope" until they can pray it with us as one of the Faithful at the Easter Vigil. Because we are celebrating the Scrutinies, the readings will be taken from Cycle A of the Lectionary.

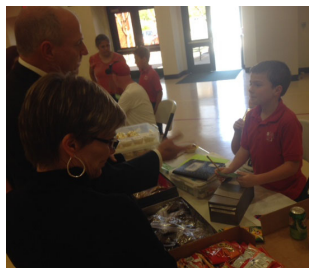
