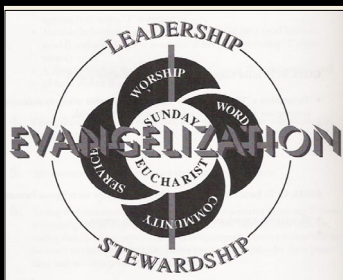

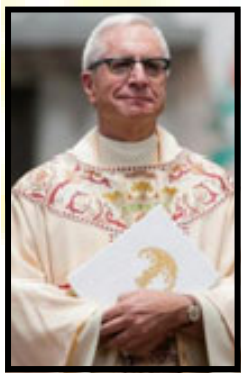

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



This is it. The triumphal entry of the Messiah into the Holy City. It really seemed important at the time, at least to the adoring crowd. The Super bowl Team come home to a tickertape parade. That moment at the Oscar awards. Those are the moments tabloid writers facetiously describe as "never-to-be-forgotten."

Yet, as we always find in the gospels, God has a persnickety penchant for turnabout, a quirky and consistent upending of what we think really matters. It wasn't Jesus' palmy triumph that was genuinely important. What was important was his defeat. Because it was the occasion for the greatest comeback in human history.

You can sense the paradox in the scene: the euphoric crowd carpeting Jesus' path with palms, exultantly shouting their hosannas. But there's a jarring, even clumsy note about the scene.

The great hero doesn't enter his kingdom mounted on some white horse, Traveler, as a USC fan might expect. He's sitting on a dull-eyed donkey. That donkey, I think, is God's exquisitely subtle comment on all we think is important.

Sometimes I sit and watch at weddings--the mother of the bride in a panicky tizzy because the florist forgot the baby's breath when her daughter is about to vow herself to a man for the rest of her life.

What's important is what we have in our hands when we walk through the doorway of death. There's no impressing the ferryman with your degrees, your Super bowl ring, your Oscar award. He's seen them all; he's unimpressible. The only thing you can take aboard is what you've made of your soul -- - your self, your who-I-am. Not what-I've-done. Just who-I-am.

With our this-world minds, cocooned within the limits of time and space, size and clout and length-of-days seem very, very important.

Seen from the perspective of God, the perspective of Jesus as his donkey trundled over the carpet of palms, they're not important at all. What's important is the beyond-time, beyond-space light that flickers within each one of us. A light that transcends death. Within us. Right now. How self-improverishing that we don't grasp that, or understand it, or even pay it any attention. Eternity. Within us. Right now.

Now there's something to shout hosanna about!

## GOOD FRIDAY—FAST AND ABSTINENCE

To **abstain from meat** on Good Friday means to not eat meat. It does not intend the omission of eggs or dairy products.

The **required fast** on Good Friday involves eating only one full meal on those days. One or two smaller meals may be taken on those days, but may not total one full meal. The required fast does not allow eating anything between meals.

All Catholics who have **completed their fourteenth year** are bound by the law of abstinence; all adults are bound by the law of fast up to the **beginning of their sixtieth year**.

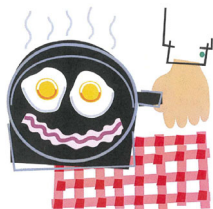

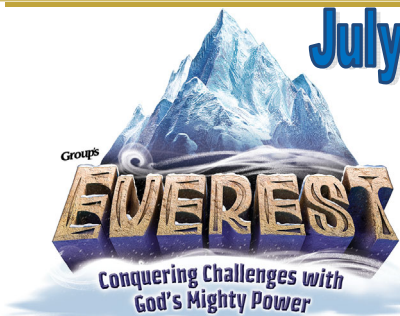

Palm Sunday or "Passion Sunday" marks the beginning of Holy Week and commemorates Jesus's triumphant procession into

Jerusalem. This event has been celebrated in a variety of ways from decorating houses to simple processions. The event is documented in each of the four Gospels and its symbolism is captured in Zechariah 9:9 "The Coming of Zion's King"... Psalm 118:26 is also echoed in the words of the crowd (and in our mass), "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord." This week leads us into the Easter Triduum ending of course with the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday.
