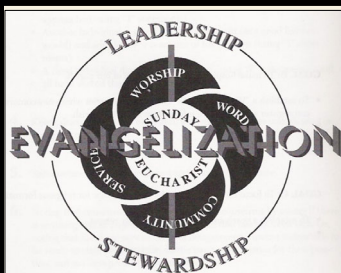

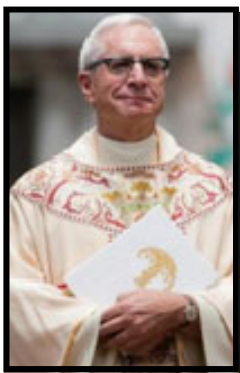

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



The simple definition of “liturgy” is “liturgy is the work of the people.” Frankly, it’s also the work of God who allows us to experience Him and His love. The liturgy allows us a glimpse of who God is. Our work allows God to bring us, His sons and daughters, into a deeper relationship with Him. It is God’s love which transfigures us from ordinary people to the Body of Christ. He chooses us, He loves us, and He sanctifies us.

Our work in the liturgy is to be open, available, and receptive – hearts open to receive love, open minds to know God, hands open to welcome those around us, and mouths open to pray and sing God’s praises. All of that is work! It’s liturgical work. Praise God joyfully as we do it!

Jesus didn’t have a lot of time for quiet people, reserved when they experience his presence. He insisted that the joy of his message be hollered from roof-tops. He told his followers to “go out” - “proclaim” – “love one another in memory of me” – “as I have done for you, you must do for others.” Jesus, by his own life didn’t allow a lot of room for “holding back.”

In the liturgy some people struggle with the work of praying the responses aloud – it is a **dialogue** Mass. Sometimes we priests might think we are celebrating Mass in front of an oil painting. Then, suddenly, someone moves, coughs, or sneezes – ha, you are alive, caught ‘cha! It’s not only the verbal responses. It’s also the singing. With music the congregation contributes to the liturgy in a very fundamental way. Liturgical music is not to entertain – although some of it is entertaining. Liturgical music acts as a way to engage all of us into One Body of Christ gathered for liturgical worship. Hint: sing joyfully, respond, pray, and experience the love of the Lord in the liturgy.

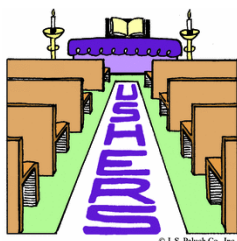

RCIA SCRUTINIES

This Sunday at the 9:00am Mass we celebrate the RCIA "First Scrutiny" for those in our catechumenal process who are preparing for the Sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil. Next week, at the 11:00am Mass, we celebrate the RCIA "Second Scrutiny," and on March 22nd at the 5:00pm Mass we celebrate the RCIA "Third Scrutiny."

The three Scrutinies are among the most ancient prayers in the Christian liturgical tradition. As early as the second century, Christian communities would help those who had been chosen for Baptism to prepare for their initiation by laying of hands and prayer. 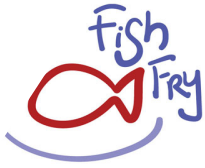
