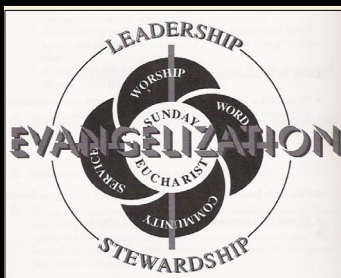

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Among the many expressions of Roman Catholicism is: "If you want to know what people believe, listen to how they pray" – perhaps you learned: "Lex orandi, lex credendi" (literal Latin: the law of praying is the law of believing). The point is that Catholics express their belief in prayer and worship.

Prayers grow from a theological experience. Prayers express faith and belief. Jesus taught "the perfect prayer" - our Father in heaven – your name is sacred – I dedicate myself to you and your way – I petition you for my needs this day – I want to direct my life to forgiveness - and please, guide me away from sin. To all of that we say: "Amen!"

The month of May is especially dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The school community crowned her as our Mother. We believe that she will direct us to believe in God and to be holy as she was, compassionate and a gift to others as she is a gift to us. When those who were around Jesus asked: "Where did he get all of this?" - I bet anything: "From his Mother!" is the right answer. "Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help or sought your intercession, was left unaided." We believe that those who petition the Virgin Mary will not be despised but in her mercy she will hear and answer our prayers.



On Saturday, May 23rd, St. Juliana parish will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Let us pray that those who will be confirmed in the faith be: "filled with the Holy Spirit and themselves become a Temple of his glory. ... That through the strength of the sacrament they become witnesses before the world to the Gospel of our Lord Jesus." As these candidates encounter Jesus in the sacrament, let us be their help support. May their holiness be our gladness!

As the early Church grew in its understanding of God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and Mary through prayer, I encourage you to spend time in prayer. Find a moment to come to the church, especially on the first Tuesday during Eucharistic Adoration. Pray what you believe, live what you pray.

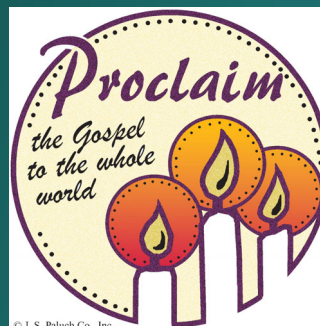

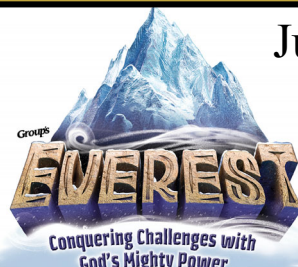

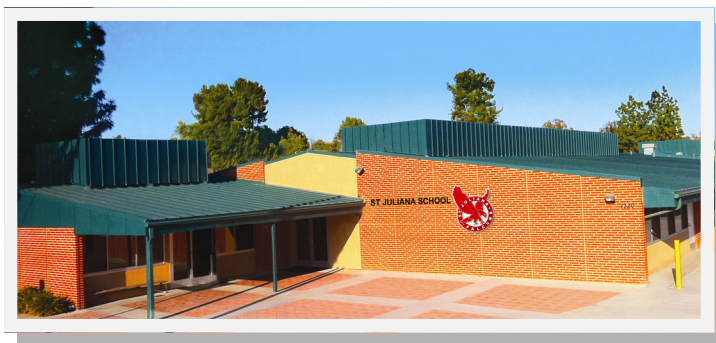

CORAZON NEWS



On April 23, 2015, Oscar and Aristeva, and her 6 year old daughter Fernanda, received drywall and insulation in their Corazon home from the St. Juliana Knights of Columbus. Three of us volunteers arrived at the site about 7:30 in the morning. The fami-

ly, plus about 15 Mexican volunteers were there to greet us. We quickly went to work with the insulation, stapling, measuring and cutting pieces, hammering, drilling, and applying texture coating.

Aristeva explained that she was a single Mom with 4 children when she met Oscar 5 years ago while both selling souvenirs at the border to the tourists waiting in their cars to cross to the U.S. They married 4 years ago, and Oscar bought a two room house on a double lot. There was enough room to house her youngest child with special needs. The other 3 remain with her mother who lives nearby. A neighbor told them about Corazon and Oscar joined 3 years ago. Aristeva found employment at a local plasma TV assembly plant. 2 years ago they received a Corazon house. Today we finished the drywall project. We also donated paint for the inside which will be applied after the texture coating dries. Oscar and Aristeva have a small garden in their front yard. There are several gourds hanging from a tree he planted which gives a cheerful character to the yard. Oscar and Aristeva are thankful for their Corazon neighbors, and the St. Juliana's Knights of Columbus who sponsored their project. She says that with the responsibility of supporting her children, she would never have been able to improve her house without this help.
