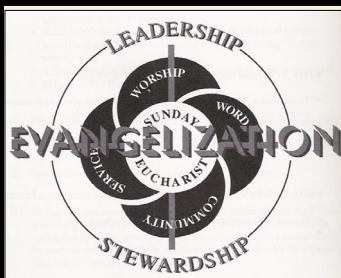

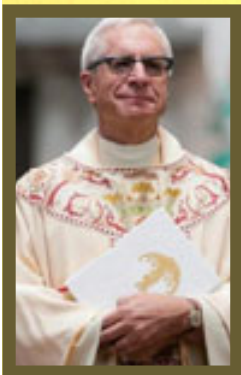

**A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.**

Authors write a lot about some sort of God they cannot see and many have not met through faith. Scholars write about causes in truth or justice which, *per se*, can only be reasoned and apples and other falling objects which in themselves are not gravity but are the effects of gravity. Discourse about God is of a different category. A very enlightening discussion about God can begin with those who have faith and live their lives believing the relationship is life-giving. That relationship urges the believer to go out into the whole world and make a difference. I am reminded of the Helen Reddy song: "I am woman hear me roar!" What if Christians in their strength lived; "I am Christian! By my baptism I am a new creation! I can give gifts the world cannot give; God's love, joy, and peace. Come, listen to me."

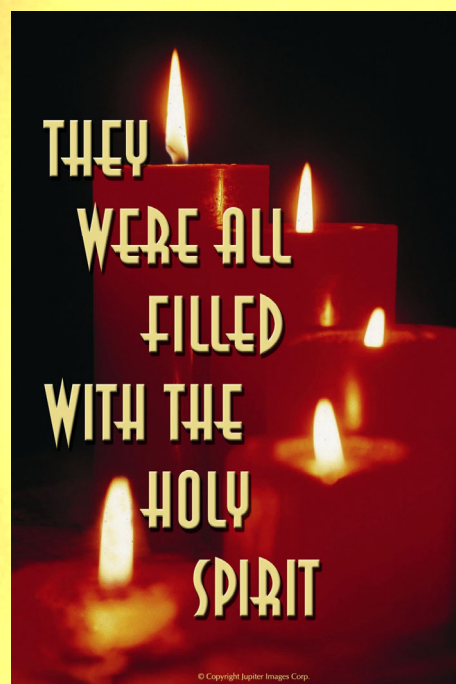
Today's feast, Pentecost, is that feast which gives the Church her gifts of understanding, wisdom, knowledge, piety, counsel, fortitude, and awesome wonder of the Lord. As these gifts helped the disciples, so do they help us to **"Go out into the world and proclaim Jesus Christ Is Lord!"**

The gifts of the Holy Spirit lead us to salvation. We have been given the important mission to "make disciples. You are different from the world, go into the world and make a difference!" We do this when we baptize new members and as initiated members when we live our lives in a relationship with God made possible by that water baptism, the Holy Eucharist, and an out-pouring of the Holy Spirit. Salvation is not what we know about God as through study. Rather Christians are saved by their relationship to Christ.

Our parish community celebrates the sacrament of Confirmation this weekend. Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist are the three "sacraments of initiation." May all of us be once again made aware of the saving gifts which are lavishly poured out on us so that we will experience God, reflect on God, love God, and demonstrate our belief by the way we live our lives.
