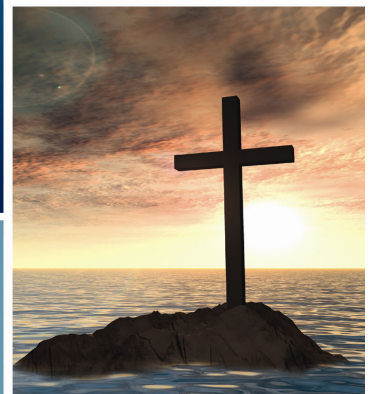

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Jesus calmed the storm with the rebuke: "Quiet! Be still!" Then he asked his disciples: "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" It's Father's Day! What does the family look for in Dad? The calming assurance that everything is going to be all right. Perhaps what we expect from any father: a vision with direction – clarity and strength. For Dad add the Spirit's gift of courage. On Father's Day, reflect both on the Gospel and Dad. Clarify what we expect from Fathers – the paternal figure in the family and in the parish! During any type of storm: "Don't get all bothered! Calm! Have faith!" Does Dad offer an honest perception no matter what the problem? In Dad look for a conclusive decision made by reflective thought of what ought to be done and the courage and will to see it to completion. Not a bad role for Father.

Mom's role might be, rightly or wrongly, understanding, empathy, seeing a problem from a child's point of view. Simply because from the earliest days of the child's life, before the child was capable of words, Mom had to intuit what the child needed.

Together, parents must realize that the most important gift they can give their kids is the evident solidarity of the marriage itself. Kids need a gut conviction Mom and Dad have a precious relationship.

In the Year of the Family, continue to grow as a Catholic family. As I asked you to do before, read the Gospel, speak about it together. If you want some direction in your family faith formation from the media, I suggest the multiple videos of Fr. Robert Barron, *America* or *Commonweal* magazines and the weekly newspaper of our Diocese offered free at the back door of our church. Attend the offerings of the Faith Formation Team of the parish.

On this Father's Day, or during the summer, grow your faith in God and in your family. Take a bit of a pilgrimage by Metro-link to Old Los Angeles, visit the first Catholic Church in the city right across the street from the train station, walk to the Cathedral, and visit Homeboy Industries. Take the Metro-link in the other direction to San Juan Capistrano and visit the mission. Drop my name at the gate, after they laugh, you will still be charged admission fees! If you decide to go by car, let Dad drive, Mom will be saying her prayers, and kids – you play silly car games. When Dad gets lost, don't nag him to Google directions –driving while lost is a guy thing!
