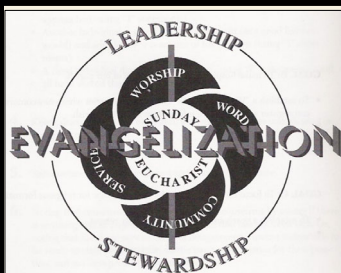

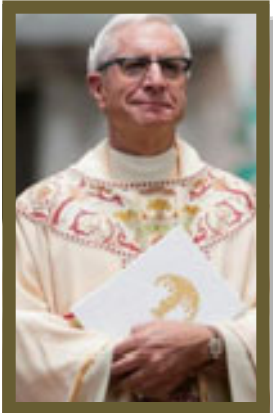

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Jesus commands the synagogue official: "Do not be afraid; just have faith." It's all so familiar. It's nearly Hallmark. Today's Gospel lesson tells us that Jesus "crossed to the other side." In fact he crossed to the greatest other side ever: from death to life. In today's Gospel he encountered a person of faith who wanted a favor from him for his beloved daughter. Jairus made an act of faith. He made an act of faith that Jesus would restore his daughter to health and life. The same act brought calm to his family; there was great commotion. That family crossed to the other side.

Faith will focus all of your decisions. It will set the value of life and purpose of life. The person who lives his life fully gives glory to God.

Life and faith grow in a community setting. The gospel lesson pictures a family setting with food: "give that girl something to eat!" Jesus wanted the little girl to be given something to eat. A family sharing stories and food together are signs of isolation turning into communion. It's the Mass!

The family is the focus of many talks of Our Holy Father, Pope Francis. He has summoned Church leaders to discuss and reform and revitalize the family as the "domestic church." It is in the family that we first learn who God is. Indeed, at our infant baptism the priest or deacon prayed especially over our fathers: "Together with your wife you will be the first teachers of your child in the ways of the faith. We all hope and pray that you will be the best of teachers by all that you say and do."

If you are a family – not all readers are – **what are you doing as a family to form yourselves as a "domestic church?"** By what you do and say, how is the faith being passed on in your family? I offer these suggestions:

- ♦ Attend Mass as a family. Discuss Sunday's readings or homily as a family, even if you didn't attend as a family. Talk freely about God and Scripture. Pray together.
- ♦ If any member is in some form of religious education – Catholic School or SRE, discuss the religious lessons as a family. Mom/Dad become active in your child's religious education - attend classes together. Discuss moral decision making.
- ♦ Is a crucifix placed obviously in your home – in every bedroom?
- ♦ Participate in the ministries of the Mass – altar serve, lector, Eucharistic Minister.
- ♦ Teach stewardship to the family by example and sacrifice
- ♦ Visit Mission San Juan Capistrano or any mission, the cathedral (Holy Family), Christ Cathedral (Crystal Cathedral) as it is being renovated, LA's cathedral. Learn what a cathedral is and why it is important.
- ♦ Discuss the importance of marriage as a sacrament of the Church.
- ♦ Perhaps invite religious sisters, brothers, or priests to your home (!)

Learn, practice, celebrate, and love your faith as a family. It is primary to passing on the faith.

"How precious is the family as the privileged place for transmitting the faith!" Pope Francis
