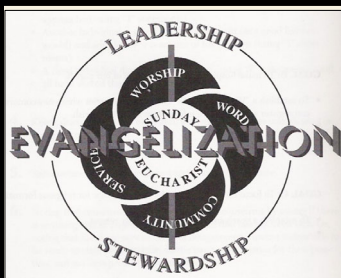

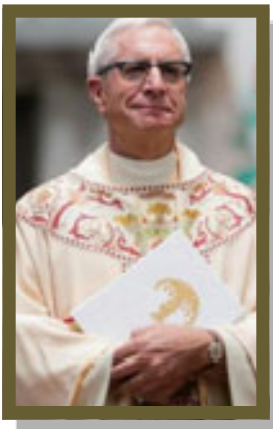

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



This is a great feast – Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ! Cities are named Corpus Christi! In a few parts of the globe this feast was celebrated on Thursday following Trinity Sunday, here it's a Sunday Solemnity. Some communities celebrate with a parade around the town and a parish meal.

Why not a meal! Corpus Christi is the core of our community life; it is the Real Food that nourishes us to "go out and glorify the Lord by the way we live our lives." It is the Feast of the Eucharist, a word which means Thanksgiving. It is the action of thanksgiving, the Eucharist is not a noun, like most religious words it has action to it – go out and be thanksgiving for others, do what you receive. Today we celebrate the way we are the Body of Christ, the dynamic presence of Jesus Christ.

Jesus took, blessed, and shared bread and wine. He identified that bread and wine with himself. He said; "do this in memory of me." The bread and wine become the Real Presence of Jesus our Lord.

This is true for me, and I hope you - singularly the most important reason why I am and remain a Catholic Christian and no other kind is my belief in transubstantiation, that the bread and the wine truly become the Body and Blood of Jesus. I believe that with all my being. The bread and the wine still look like bread and wine – the same form and figure – but the substance is changed. It is not a symbolic change, it is a real change not just for as long as Mass is celebrated but until the sacrament is consumed. The Eucharist is Jesus! Remember the words of good Flannery O'Conner: "If it's just a symbolic change, then the hell with it!"

Allow this feast of the Most Holy Sacrament, the Sacrifice of the Altar to focus us on what is most important in our lives as a Catholic community. The sacrament of this sacrifice means that we are eternal right now and right here. This sacrament is our energy, it empowers our souls as it commits to make us one with the Lord.

PSST! You remember this classic: *Pange, lingua, gloriósi*, just call it "*Sing my tongue the savior's glory*."

Sing, my tongue, the Saviour's glory,  
of His Flesh, the mystery sing;  
of the Blood, all price exceeding,  
shed by our Immortal King,  
destined, for the world's redemption,  
from a noble Womb to spring.  
Of a pure and spotless Virgin  
born for us on earth below,  
He, as Man, with man conversing,  
stayed, the seeds of truth to sow;  
then He closed in solemn order  
wond'rously His Life of woe.  
On the night of that Last Supper,  
seated with His chosen band,  
He, the Paschal Victim eating,  
first fulfils the Law's command;  
then as Food to His Apostles  
gives Himself with His own Hand.  
Word-made-Flesh, the bread of nature

by His Word to Flesh He turns;  
wine into His Blood He changes;  
what though sense no change discerns?  
Only be the heart in earnest,  
faith her lesson quickly learns.  
Down in adoration falling,  
This great Sacrament we hail,  
O'er ancient forms of worship  
Newer rites of grace prevail;  
Faith will tell us Christ is present,  
When our human senses fail.  
To the Everlasting Father,  
And the Son who made us free  
And the Spirit, God proceeding  
From them Each eternally,  
Be salvation, honour, blessing,  
Might and endless majesty.  
Amen. Alleluia.

**CORAZON NEWS**

Last Fall, St. Juliana parishioners donated generously to the Corazon scholarship fund. Doug and Jean Knudson were privileged to meet many of the students in the program and would like to share about two students in particular who will be receiving benefits from the program:



Anahi and Anali, aged 14, are in their second year of technical secondary school. They are assigned to the same academic classes and technical secretarial courses. They said there are 30 or more students in their school classrooms. The twins have an older and younger brother, and a younger sister.

Their mother makes piñatas for a small business near their home to supplement their father's income. The girls joined the Corazon tutoring program 3 months ago. They must attend regular tutoring sessions for at least 6 months before they can apply for a Corazon scholarship which will help defray rising school costs. They have big goals so receiving a scholarship to continue their studies is imperative. The girls were interviewed separately and both said their favorite subject is math and that they want to go to a university. Anahi wants to be a doctor so she can help people and Anali wants to join the ministerial police to help fight corruption and organized crime.

Your donation to support Anahi and Anali through the Corazon scholarship program gives them a resource that would otherwise be unavailable. The tutors are there to guide and nurture them in the long haul. Anahi, Anali, and students like them have the opportunity to dream of and work towards an exciting future thanks to donors like you.
