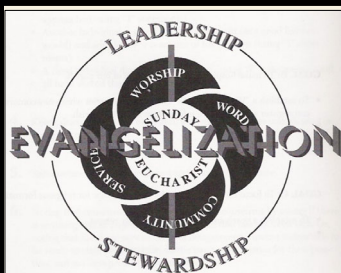

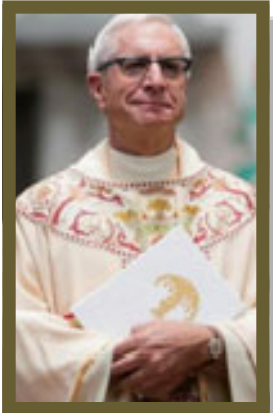

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



The first ever Christian school is pictured in today's gospel as if for its graduation. The chosen students have been disciples under the tutelage of the best ever Master Teacher who now trusts that they will be his presence in the community where he will not be, he sends them out into the world. The apprentice learners become masters – the disciples become apostles. They are sent out, two by two, with authority over unclean spirits. The Teacher does not give them much to work with, only a mission to accomplish.

It helps us to remember that even Jesus taught the baptized who were not fully converted, those who understood him enough to misunderstand him, those who said they would never leave him, and those who denied him. Yet they had to be sent out, they could not stay locked up securely. They were sent, without provisions. They were dealing with a God who provides as love provides, they were dealing with a God who said: "Do this in imitation of Me. Go out and be willing to be used up in a role for which you had no training and most of your work will be in a foreign land."

Maura and Kerry Condon have been the leaders of St. Juliana's Confirmation program for the past six years. They were asked to develop, stabilize, and lead a program our parish could be proud to present to the next generation of Catholic Christians. They have accomplished that goal in their own words to "... the point where we cannot do anymore. We believe (the parish needs) someone else with more time ... to take what we have done and bring it to the next level of success."

Indeed, it is with sadness that I accept their resignation. They have coordinated a program of positive influence in our parish and beyond. That comes as the result of A LOT of program development, stabilization, and sacrifice of time.

Wisdom, awe and wonder, and courage are Gifts of the Holy Spirit. We understand that knowing about God leads to conversion, awe and wonder point to the "WOW" experience of encountering God. Courage is the gift that says: "Conversion is a language spoken to foreigners even if we've known the listeners for years. I'm going to teach them even if they don't like what I say." Conversion, an encounter with Jesus, is the goal of the sacrament; conversion is no easy task. Christian conversion goes against much of what the "American Dream" preaches so loudly.

We, the parish community, thank the Condons for their ministry. Maura and Kerry, you had the courage to say: "Yes, we'll do it." Wisely you followed the lead of the Holy Spirit, you accomplished a mighty goal.

Parishioners, let me assure and re-assure you that the next chapter of our Confirmation program will stand on the shoulders of giants. "The next level of success" is being prayed about and planned. Together with Mr. Mike McHenry it is our goal to make ready a program that is family orientated. As the parish school forms community with parents and students, so do I want parish faith formation to form a community of converted Catholics who know, love, and imitate Jesus. This is best done as a family.

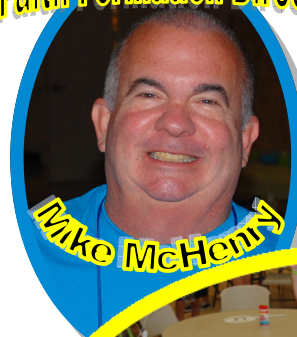

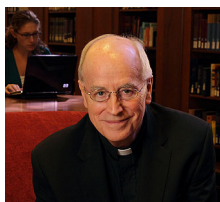


**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS**

Fr Heft holds a PhD in Historical Theology, and is Professor of Religion and president of the Institute of Advanced Catholic Studies at the University of Southern California.

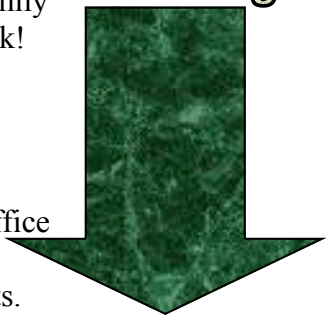
