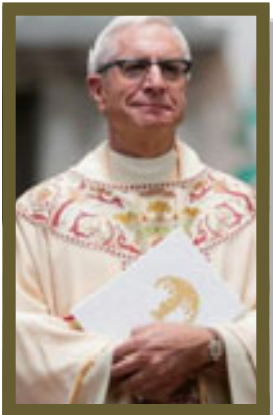

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



"*Carpe Diem*" like most shibboleths is over-used. Used so often and without care, the phrase lacks meaning or can be offensive. "Seize the Day", live life to the fullest today because there will be no tomorrow is a recipe for reckless abandon, bacchanal, and God-less activity. It says: "Everything is coming to a swift end, so let's just conclude life with a giant party. Spring break with no rules." Certainly young people want to live life to its fullness. Parents and other elders don't want "the kids" lives to be short in any way. We don't want the kids to be short of experiences, money, luxury, education, nutrition, medication, goods and services, and etc. Basically we want to see to it that "the kids" have all they need to grow up like Tom Sawyer.

Let's be sure those same children have faith experiences and family structures! Young people mature gradually and they learn from what they hear and see. The adults in the community and family are responsible for our youth - that they experience the best possible examples of faith and family and faith community. It is in their constant faith formation – praying the Mass, praying before meals, spending time every day and especially on the first Tuesday during Eucharistic Adoration, being attentive to religious studies classes in Catholic schools and the Parish School of Religious Education, and discussing the content of faith with elders - that our younger members will be converted and will know, love, and serve God. It is in our family life that we will know how to get along with each other, experience love, and learn how to trust.

As pastor, I am excited that St. Juliana Parish will celebrate "**Faith and Family Sunday**" on Sunday, August 2 at Five O'clock Mass. I often hear "Sunday Fun day" – like "*Carpe Diem*" I fear that does not include Mass or family being together. Let's try at least on Sunday, August 2, to celebrate "**Faith and Family Sunday**" at the parish. Fr. Jim Heft, S.M. (you can Google him, even watch him on You Tube) will celebrate and preach the 5:00PM Mass. Hamburgers, French fries, and soft drinks will be provided after Mass by Carl's Jr. Fr. Heft will give a talk on "Passing on the faith." We have arranged adults to supervise youngsters who might not want to hear a talk, there will be a movie up-stairs in the Seven Holy Founders Room and play outdoors. Serving the food easily and eliminating tension of seeing lines for food will be facilitated if some folks would go first to the parish center for drinks - you may also bring your own (!) – then get food. Fr. Heft's talk should begin close to 7:00 and conclude about 8:00. If you can't come for all, come for some. There is no cost – you have already paid for it!

As I finish writing this, I notice that Fr. Robert Barron of Chicago has become Bishop-Elect Robert Barron auxiliary bishop of the Arch-Diocese of Los Angeles. I have directed you to him for reliable web based information. His writings are clear, his video presentations are informative. He is really good. I hope he has enough time to continue his media presentations; Google and You Tube. Secretly I was hoping he would be appointed to the Diocese of Orange. With all the media and technology available at Christ Cathedral, he would be at home and we would be the home of really good Catholic media.

CORAZON SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

Laura's Story

Laura has four children. She was really struggling financially. She herself has a secondary school education which means she completed 8th grade. She found out that her children could get scholarships from Corazon to help defray school costs. Rather than having her children work to help support themselves, she asked them to help the family by going to tutoring and thereby earning scholarship money. Laura was really impressed when she saw the positive change in her children after getting regular tutoring. Their grades really improved. In fact, Laura was so impressed that she decided to be part of Corazon and become a tutor at the community center herself. In dealing with other kids, she says, she has learned the patience to help her understand her own children better.

Guillermina and Lola's Story

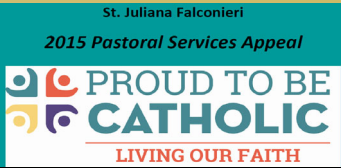
Guillermina is a Corazon volunteer from her community. She is the adult co-ordinator and is in charge of all the tutors. She has seen a big improvement in the children she has helped. At first, she says, they came here with poor grades and they lacked self-discipline and studious behavior. All prospective tutors must first take 4 classes on how to handle situations. Rules and expectations are established and posted. For instance, students must not be talking on phones or be listening to music. Inspirational quotes are also posted. All students are treated with respect and kindness. Guillermina says that she used to be really shy, but she has overcome that a lot. She added that volunteering at Corazon has helped her personally. She now feels more comfortable speaking in front of others.

Lola is a Corazon youth co-ordinator. She also teaches classes on preventing violence at home. These classes are required in order to join Corazon. A policy of anti-bullying is established and taught through the workshops.

Besides the personal fulfillment of being a volunteer, Laura, Guillermina and Lola receive hour credits for their time. They can swap their hours for benefits such as food from the pantry, other donated items for their homes, or construction projects to improve their living conditions. While doing these interviews I came to realize how far reaching your sponsorship donations go to improve the lives of others. Thank you so much for your donations.

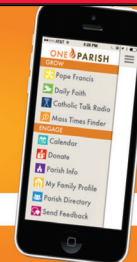
