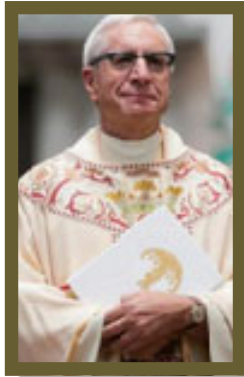

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



When you talk about "the faith" among yourselves – family, husband and wife, siblings, office workers, team mates, Catholic friends, "recovering Catholics" and not Catholic – what do you talk about? Is your topic an important matter, an essential of "the faith" like God the Father, the Person of Jesus (not what would Jesus do, but who The Christ is), the Holy Spirit, the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Eucharist, or the Resurrection, Matthew 25? Or might you discuss church rules, roles of people in the Church, the Church in the media, the local parish and its pastor, or Christ Cathedral? Do your conversations lead you to conversion; knowing God (understanding with the mind), loving God (something to do with the heart), and serving God (courage to make moral decisions) – and caring for the other and our planet in loving service as Christ has commanded us to serve/love? Is your discussion toward conversion and away from sarcasm, cynicism, hypocrisy, sacrilege, and ridicule?

The gospel for the past three weeks has been St. John, Chapter six. It teaches the Eucharist, the word means "thanksgiving." On an ordinary gum chewing human level it takes a lot to be thankful or grateful especially when so much is taken for granted. I'm delighted Southern California is my home! I really enjoy all that is offered here, the ocean – couldn't think of living in some land-locked state, the amusements and diversions

of Orange and Los Angeles - Anaheim Stadium, Dodger Stadium, the Coliseum, Rose Bowl, Disneyland, Hollywood, and the missions and museums, we've got a lot to do here. We can do it year-round! Life isn't boring.

What if you made a list of folks who are your family and friends, places you enjoy, and things you like to do. You might find out you are lucky. For many of us, Mom and Dad are to thank, they are the ones who left somewhere else to relocate here. I'm glad my parents left Chicago before I came along!

Turn to the Blessed Sacrament and Jesus who is present in it. Is it any longer for you the experience of: "WOW, I am receiving Jesus!" So often I hear: "The Mass is so boring. I never get anything out of it." I think: "Really? You are telling me that after so many years of Mass attendance, not to mention Catholic education. Perhaps Mass is boring, but the Eucharist is a gift. Thanksgiving Day can be boring, but I cherish the family arguing." Remember your First Holy Communion (it's a command not a question). Weren't you filled with "wonder and awe?" (Some of us were filled with fear that we wouldn't be able to receive First Communion if we drank water or ate that tempting pastry.) Remember the first time you saw Mary Poppins or the Zapruder film, or the Moon Landing (All Walter Cronkite could say was: "WOW")? When was the last time you were filled with wonder and awe at Communion time at Mass?

That's the question: When did the Eucharist, not necessarily the Mass, lose its meaning, its eternal aliveness? When did it all become so routine, same-old-same-old? What might YOU do to make it come alive, like your First Eucharist? YOU are responsible to say: "Thank You" to the God who gave you life and who continues to love you in the Eucharist.

If the Eucharist has kept its same sense of awe and wonder it had at the beginning, would you tell someone else how and why?

Nifty questions.

A HUGE THANK YOU and shout out to all who came to Faith and Family Sunday. THANK YOU to those who prepared the parish center and cleaned up after. Thanks for the company you are, especially for Sunday dinner and speaker. It's time we talk about our faith, practice our faith, and live our faith as a community. Let's begin with the primary community – our family. Take our faith home. Allow a friend to say: "You've got something I need." Tell that friend: "You can find it at St. Juliana Parish, corner of Melody and Acacia, Fullerton, 92831."

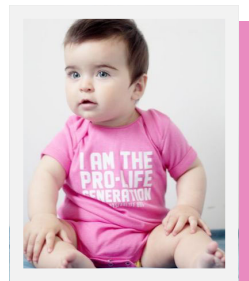

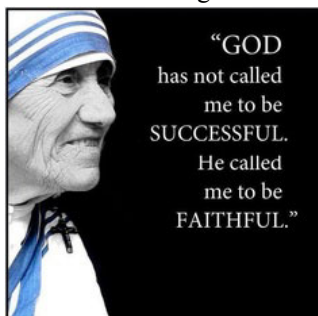
**WHAT DOES A CATECHIST DO?**
