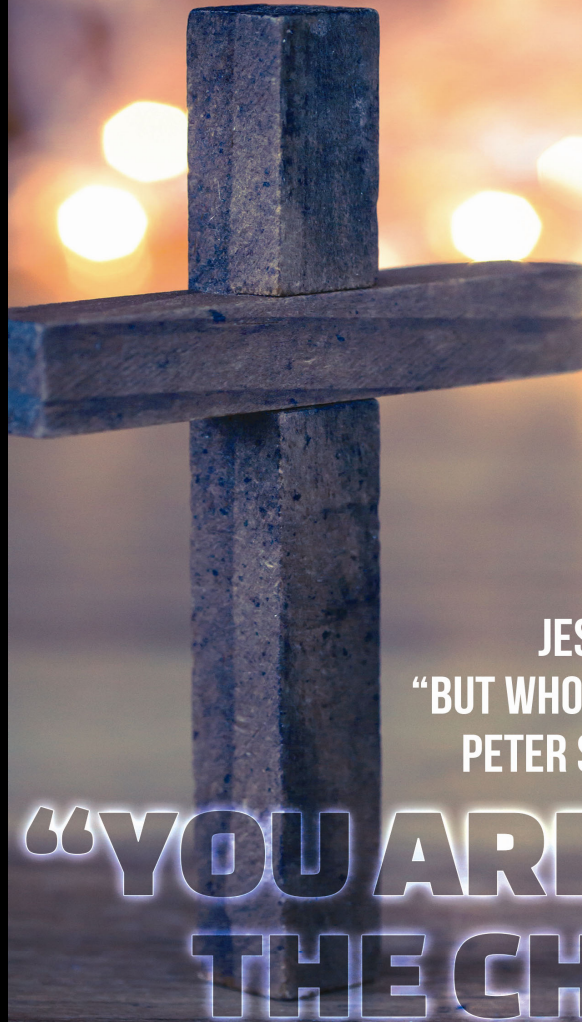

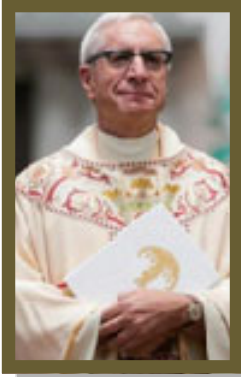

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



Which are the works that give faith life? The work of faith is the work of love and mercy. Your marriage works because your love works and love is work. Discuss that among your families tonight! All friendships work because love is work. It is the work of compassion, service of all sorts – cleaning, cooking, and being responsible for the other. To continue last week's theme, it is the work of hospitality.

The Jewish Seder dinner is at once a ritual; its actions are set and repeated every year. The Seder is also mixed with some spontaneity - even humor. I used to attend one, for some years I was the house goy! Perhaps it was the first year I participated, I was asked to make the announcement at the front door: "Let all who have no place to go tonight come here!" I proclaimed this as a demand, very loudly. The host remarked: "Not so loudly!" The next year and all subsequent years I simply held up a sign.

Hospitality, like all works of mercy, is rooted first in being a good human. People, because they are human, are kind; they decrease the suffering of another. Compassionate acts "divide grief and multiply joy." Mostly these acts are simply taught and offered as an obligation to others. When practiced as an expression of the experience of God in our lives, we are virtuous.

Don't let others feel left out, don't bully, don't discriminate. Wise humans and virtuous Christians practice such good behavior. Because you confess Jesus as the savior, because you lose your life and gain Jesus' identity, invite others into your lives and to your table. "Let those who have no place to eat tonight come to my home."

Our community welcomes two very important visitors to our home and around our table this week. Fr. Gottfried M. Wolff, OSM is the Prior General of the worldwide Servite Order. Father General is from Germany. Fr. Gottfried is traveling with his companion on the General Council, Fr. Souriraj M. Arulananda Samy, OSM who is a native of India. These friars are conducting a visitation of the friars and ministries of the USA Province of Servites. Theirs is the ministry leadership of the whole Order. Theirs is a ministry of service. They come to listen, to learn from, and encourage the friars all over the world. These good men bring the joy of the international Order and share the hopes, fraternity, and prayers of the local friars.

September 14th is the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross. The cross is more than decoration and jewelry. It is the image of our salvation. When you see it, see the victory of Christ. September 15th is the Feast of Our Lady Of Sorrows, the particular Feast of Mary for the Servite Order. The devotion, rooted in the gospels from the prophesy of Holy Simeon to the image of Mary at the Foot of Jesus' Cross, grew strong especially among the Servite Order in the Middle Ages.

Finally, I have great news to share with you! Next weekend we will officially welcome Mr. Taylor Engel to our community. Taylor will be the Coordinator of Youth Ministry, leader of the middle school youth, Confirmation program, and in time high school youth. He brings great enthusiasm, joy, youth, leadership, and learning to our parish. He will certainly continue the great work that has begun with those devoted men and women who have preceded him. He will speak at all the Masses next weekend.

Do not forget the Fall Festival - September 25, 26 and 27. (See page 8 of this bulletin for Fall Festival details and more information.) I appreciate those men and women who are working to continue the legacy of our hospitality and Fall Festival Fun. It is a great time to welcome all who come to our parish and to encourage those who don't know us. Come! Bring a friend!

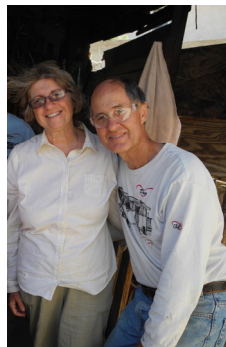

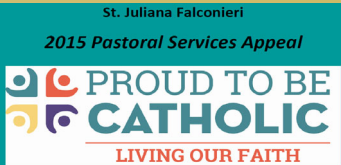

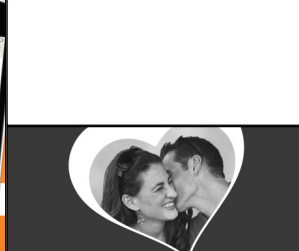
