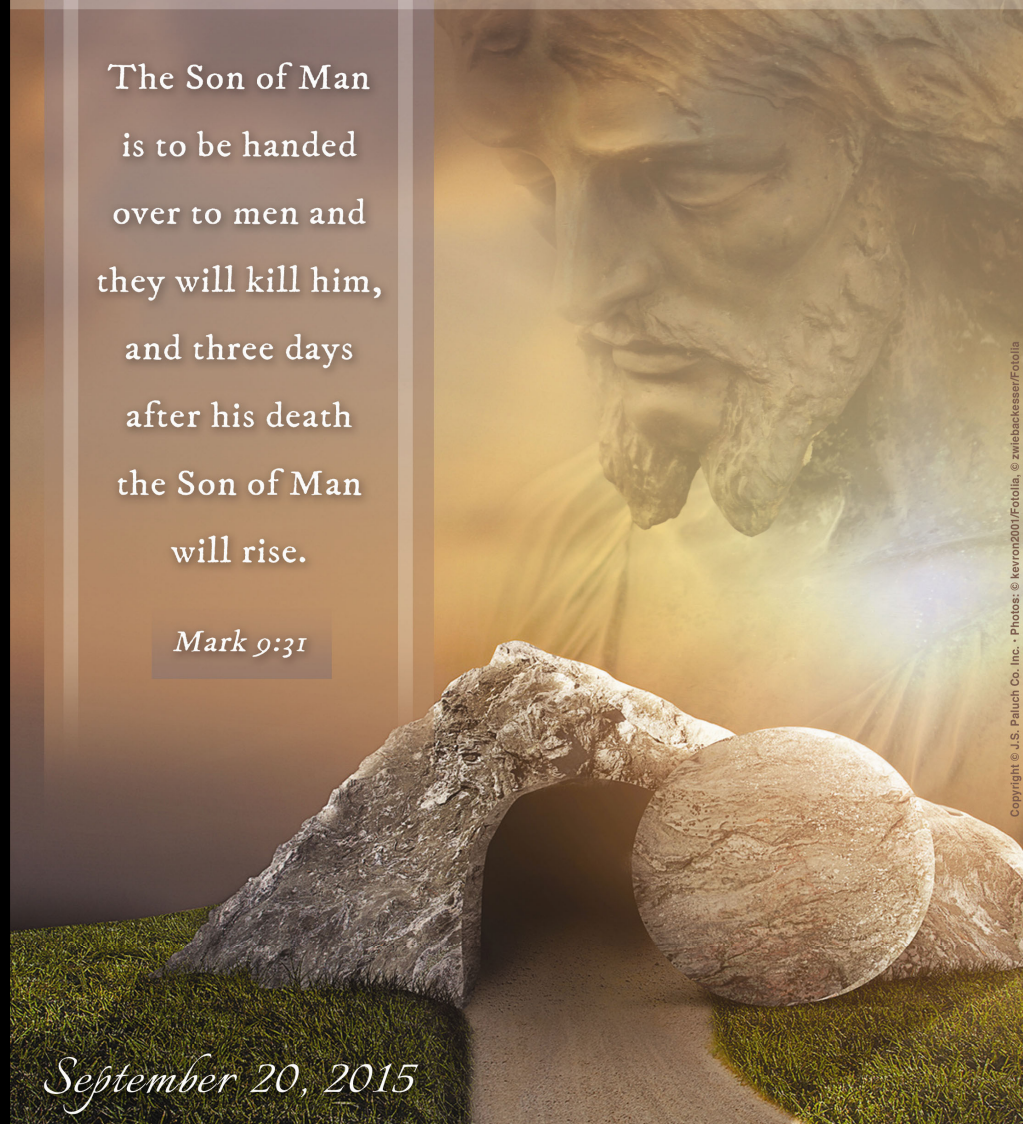

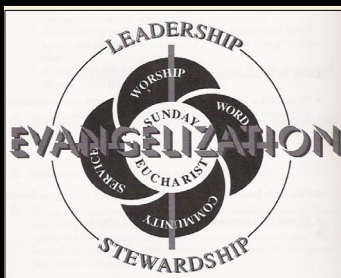

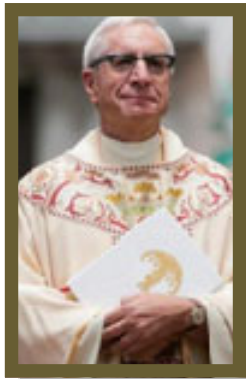

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



The pope is coming to the USA! His visit will be headline news. Along with our Holy Father, the Roman Catholic Church in the US will be the attention of what seems to be the world via press coverage. Pope Francis will do what other popes have done; celebrate Mass in basilicas, cathedrals, and for huge crowds in the great out-doors. He will speak to the US bishops and address the United Nations. He will snarl big city traffic. He will do what no other pope has done in the US: address a joint session of the US Congress and canonize a saint, St Junipero Serra, OFM, the founder of the California Missions. Good Pope Francis will not only speak words of direction, he will most likely caution the very powerful; listen and watch as he will speak words and offer acts of mercy to inmates, immigrants, and the very poor. By his actions, he and our Church stand as a living witness of Christ and his command to love one another. He lives his life deliberately for Christ; his faith is an experience of God. 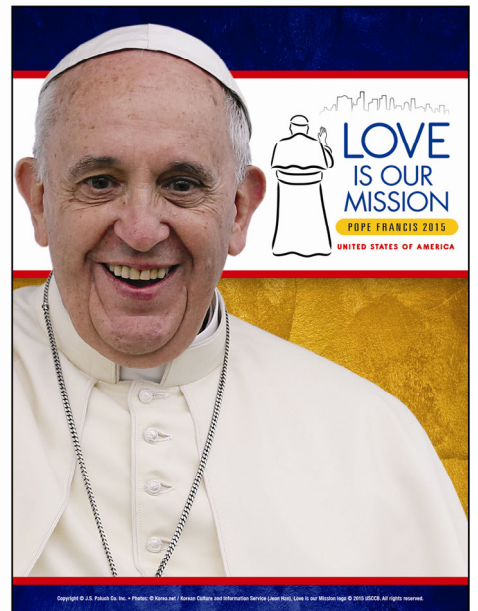

Keenan writes this gem: "As the willingness to enter into the chaos of another, mercy best conveys the actions of God who creates by bringing order out of chaos and who redeems by lifting us out of the chaos of sin. Christ's own entrance into the chaos of death occasions our hope in the risen life. His pledge to return is a pledge to deliver us from the chaos of our own lives. Whatever the media will present by way of data and conclusions, the Roman Catholic Church will be on stage from Pope Francis' landing until his leaving. Conclusions based on data have already been published declaring definitively that the Church has lost great waves of members, is not growing, and is closing one parish and school after another. Wherever that is true, it is sad. Let Pope Francis be our shepherd as we experience and practice our faith and the virtue of mercy, so that our community's obituary will not be forthcoming.

More and more let us become a community of welcome and hospitality. We are people of mercy when we enter into the chaos of countless others who still carry burdensome crosses. May the grace of God shine forth in us like "that little candle [that] sends its light! That's the way a good deed shines in a weary world."

Holy Father, we pray that you have a safe journey and warm welcome.  
Encourage, challenge, and lead us to be better Christians every day.

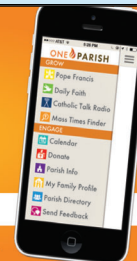
