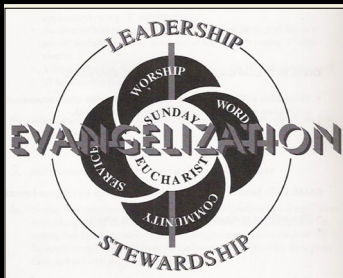

## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The manger scene gets a bit more dramatic this week. Can you imagine the stage setting? With no conveniences, people are huddled close, it is cold. The place smells, not of cinnamon and apple, or anise and garlic, but of dung. The humans are glad for the warmth of the cows, camels, sheep, and dogs. Some of the humans are from near-by and are ordinary people. These are shepherds, lower-class types. Angels are singing and a bright star is attracting rather dramatic men from the ends of the earth. Add the parents and drummer boy. Don't forget the child, the reason for the gathering. From the earliest times of our faith the theme has been as James Joyce wrote regarding the Catholic Church: "Here comes everyone!" And it's a hugely uncertain "everyone!"

Today our future salvation is in the manger and open to the world. The ends of the earth come to be saved. These wise men were different, there was something exotic about them; their spiky gold crowns, their fabulous presents. We might not be aware that in the one gospel in which they appear, there's no indication they were kings, or even three, or that one was white, one black, one yellow, and certainly no hint their names were Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. Caspar is perhaps from Turkey, he is old, normally with a white beard, and gives the gold. Melchior, from Arabia, is middle-aged, giving frankincense. Balthazar is a young man, black-skinned, with myrrh. Some scholars put their ages at 60, 40, and 20. Simply, three gifts need three gift bearers. You won't want to buy more than three Lladro or any other type of statue, would you?

The Holy Family welcomed their guests upon their arrival with acceptance and hospitality. They came to see the child, the reason for the gathering.



A star proclaimed "Jesus, here he is!" The wise men are wise because they believed the proclamation and came to worship. Their lives were changed as they were welcomed.

The Holy Family did not ask for citizenship papers. No baptismal documents had to be presented. The guests were not turned away because of their skin color or language or accent or native dress. The guests told the parents, "We've come to see Jesus. We see the star and hear the voices." They came because their salvation was near at hand. They wanted to change their lives through a relationship with Jesus.

Do you see the star? Do you hear the voices of angels directing your life? Is your life changed because you came to the manger?

What proclamation does your life give to others? How do you welcome people who come to you? What gifts to you bring to others? How do you accept the gift of other people?

## *Epiphany Proclamation 2016*

While a day like Christmas is fixed in our minds and on the calendars on December 25th, many of the important feasts of the Church year move, based upon the date that Easter is set. Easter changes each year moving to the Sunday after the "Paschal Full Moon," and can fall between March 22 and April 25.

In ancient times before calendars were common, most people did not know the dates for the upcoming Liturgical year. On Epiphany Sunday, the upcoming dates were "proclaimed". After the singing of the Gospel, a Deacon or cantor, in keeping with an ancient practice of Holy Church, announces from the ambo the moveable feasts of the current year according to this formula:

Know, dear brethren, (brothers and sisters,) that, as we have rejoiced at  
the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ,

so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the Tenth day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the Twenty-Seventh day of March you will celebrate with Joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the Fifth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the Fifteenth day of May the feast of Pentecost.

On the Twenty-Ninth day of May, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the Twenty-Seventh day of November the First Sunday of Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ,  
to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever.

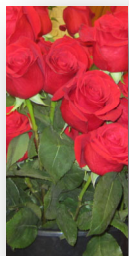

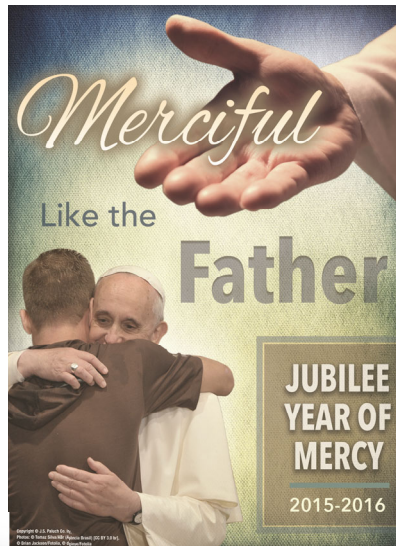
**HOLIDAY “THANKS!”**

JANUARY 3, 2016**



The Epiphany of the Lord In this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, Epiphany celebrates God’s mercy shining on the magi from a guiding star. Their kingdoms were far from Jerusalem, their religions far from God’s covenant with Israel. At first the star led the magi to Jerusalem, where they could “recalculate” their quest with the help of God’s own “GPS,” the Jewish scriptures. How chal-

lenging and humbling for the magi to discover that they would find the world’s Messiah not in a palace but with a poor couple in an insignificant village. That’s where God’s mercy, shining in the star, led the magi to worship Jesus, the Prince of Peace. Today the magi invite us to “recalculate” our life’s journey during this Jubilee Year—to follow the star of God’s mercy along the way of humble love, to discover a renewed personal relationship with Jesus ourselves and so become “guiding stars” leading other seekers to find Jesus, too.
