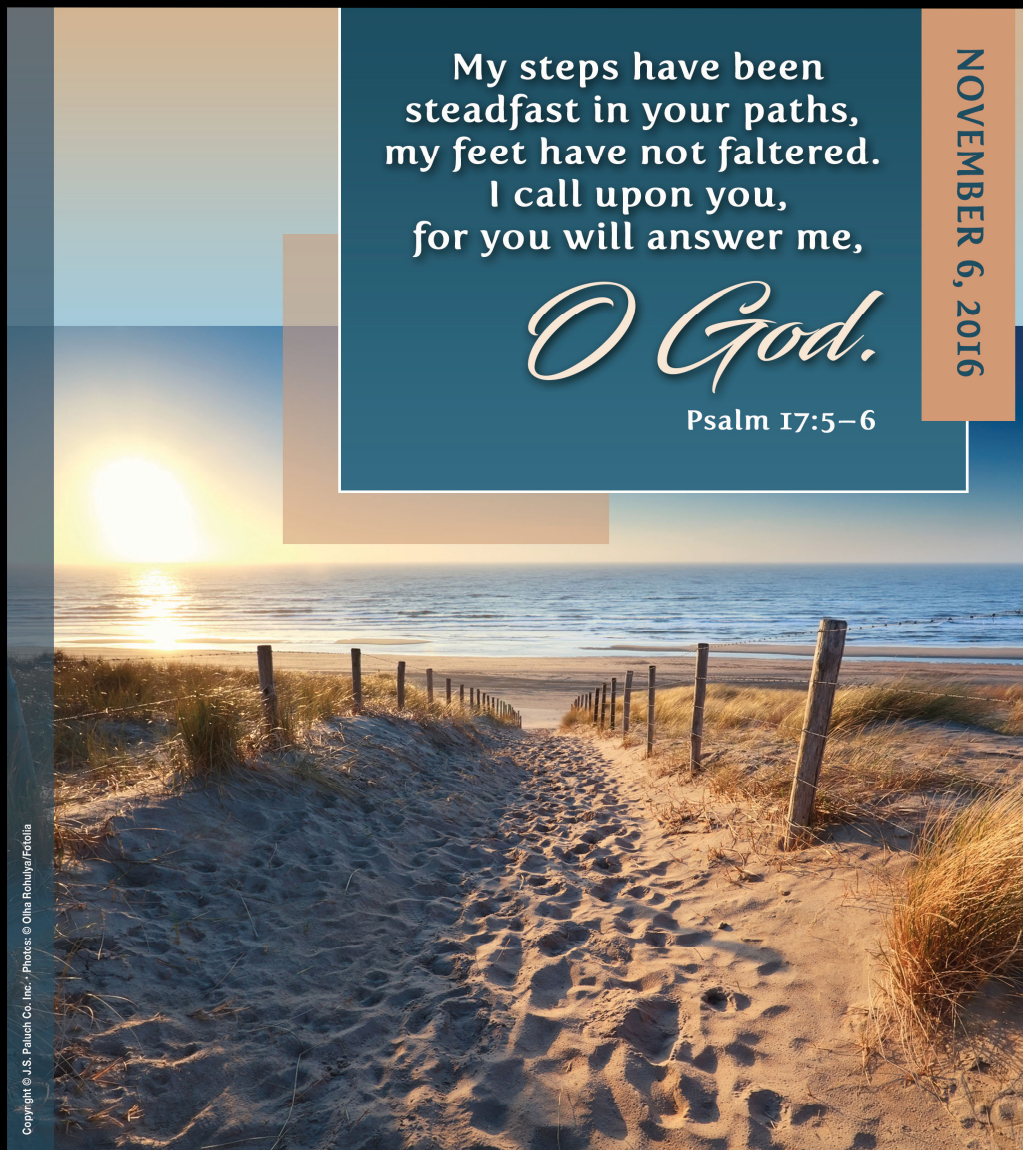

It's November, the month we remember both the "communion of All Saints" and "All Souls of the departed." I enjoy the Feast of All Saints – and here at St. Juliana it's made especially memorable by our grammar school students who study, draw, and dress as saints. They also act as saints! This they do every day as they perfect their knowledge of God, develop a relationship with Him, and imitate Jesus who taught us the way to Our Father. That's what the saints do for us; they give us a model for living God's life within us.

Hollywood creates "Super Heroes" – sports teams provide "Athletic Heroes" – we all identify with Historic and National Heroes – don't forget the "Heroes of our Faith." During November take time to read the Lives of the Saints, reflect on the Sermon on the Mount, and grow in your friendship with and conversion to the Lord of Life. Let the community know saints live in your house.

Remembering those who have died – died recently and in the long past is also an important November act of mercy. At every Mass each priest prays (in these or similar words in each Eucharistic prayer): "Remember also our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection and all who have died in your mercy, welcome them into the light of your face." With this prayer all the departed are remembered at each and every Mass.

November is the month of All Saints and All Souls. Give thanks and remember those whose lives are changed and not ended. Remember and give thanks to those who showed you the way to God.

A few members of our community asked me about what was printed in the newspaper regarding our Church law and cremation. Some years ago the LA Times printed an article regarding a huge new change in the Church; altar GIRLS! Bishop McFarland followed the article in the secular paper very quickly with a multi-page epistle to his priests which concluded –in these or similar words– "And so, gentlemen, neither you nor I will accept any liturgical directive from the Los Angeles Times!"

The *OC Register* newspaper article I read was quite clear and as far as I could tell, correct. I heard a National Public Radio piece that was not so clear. Be clear: Roman Catholics may be cremated. Our Church has allowed cremation for many years. Cremation is becoming very popular. St. Juliana Church now has an "ossuary" – a proper stand for honoring an urn containing the cremains of the one we honor with Christian burial at the funeral Mass.

Cremation was not the only issue addressed; honoring the body was the main topic of the Vatican directive. Theologically, we Roman Catholics believe in the resurrection of the body – we say so in our creed. It is always a "temple of the Holy Spirit" this grace of the body does not stop with death. Burying the dead is a pious custom humans bestow on humans. Practically, I have dealt with a few people who feel really lost when there is no actual place, such a grave site, to go to so that the dead can be visited. "But he is just out there (at sea) somewhere." "We tossed his ashes around trees in the mountains!" A certain and marked grave, whether in the ground or on a wall in a cemetery provides a place for survivors to give reverence to the dead.

To honor the body, the ashes must be kept together. Human remains may not be scattered. This includes at sea, on or over favorite places, or in keep-sake charms such as necklaces, ear-rings, locketts, and etc. that are distributed to loved ones and friends. Nor should the remains be brought home and put a bookshelf, mantle, and etc. The remains are best buried or placed in a wall niche or wall vault called a "columbarium" in a cemetery; Roman Catholic or otherwise.

Burial at sea has been allowed as long as sailors have died! What is important for our faith is that the body is kept intact. One may put the WHOLE URN or FULL BODY into the water.

Burial in non-Catholic cemeteries is allowed. Roman Catholics may be buried in National Cemeteries or in private cemeteries around the world unless such has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching.

### SECOND COLLECTION - ARCHDIOCESE FOR THE MILITARY SERVICES, USA



American Catholics have a rare opportunity this weekend to support the pastoral care for their brothers and sisters, the faithful, in the United States Military and the nation’s Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Medical Centers. This special collection is being taken up in parishes nationwide for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS).

The AMS was established by Saint John Paul II in 1985 to provide the Catholic Church’s full range of ecclesiastical programs, pastoral services, and liturgical celebration to Catholics in the U.S. Armed Forces. The mission of the Archdiocese is to “serve those who serve”—specifically, those who serve in uniform on active duty or reserve; studying to be officers in the U.S. Military Academies; receiving treatment at many of the 153 VA Medical Centers throughout the fifty states, Puerto Rico and Guam; or working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders; and the families of these populations.

His Excellency, the Most Reverend Timothy P. Broglio, J.C.D., Archbishop for the Military Services, said:

“The Archdiocese tries to meet the same pastoral needs of the faithful that your home diocese does, but distances, the deployments and disruptions of the longest war in our history, a severe shortage of priests to serve as military chaplains, and related costs pose a challenge to many pastoral projects. For example, to offer on-going formation to catechists, or to explain the archdiocesan-wide catechetical program for the Navy installations in San Diego, someone has to travel from Washington to the West Coast. My four Auxiliary Bishops and I spend more than 220 days of the year ‘on the road’ to visit the Catholic communities spread throughout the world. There we provide pastoral care to the men and women in uniform and their families, patients at the VA hospitals, as well as to the chaplains and priests who serve them. We administer confirmation and celebrate Mass with the community. Where and when possible, we also visit with those in command. But those costs add up.”

The AMS receives no funding from the military or the government. This special collection is mission-critical. Thank you!

Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Jubilee for Prisoners

One of the most moving images of Pope Francis' ministry comes from Holy Thursday. Slowly, deliberately, Francis kneels down before prisoners—men, women, young, old, Christian, Muslim—and washes their feet, recalling Jesus admonition to Peter:

“If I, therefore, the master and teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash one another’s feet” (John 13:14).

On today’s Jubilee for Prisoners, whose rights the Church bids us advocate, Jesus declares in the Gospel, “to [God] all are alive” (Luke 20:38). Have we “imprisoned” anyone figuratively, but no less painfully, passing harsh judgment, then refusing our respect, acceptance, even affection? This month of All Saints and All Souls bids us reflect on our eternal destiny and prepare for it. Respect for ourselves and others, souls and bodies, practical care for neighbors and strangers: such witness affirms that we view our present in light of our future, and believe that, even now, in our midst, stands the Lord of life, the living Jesus.

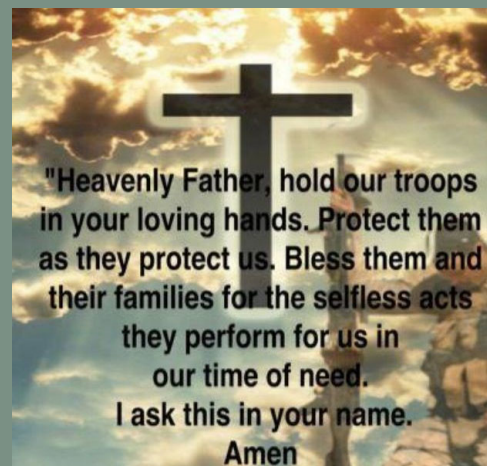

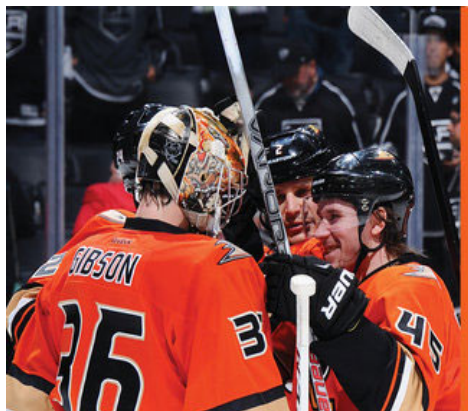

PSA 2016 INFORMATION

**What is the PSA?** The PSA is an annual campaign to fund the annual budgets of our diocesan ministries. The PSA funds are fully utilized on an annual basis and require replenishing to keep these vital ministries operating. Currently in its 37th year, the PSA was initiated by Bishop Johnson for the people of our growing diocese to join together to build up the Church in Orange County. Our subsequent Bishops McFarland, Brown and now Bishop Vann believe that the PSA is necessary to continue to fund the important ministries and services that serve all Catholics in our Diocese as well as thousands of those in the community.

**Why does PSA also support Catholic education?** The PSA supports annual tuition assistance grants to Catholic elementary schools in our diocese. For example, the funds raised for the 2014 PSA were granted to schools for the 2014-2015 school year. The funds raised through the For Christ Forever capital campaign are invested in an endowment which is a permanent fund that will provide annual income to the schools to supplement the PSA funding and other resources.

**When will I receive a tax acknowledgement for my gift to the PSA?** You will receive a tax acknowledgement letter for the PSA in January following that campaign year. If you do not receive a letter, you may contact the Orange Catholic Foundation at the contact information provided below.

**How much should I give to the PSA?** You are asked to prayerfully discern the amount of your PSA gift. Your sacrificial gift in any amount will be acknowledged as your commitment to our faith and your response to God's many blessings.
