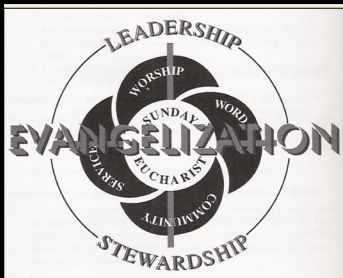

“Father, is it done, finally?” – “Well, yes – mostly!” Welcome back home to your church! When this project began and progressed I began to think: “Wouldn’t it be nice to be back in the church retrofitted, reroofed, and redecorated for the Third Sunday of Advent, *Gaudete* – “Be happy, rejoice, and be glad Sunday?” A goal was set – and met! Mostly. Thank you, all of you for putting up with me and my nonsense. Rejoice, be glad, be happy. Say it again.

The church has been seismically retrofitted, reroofed (in some places the roof has been re-built), and re-decorated within ADA laws. The project was precipitated by the Diocese and the need to retrofit the building, and it was continued with the Pastoral Council and Diocese of Orange to enhance our church.

I explained the seating arrangement at the 9:00AM Mass on *Guadete* Sunday. Not all of you were there. Here’s the deal – law requires seating for ADA accessibility. Rather than have such a section in one place, it is spread around the church providing accessibility and liturgical functionality. Just in front of the choir section, which has been extended two pew spaces larger, is a “business class section.” Parents of toddlers or with baby carriers, adults with walkers and those who need space can find this useful. In that general area is a larger space in the isle. Funerals can begin there and Easter Vigil baptisms can be celebrated there. The space close to the confessional on the field side will allow wheel chairs and walkers an easier access to the confessional. In the seating area there is also an “ooopppsssss” – wood screens with kneelers and hymnal racks were intended for the front of the first pew. The church was not measured correctly. The little fence would have made the communion procession neater. I apologize.

The stripe on the carpet is in compliance with law, transition steps must be obvious.

The space with the cross in front of the sanctuary will be useful for baptisms.

Nearly every surface has been either painted or cleaned.

The “Children’s Chapel” seats can be rearranged to accommodate different prayer settings, Bible study, and faith formation classes. With movable seats, not pews, I hope this room will be useful for faith formation and prayer. I hope to find some suitable art work for its walls.

There is still work to be completed. Some top-set, floor base is missing. It’s on back order. Some tile work needs to be completed and corrected. Some surfaces need paint touch up. Hand rails to the sanctuary are being fabricated and will be installed once they arrive. New holy water fonts have been ordered, they too are yet to arrive. The sound system will be adjusted to the voices of readers, celebrants, and choir. New door hardware making entering easier is “on the drawing table.” The floor resisters along the aisle ways are on that same table. Please be careful when walking along the aisle ways.

The kneelers are quiet and the book racks convenient. Should you have a church hymnal in your private possession, please return it. There will be no penance, just a good celebration of the Mass!

If you find something that “ain’t just right” please try to love it until Ash Wednesday, then be patient during Lent, and rejoice at Easter when you “fuguetaboutit.” If you notice something that is broken or un-safe ALWAYS bring it to our attention.

One future project remains in the design works; the entry onto Melody Lane will be redesigned. We have a donation for that project.

Financially, I started with the goal to “not bite off more than we could chew” – at one point I addressed our Finance Committee with the concern and worry: “It’s snowballing!” I appeal to you, please consider a special donation to our redecoration/church enhancements. A recognition plaque will be placed in the narthex. Kindly contact Mr. Curtis Wesseln or me in the Parish Office.

Multiple vendors and laborers and the Diocese of Orange all cooperated to meet our (my) deadline. The flooring company (Vintage Design) sent a worker ALL DAY, dawn to dusk, on Thanksgiving Day to prepare the floor. With the school students ready to begin their Advent Program the flooring company worked until just before 7:00PM on Friday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. I am grateful to Mrs. Jan Turcotte, the design consultant who organized the project and kept us on target. The Diocese has been generous; we received a \$200,000 gift from Bishop Vann. Be sure to thank Bishop Vann. The workers were grateful for your kind words to them expressing to me “Father, we don’t get the thanks, from all parishes, as we got from yours!” Thank you!

Finally, this is the church **building** – a whole lot more significant is the **community** of God’s People called Church – that’s each of you who come worship here – AND – those who belong by baptism. Together, let’s build a Church community for the Lord. Come here often during the week and day to find time to “raise your hearts and minds to God.” Invite someone to “Come Home For Christmas” – if you don’t who will? If not now – when?

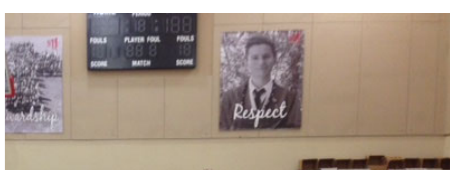

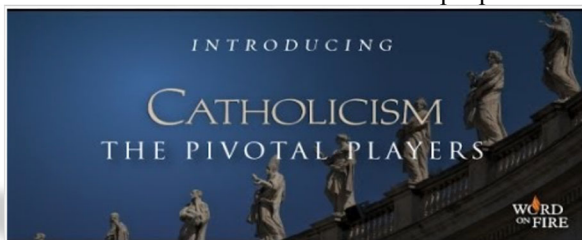

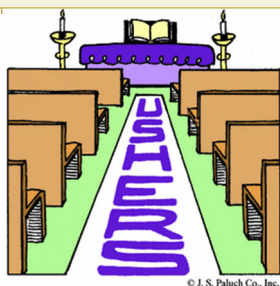
