





A NOTE FROM FR. MICHAEL PONTARELLI, O.S.M.



"Remember, Lord, your Church, spread throughout the world, and bring her to the fullness of charity, together with Francis our Pope and Kevin our Bishop and his brother bishops and all the clergy."

We pray those words of petition, in the Third Eucharist Prayer and similar words in the other nine Eucharistic prayers. It's part of the great "Apostolic Succession" of our Church. It reminds us of those who, in the prayerful intention of The Roman Canon, Eucharistic Prayer I, "guard, unite, and govern (the Church) throughout the whole world." Priests celebrate the Eucharist because the office of Christ who is at once Priest (Sanctifier), Prophet (Teacher), and King (Ruler) is passed from the pope to the bishop to the priest.

The Pope appoints bishops; the Ordinary Diocesan Bishop and any auxiliary (helper) bishops. This is completed within a process that begins with the local diocese, then the national conference of bishops and finally to Rome. The Diocese of Orange is large; an ethnically diverse congregation of 1.3 million Catholics we are the 10th largest diocese in the USA. Currently we are led by Bishop Kevin Vann who is our Ordinary bishop, and two retired bishops, Tod David Brown and Dominic Luong. Ordinary is not a derogatory term, it means he is THE bishop all others are bishops under his direction.

On November 23, 2016 in a communication from Rome, Fr. Tim Freyer a priest of the Diocese of Orange was named as an auxiliary bishop to Bishop Kevin Vann. Bishop-elect Freyer grew up in Huntington Beach and has been a priest in the county's diocese since 1989. He will be ordained as a bishop Jan. 17 at St. Columban Catholic Church in Garden Grove. He will then no longer be bishop-elect but Bishop Tim. He is fluent in Spanish, has been a priest at several parishes throughout the county, including St. Hedwig Parish in Los Alamitos, Our Lady of Fatima in San Clemente, St. Catherine of Siena Parish in Laguna Beach and St. Mary's in Fullerton. He was an accomplished pastor and good shepherd at St. Boniface in Anaheim. His current assignment is Episcopal Vicar for Priests. In this ministry he cares for priests as a "priest's priest" - he sees to the general welfare of priests, that they are getting care in their retirement and being saved from "burn out" in their assignments. He mentors newly ordained and young pastors (the older ones are another story). He prepares the annual diocesan priest retreat and community days of priest renewal. It's a real ministry, a huge help to all of us priests! He serves as a chaplain to the Anaheim Police Department. While at St. Boniface, he founded a center to care for the needy in central Anaheim.



Auxiliary Bishop Tim will be helpful to Bishop Kevin Vann as together they lead us to God.

The Roman Church is always full of rumor and intrigue; expect another auxiliary bishop for service in the Diocese of Orange!





The Sacrament of Penance offers a new possibility to convert oneself to the Gospel and recover grace that was lost by sin.

Who must go to confession? Each of the faithful is bound by an obligation to confess mortal, serious sins, at least once a year. Confession of everyday faults (venial sins) is strongly recommended by the Church.

Mortal sin: a sin whose object is grave matter and is committed with full knowledge and deliberate consent.

Venial sin: a less serious wrong doing, disobeys the moral law.

Begin with an examination of your conscience. Before you enter the confessional, prayerfully reflect on your words and deeds since the last time you received the sacrament. Knowing the Ten Commandments and the Gospel of Jesus, when have you "missed the mark?" When have you done a do not do – or when you could have practiced a virtue or performed an act of mercy but did not? When did you misuse God's creation? What have you done that gives you guilt?

Tell these faults to the priest. Listen to any advice, counsel, or guidance that the priest might give you.

Receive your penance, the act that you must do to repair any harm your sin has caused and to re-establish yourself as a disciple of Christ.

Receive the absolution of your sins, be reconciled with God, the Father of mercies, and the Church as the priest prays the prayer of absolution for you.

Be prepared to pray an Act of Contrition: these or similar words: My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. 
