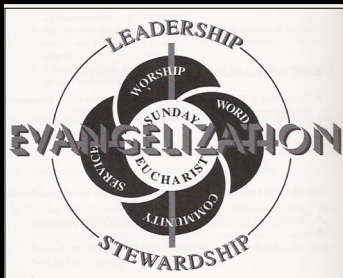

## ~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~



During this Lent, take time to listen to our prayers. Then allow those prayers the chance to convert you, the one who prays. Be brave to accept the likeness of Christ. If you want to know what people believe listen to the way they pray: “*Lex credenda, lex orandi*” that is “the law of believing is the law of praying” a saying many learned years ago. One of many beautiful prayers is from Preface II of Lent: “[Father], you have given your children a sacred time for the renewing and purifying of their hearts...”

Unlike Advent, Lent is a time when the Church community goes on retreat. This is our time to renew and refresh our souls so that we can accept once again the joy of Easter; the forgiveness of our sins and our sure and certain hope of life eternal.

This is our time to recommit ourselves to the promises made at our baptism: to be disciples of Jesus and to live life awaiting his promise “to be with us always until the end of time.” We are Christians not because we are good people — we are Christians because we are disciples of Jesus, he is our Friend who directs our lives as we await the resurrection of the dead and the promise of immortality. We are Christians because our lives are orientated toward Easter.

How do you describe your lived relationship with God to this point in your life?

The real questions are how much of a disciple of Jesus are you, and how have you begun to and followed through with your intentional relation as his disciple? Can you say that you were “called by God” to come to Mass, to be guided by the Scripture taught by a homily, nourished at the Table of Sacrifice, and sent to “glorify the Lord by the way you live your life?”

If a co-worker or neighbor were looking for a religious community to join, would your friendship with the Lord, your discipleship, direct them to this faith community?

St. Juliana Falconieri is a “Catholic Community [it is our intention] to live as people of God with Christ at the center of our lives.” Strong faith, and a discipleship, is the cement of our community. Together let us mature in our faith and practice it in a lively manner.

On this Lenten Sunday that celebrates the Transfiguration of Jesus the Gospel lesson recalls how Jesus intentionally picked disciples; from those he deliberately selected some to be even closer to him. It was his intention for them to experience his glory and become “fully awake and see his glory.” This is our invitation to live our faith as mature adults. Let us strengthen our relationship with the Lord so that he will renew and purify our hearts this Lent.

This Lent and for the rest of our lives, in a deliberate and intentional way, let us become dynamic disciples of Jesus. **Transfigure Us O Lord!**

Become an intentional disciple strong in your relationship with Jesus. Pray, be brave to be Jesus’ presence. **Transfigure Us O Lord!**
