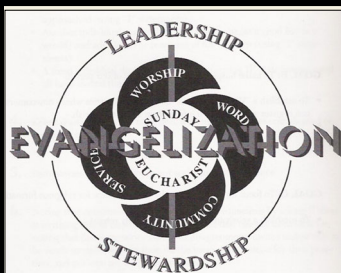

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~

Attending this Palm Sunday Mass you hear the Passion of Jesus, Cycle C, according to St. Luke. Attending Good Friday Solemn service you hear the Passion of Jesus according to St. John. In each of the narrations, pay close attention to the people identified. They are the common ones; Peter, Judas Iscariot, the High Priests, Pontius Pilate, “the crowd,” Barabbas,” “the Roman Soldiers,” Simon of Cyrene, “the women of Jerusalem,” the two thieves,” Mary Magdalene, Mary Mother of Jesus, and Jesus Christ crucified. For some of these, most actually, the details of their presence is sketchy. Frankly what is known is mostly legend. Doesn’t mean it’s good or bad, just uncertain.

It’s safe to say the writing of the gospel began with the ending. Knowing the crucifixion/resurrection a suitable beginning was added. That’s why “Alleluia, Jesus Christ is risen from the dead” the Easter proclamation is the first Christian proclamation. “Silent Night” or “Away in a Manger” came later. And “Jingle Bells” long after that! The gospels were most likely written chronologically backwards. Not bad, for the most part most writing is. Knowing that he became the President of the United States, biographers traced Abraham Lincoln’s life backwards showing his direction from Illinois to the White House. Knowing that the Broncos won the Super Bowl, the writers even for that game, wrote the copy from final score back to opening kick-off.

From Puzzled Peter to the humble and helpful Simon of Cyrene, to Mary with Jesus at the hour of his death and the others in-between; with whom do you identify, even every now and again? For a “spiritual exercise” distinguish the actions of St. Peter with the response of Judas. Look at the women along the way: What must you do to help those who are in trouble today? Reflect on the Roman Soldier: When would you come to believe “Jesus Christ is Lord!”?

Who were you in the school passion play? What did it feel like? Did it feel at all? Which person did you want to be?

Allow the crucifixion of Jesus to convert you to be a strong disciple of Jesus. Be one who stands up for and with Jesus even and especially when doing so is difficult. Hint: most prophets have been killed or “beset because they are obnoxious” to the wicked.

The cross is always before us; is it leading you as a disciple or is it art if not jewelry?

Once more! IMPORTANT! This year, take time to celebrate the Easter ritual fully. ***Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord’s Supper, Friday of the Passion of the Lord (Good Friday), and The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night (Holy Saturday, Easter Vigil) or Easter Sunday in the daytime are three ceremonies which make the one complete Feast of Easter.*** Mass on Holy Thursday will be at 7:00PM followed by the repose of the Lord until 12 mid-night in the Parish Center. The Good Friday Solemn Ceremony begins at 1:00PM. The Great Easter Vigil starts at 7:00PM. If you don’t attend the Great Vigil, Easter Day Mass times are 7:30AM, 9:00AM, and 11:00AM. ***I encourage you to keep the celebration and to celebrate with joy.*** THERE ARE NO MORNING MASSES celebrated on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday; instead Morning Prayer is prayed at 8:00AM, all the faithful are invited at that time. ***Please bring hand bells to ring during the Gloria at the Great Easter Vigil Mass.*** Let’s celebrate the forgiveness of our sins and promise of eternal life.

There is one more Easter related celebration to attend! ***The Chrism Mass at Christ Cathedral Campus (The Arboretum Church) on Monday, March 21.*** Together with Bishop Vann and the many priests and deacons of our diocese as well as parishioners from each parish, please attend the Mass which blesses the Holy Oils to be used in the diocese for the coming year. It’s a festive celebration! If you have never been to it, come. If it’s been some while since you attended it last, do it again. If you participate every year, do it once more. This celebration begins at 5:30PM; it’s at Christ Cathedral (formerly Crystal Cathedral) 13280 Chapman Avenue, Garden Grove, CA 92840.
