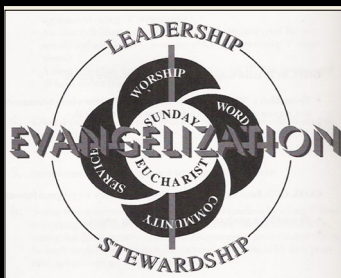

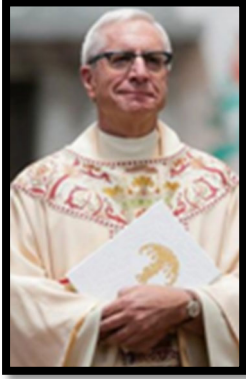

~ A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M. ~

Thank you, all of you, who participated in the Three Great Days of our faith, the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday solemn ceremony, and Easter). If you were in any way part of the rituals, thanks a zillion to the power of infinity! If you attended and prayed with us, thanks a zillion to the power of infinity! So many youth gave up free-time to practice, thanks. I was really pleased with the prayerful leadership and celebration of the Easter Triduum – I hope you were too. Thanks to Fr. John Money Penny for leading Holy Thursday and to Fr. Jerry Horan, OSM for leading Good Friday. Our visiting priests prepared and led the services with love for the Lord and us. I asked you, dear parishioners, to come to the three services which make one celebration and you did. Thank you so much; a zillion to the power of infinity!

The banner in the back of the church headlines; “Proud to be Catholic” – at St. Juliana’s we are proud to be Catholic. Believe the Good News; your sins are forgiven and live in the “sure and certain hope” of eternal life. Shout this new joy with the decisions you make for your life.

Today’s Gospel lesson is the experience of coming to faith. There are two great saints named Thomas; today’s Apostle Thomas and St. Thomas Aquinas, the Dominican Preacher. Thomas Aquinas is sharp, he has the all truths of our faith organized and explained in long volumes of reading. The Apostle Thomas is more like the rest of us; “Yeah, show me. I might not be from Missouri, but show me. I’m not as gullible as I look.” The experience of Jesus that is to say, faith, grows on us. Seldom is anyone thrown to the ground as St. Paul was converted. For most of us our faith is formed by the way we the experience other people of faith. The experience of God (faith) grows on us until it becomes our own. And when it becomes our own, there is that moment of “WOW, it really is true. Jesus is Lord! I’m in love with this most wonderful guy! Yes I believe, help my unbelief.” We are at peace with our belief. We bring other people to that same relationship.

Today’s lesson is the first ending of St. John’s Gospel, there are two. The endings are similar: “There is much more to be written. This has been written so that you might believe.” That’s the purpose of gospel writing, leading us to believe. If the testimony of each of us were written, how many volumes would be filled?!

Let the way we live our lives speak louder than the words used to write our faith. Might our belief encourage good works and more of us to say: “I believe Jesus is Lord” and I will live that creed.

What follows is for your awareness of the seismic retrofit, roofing, and beginning of the “enhancements” of our church building. As of this writing – the retrofit project is scheduled to begin on Monday, April 4. **Beginning Monday, April 4th, we will not be able to use the sacristy area and cry room for about ten working days.** In those areas the asbestos fiber ceiling will be taken down and removed. In the church, ties will be installed to secure the wooden beams. A new roof is scheduled to replace the old one. **We will be able to use the church for morning Masses each day, any funeral, and on April 5th, our day of Eucharistic Exposition – the project will be suspended during those times. Otherwise, after the 8:00AM weekday Mass the church is not available.** During the construction time, a temporary sacristy will be set up in the facilities maintenance room in the Parish Center. What I am informing you of is the plan, at the time of writing this article, which is mid-week. Listen for more information; emails will also be sent.

To keep up on parish matters – to keep yourself most current, if you have a smart-phone, I encourage you to sign-up for and use the app: “One Parish.” If you are a Facebook user, like “St. Juliana Falconieri Catholic Community” - parish events are posted regularly. Our parish school posts events on: “St. Juliana Falconieri School”. It’s a great way for family abroad to know what school life is like here. **GO FALCONS!** Should you suffer with cancer and wish prayers links from the USA Servite Province – the Servite Order in the United States, on Facebook like, “National Shrine of St. Peregrine”. Prayer links are sent several times each week.

May Almighty God, in His Divine Mercy, enlighten your minds to know Jesus, His Risen Son. May your hearts burn with love for him, and your actions demonstrate your conversion to Jesus. Continue your friendship with the Risen Christ this whole Easter Season.

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

April 3, 2016

Second Sunday of Easter or Sunday of Divine Mercy

Last year on this Sunday, Pope Francis declared this year a *Jubilee Year of Mercy*. Saint John Paul II named the Second Sunday of Easter "Sunday of Divine Mercy" in response to Saint Faustina Kowalska's Divine Mercy devotion, which offered spiritual comfort to hearts worldwide. But Francis challenges us to make that comfort we receive a gift we gladly share: "We are called to show mercy because mercy has first been shown to us." The clearest expression of merciful love, says Francis, is pardoning others. "At times how hard it seems to forgive!" he acknowledges. "And yet pardon is the instrument placed into our fragile hands to attain serenity of heart" (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 9). The necessary condition for living joyfully? "To let go of anger, wrath, violence, and revenge." May Divine Mercy Sunday in this *Jubilee Year of Mercy* remind us that Jesus made mercy our life's ideal and a criterion for our faith's credibility: "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy" (Matthew 5:7).

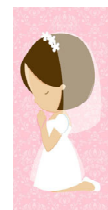

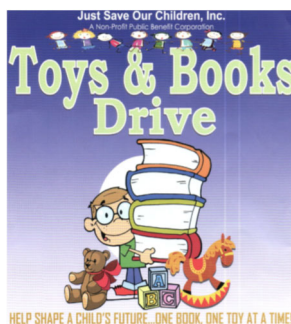

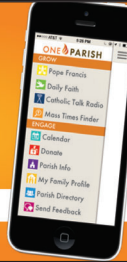
